RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WAIHOU TAVERN HURDLE

The start of this race was delayed approximately 6 minutes due to the late arrival of ambulance personnel.

SCIMITAR LAD (E Stack) over-raced in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained.

STORM HOME (C Perrett) over-raced in the early stages.

VICTOR LUDORUM (K Veenendaal) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 150 metres on the first occasion.

BRAVE BUCCANEER (A Ihaka) badly misjudged the jump near the 1300 metres losing ground.

SCIMITAR LAD hit the fence near the 1100 metres hard unbalancing its rider.

VERDASCO (P Ormsby) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres and fell. P Ormsby was stood down from his remaining ride. A post-race veterinary examination of **VERDASCO** found the gelding to be uninjured other than some superficial abrasions. Hampered by the fallen runner were **IT'S A MESSAGE** (M Mitchell), **BRAVE BUCCANEER** and **CHAINEDINALKATRAZ** (S Phelan). Also inconvenienced was **STORM HOME** which when avoiding the fallen runner made contact with **DAN DINERO** (G Walsh).

CHAINEDINALKATRAZ and **BRAVE BUCCANEER** were retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.

STORM HOME was retired from the race after jumping the third last fence.

I'M ISAAC (E Farr) shifted out under pressure after jumping the second last fence and had to be straightened.

Race 2 NOTTINGHAM CASTLE HOTEL HURDLE

A lhaka the declared rider for **GENEROUS TYPE** was unable to make the contracted weight and was fined \$100 under Rule 330(3)(c). C Perrett was the replacement rider.

T Harris the rider of **SUPERCHARGED** was unable to claim any of his allowance and was fined the sum of \$100 under Rule 330(3)(c).

Trainer P Nelson presented **HO DOWN** to race without its notified gear of blinkers and was charged under Rule 616(3). As Mr Nelson had left the course a hearing was opened and adjourned by the Judicial Committee until a date to be set.

HO DOWN (E Farr) misjudged the first fence.

COMTE DE JEU (A Kuru) over-raced in the early stages.

GENEROUS TYPE (C Perrett) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres.

GENEROUS TYPE and **RADINKA** (M Mitchell) were both retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten. **HO DOWN** put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres and then commenced to give ground and was pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

Race 3 NEW WORLD MORRINSVILLE 1200

STRICTLY LIMITED (O Bosson) was slow to begin.

UNDERTHEINFLUENCE (L Innes) which was slow away was further hampered by **LUCKY ORPHAN** (T Thornton) which shifted out leaving the barriers.

IMPACT (R Hutchings) and **OUR JESSE JANE** (M Wenn) were crowded to the inside of **DOIKNOWYOU** (N Harris) which shifted in leaving the barriers.

SMILING CHOICE (B Hutton) had to be checked when crowded shortly after jumping away due to movement from runners on either side.

Passing the 200 metres **DOIKNOWYOU** raced greenly when placed under pressure shifting out. **DOIKNOWYOU** then ducked in. Shortly after **SUMMER DALE** (S Collett) shifted out under pressure into the line of **EEZEMOOVA** (M Hills) which was inconvenienced.

Passing the 100 metres WHITLEY CHAPEL (C Grylls) shifted in under pressure inconveniencing DOIKNOWYOU.

A post-race endoscopic examination confirmed **JONAH** (A Forbes) as a bleeder and as such is subject to the mandatory 3 month stand down period.

Race 4 AXIS AUTOMOTIVE STEEPLECHASE

THE ROSE jumped the first fence awkwardly almost dislodging rider A Galliers-Pratt who lost the use of her stirrup irons for a distance.

GO JIMMY GO (M Cropp) landed awkwardly after jumping the third fence.

EL MARINO (A Kuru) made firm contact with **GO JIMMY GO** after jumping the fifth fence with **GO JIMMY GO** becoming briefly unbalanced.

ROBERTY BOB put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres dislodging rider K Veenendaal. **DESPERADO** (E Farr) and **MARVON DOWNS** (S Phelan) both put in poor jumps at the same fence.

At the fence near the 1000 metres on the second occasion **THE ROSE** landed awkwardly dislodging rider A Galliers-Pratt. Inconvenienced in this incident was **DESPERADO**.

MARVON DOWNS and TRALEE (M Mitchell) both jumped the third to last fence awkwardly and fell.

All fallen riders were uninjured.

M Cropp the rider of **GO JIMMY GO** was advised that he must ride his mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit.

A post-race veterinary examination of **MARVON DOWNS** which was bleeding from a nostril found this to be the result of a laceration.

A post-race veterinary examination of **TRALEE** did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 5 BARRY BURGE STEEPLECHASE

NO QUOTA (S Houston) was crowded leaving the barriers.

MR ALIGN (M Mitchell) was inconvenienced jumping the first fence.

NO QUOTA became awkwardly placed on heels when jumping the third fence in restricted room.

LIZAC (N Quinn) stumbled on landing after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres on the second occasion.

NO QUOTA landed awkwardly after jumping the second to last fence.

LIZAC lost the off front plate during the running.

NO QUOTA lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 6 LUNJEVICH & MARTIN CONTRACTING 2200

SPACE ODDITY (R Irwin) began awkwardly losing ground.

BUNKERED (L Wheeler) shifted out leaving the barriers crowding **TOM'S MYTH** (B Ropiha) and **CALLMELOU** (T Johnson).

PARTY HORSE (S Fannin) and SOLYN (S Wenn) were both slow to begin.

Rider A Tata (ISDABICKY) was reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 7 KARL DAVIS BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1200

JOEY JONZ (B Hutton), RATATUI (A Taylor) and AITCHALPEEBEE (T Thornton) were all slow to begin.

IZZANORANGE (B R Jones) blundered leaving the barriers.

DANCE (D Johnson) began awkwardly losing ground.

MRKNOWITALL (M Sweeney) was held up approaching the 400 metres and shifted in to obtain clear running.

Passing the 400 metres **CAGA DANCE** (M Hills) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **DANCE** which shifted out when placed under pressure.

Passing the 300 metres MRKNOWITALL raced in restricted room between DANCE and PLAYS UNTIL DARK (O Bosson). MRKNOWITALL then shifted out across the heels of DANCE to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres making slight contact with CHANTILLY ROSE (M Cameron).

When questioned regarding the performance of **DOMARCO** rider C Grylls advised that the gelding had tended to over-race when taken on for the lead in the early to middle stages, and in the straight had been unable to get as wide on the track as he would have liked for in his opinion the going was better, further adding that in his opinion **DOMARCO** would improve with the experience of its debut run today.

Race 8 DAVE, FRED & MICHAEL LAURICH 1200

RAKAUNUI (A Forbes) stumbled leaving the barriers shifting in making contact with **PEARLE LUSTRE** (C Grylls) which had begun awkwardly.

DRAGONKEEPER (M Cameron) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with COTERIE (B Hutton).

SUGAR PLUM FAIRY (M McNab) shifted in abruptly leaving the barriers crowding **HAPPY MAN** (D Turner) which lost ground.

EDWARD CHEVAL (T Thornton) had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **LE COUGUAR** (R Hutchings) which was racing ungenerously.

Passing the 700 metres the saddle shifted forward on **LE COUGUAR** putting rider R Hutchings in severe difficulty for the remainder of the race, and as a result **LE COUGUAR** was unable to be persevered with.

Approaching the 400 metres **ROSIE RULES** (M Du Plessis) when struck with the whip shifted out taking **SUGAR PLUM FAIRY** out on to **DUNCAN** (M Hills) which was forced out on to **EDWARD CHEVAL**. Shortly after **DUNCAN** was again crowded when **SUGAR PLUM FAIRY** shifted out and away from **ROSIE RULES** and inward movement from **EDWARD CHEVAL** which had to shift in to avoid the wing of the steeplechase fence.

Race 9 FRANK & ANNIE MATIJASEVICH MEMORIAL 1600

SEAMS LIKE MAGIC (R Hutchings) began awkwardly.

STAR MISS (J Oliver), **SOPHIE CLAIRE** (O Bosson), **KEEP IN TUNE** (M Du Plessis) and **KEEPA LADY** (D Hain) were all crowded to the inside of **ROSENELLIS** (S Spratt) shortly after leaving the barrier when that runner shifted away from **BELORUSSIYA** (D Turner).

Passing the 400 metres **MAEVE DAVONE** (A Forbes) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SEAMS LIKE MAGIC** which shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight. **SEAMS LIKE MAGIC** continued to race greenly shifting out further inconveniencing **KEEP IN TUNE**.

When questioned into the performance of the favourite **SOPHIE CLAIRE**, O Bosson stated that the mare did not handle today's existing track conditions.

Race 10 CRV AMBREED 160

GOIN TO THE CHAPEL (S Spratt) knuckled leaving the barrier.

SPORTAVIAN (M Tanaka) and **TAIHOA GOLD** (M Hills) were crowded shortly after leaving the barrier between **TUTANEKAI** (N Harris) and **JESSHANIMO** (R Hutchings).

Passing the 900 metres C'MON GEORGE (T Thornton) blundered.

Race 11 ERNIE MARTINOVICH 1600

BELLA CAVALLA (R Hutchings) and **TINKER ROSE** (T Thornton) came together leaving the barriers when both runners had begun awkwardly.

HOCHHAUS (C Grylls) was slow away.

LADY ROSETTA (M Cameron) began awkwardly and then was hampered by LIBERTY FIGHTER (C Dell) which shifted in.
