Race 1	PORT FM MAIDEN (1200m)			
On jumping VAPORETTO was hampered when HOOVER shifted outwards abruptly.				
DESERT GIRL raced wide throughout.				
Passing the 1000 metres IRONWORKER commenced to race fiercely and shifted out abruptly on the point of the turn				
forcing CHAIROS and DESERT GIRL over extra ground.				
IRONWORKER raced wide without cover from this point.				
IRONWORKER lay out from the 400 metres.				
Race 2	D'CASH DASH RATING 75 (1200m)			
The start was del	ayed approximately 4 minutes when GOLDEN GLOBE proved difficult to get to the start area.			
BURSTING STONE bounded as the start was effected and shortly after was hampered and unbalanced when firmly				
contacted by ISHIGOLD which shifted in.				
PATRICE raced wide throughout.				
THAT'SOUREXCUSE improved wide rounding the final bend.				
Near the 200 metres MISS EL BEE DEE had to steady when THAT'SOUREXCUSE shifted in under pressure.				
I'M MAVERIC which gave ground quickly from the 200 metres and finished in last position returned to the birdcage with				
blood present in its right nostril. A post race endoscopic inspection revealed I'M MAVERIC to be a bleeder and accordingly				
the connections	were advised that the gelding was stood down for the mandatory three months.

Race 3 CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN SPRINT R65 (1200m) WEDGIE began awkwardly and shifted out making firm contact with GANACHE. WEDGIE blundered shortly after the start.

LIGHTNING LUCY was slow to begin.

SUMMER'S BOY raced wide throughout.

Passing the 1000 metres **SPARK IT UP** got its head up when being restrained.

LIGHTNING LUCY improved wide rounding the home turn and was then taken to the extreme outside of the track before running on strongly for 4th placing. Rider P Taylor informed the Stewards he endeavoured to find better ground for **LIGHTNING LUCY** however he conceded that the ground covered in going wider on the track had nullified the marginally better conditions out wide.

WANNABEAWALLABETOO lay inwards and gave ground from the 200 metres.

Race 4 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MILE RATING 75 (1600m)

BALLYRINA was slow in the early stages.

Near the 1300 metres HAPPY DAYS got its head up when making the bend awkwardly.

When questioned regarding the performance of **HAPPY DAYS**, rider S Muniandy advised that after getting shuffled back in the running he was further back than anticipated he added the mare had worked into the race from the 600 metres but only battled over the concluding stages despite his urgings. He further added in his opinion the testing nature of today's track did not suit the mare.

Race 5 WASHDYKE WONDERS RATING 65 HANDICAP (1600m)

HIDDEN IDENTITY was slow to begin.

SORLEY BOY was crowded between runners at the start and got back as a result.

EL BEE DEE raced keenly in the early stages.

GANADOR had to steady passing the 1300 metres when in tight quarters, getting its head up on a number of occasions. **MISS LINCOLN** improved wide rounding the final turn.

GOLD 'N CASH lay outwards through the final straight.

P Taylor, the rider of GOLD 'N CASH, reported the gelding had been on one rein throughout .

Correct weight was delayed while the connections of 2nd placed **MISS LINCOLN** viewed the films ,in regard to being forced wider in the final straight, before deciding not to proceed with a protest.

A post race veterinary inspection of **EL BEE DEE** revealed no apparent abnormalities. Trainer R McKay advised in his opinion **EL BEE DEE** had failed to handle the testing nature of todays' track conditions.

Race 6 LION BEVERAGES RATING 85 2100 (2100m)

FIORANO bounded as the start was effected.

AL ASKAN jumped awkwardly.

Passing the 1700 metres **AL ASKAN** made the bend awkwardly shifting wider and forcing **LISA LOVE** over extra ground. Near the 1600 metres **ARONSAY** made the crossing awkwardly and tended to get its head up. **ARONSAY** raced ungenerously for some distance.

Passing the 1600 metres FIORANO commenced to pull hard, only settling near the 1000 metres.

NOLAWOOD raced wide from the 1400 metres.

STORMY RAIN lay outwards rounding the final turn.

Rider J Morris reported to the Stewards that although in her opinion **AL ASKAN** failed to handle the testing nature of today's track, the gelding felt indifferent in its action on returning to scale. A post race veterinary inspection of **AL ASKAN** did not reveal any apparent abnormalities.

Race 7 SPEIGHTS STAYERS MAIDEN (2100m)

PFORPERFECT made contact with **RAGGIO SPERANZA** as the start was effected then shifted outwards abruptly unbalancing rider J Morris before making contact with **EVIDENCE** which had shifted inwards. **HAWKESBURY** got back as a result of this tightening.

LONE WOLF raced wide from the 1000 metres.

RAGGIO SPERANZA gave ground from the 600 metres.

EVIDENCE was held up rounding the final bend for a short distance.

Passing the 400 metres **LONE WOLF** was taken to the extreme outside of the track.

LONE WOLF became unbalanced on a couple of occasions in the home straight.

The connections of **PFORPERFECT** advised that the filly was galloped on during the running and lost the off hind plate.

Race 8 ONCEUPONATIME RATING 65 HANDICAP (2100m)

CHASUBLE shifted out on jumping making firm contact with **ADIDAZLER** resulting in K Wong becoming unbalanced for a short distance.

JAYAR and FLY MY PRETTY made contact at the start with FLY MY PRETTY being forced into the line of MISSCEO which was hampered as a result.

SAINT RYAN made the bend at the 1700 metres awkwardly.

CHINA BO BO raced wide throughout.

PRINCE FLIGHT raced wide from the 1400 metres.PERFECT EXCUSE gave ground from the 850 metres.ARCTIC FOX improved very wide rounding the home turn.JAYAR gave ground from the 600 metres.
