| Race 1 | PLATINIUM HOMES MAIDEN 2100M |
| <p>ROYAL COMMAND was slow away.</p> <p>BEAU ZED raced four wide without cover in the back straight and around the bend.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of JUSTA CHARLIE rider H Tinsley advised the gelding had every opportunity but was disappointing and he had no excuse.</p> <p>Apprentice Jockey D Turner the rider of BEAUDASTORM was issued with a warning after he allowed his mount to shift in shortly after the start when not clear of MANGAROA HUSTLER which was tightened.</p> | |
| Race 2 | STORAGE AND EQUIPMENT 2YO 1200M |
| <p>WEREGOINGTOGETCHA jumped inwards abruptly at the start bumping FIVE TARTS.</p> <p>DUSAUTOIR and TIME TO SPARC both began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>S Collett the rider of JOANNA was advised to exercise care after she allowed her mount to shift in near the 1000 metres when not clear of KALINGA which had to be momentarily steadied.</p> <p>FIVE TARTS raced wide throughout.</p> <p>COLONEL CARRERA raced very greenly in the home straight and despite the rider's efforts shifted out some distance towards the outside rail, losing ground.</p> | |

| Race 3 | ANDREW FAGE CATERING MAIDEN 1200M |
| <p>DAL SORAY was declared a late scratching at 9:54am acting on Veterinary advice.</p> <p>STUNNING PRINCESS was tightened at the start and got back.</p> <p>SURF had to be momentarily eased passing the 1000 metres after THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN (R Hannam) shifted in. R Hannam was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of WILFRED which failed to run on as expected, rider D Bradley advised the gelding was unsuited to the heavy track conditions.</p> <p>Following the running of this race the track was down-graded to Heavy 11 following further rain.</p> | |
| Race 4 | CLASS HARVEST CENTRE 1200M |
| <p>The start of this race was delayed due to JOJO escaping from behind the barrier and galloping a short distance.</p> <p>ALKEMPO and NORTH AND SOUTH were slow away</p> <p>When questioned into the run of JIMMY MAC which finished back, jockey J Riddell stated the track was too heavy for it on this occasion.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of NORTH AND SOUTH rider R Hannam stated the filly was not suited to the heavy 11 track conditions.</p> | |
| Race 5 | NOEL HURLEY MEMORIAL 2100M |
| <p>SHAKEITUP was slow away</p> <p>Both the riders of ASTON MARTON (D Bradley) and VALLEY OF PENTIRE (K Smith) reported to the Stewards that their mounts were unsuited to the heavy going.</p> <p>D Walsh reported that his mount SHAKEITUP which finished some distance last, hung throughout. Co-Trainer J McElroy advised Stewards that SHAKEITUP would be retired.</p> | |
| Race 6 | SUPER LIQUOR MAIDEN 3YO 1600M |
| <p>MOUNTBATTEN was slow away.</p> <p>MAKE BIG had to be steadied near the 600 metres when SWEET 'N' SAVVY shifted out simultaneously as PROPULSION rolled in.</p> <p>GINA after racing in a forward position gave ground quickly passing the 600 metres and finished some distance last. When questioned K Kalychurun was of the opinion something may be amiss after the filly felt indifferent in its action.</p> <p>Connections of GINA were asked to report the progress of the filly over coming days.</p> | |
| Race 7 | PGG WRIGHTSON/AON 1600M |
| <p>ZANE BAY was slow away.</p> <p>KENNETH raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of KENNETH rider H Tinsley stated that although the gelding was not entirely comfortable in the going he was of the opinion it would improve with the run.</p> | |
