RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GOLDEN GRAIN 1400
MADAME MILLIE (S Collett), THE LINK (M Hills) and A L'ORANGE (M Cheung) all over-raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied. IMA PERFECT GUY (J Oliver) raced wide without cover. A L'ORANGE and TAVAKE (B R Jones) came together just short of the finish. J Oliver the rider of IMA PERFECT GUY was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 200 metres.	
Race 2	HORIZON ENERGY 2YO
DIVINE SHIVA (K Myers) was slow to begin. CRYSTALIGHT (L Allpress) raced wide without cover.	
Race 3	PRO-TEC ROOFING WHAKATANE LTD 3YO
LADY SAYYIDA (M Cameron) began awkwardly. ASSASSIN (M Hills) was a little slow to begin. CHEQUESINTHEMAIL (M Cheung) made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.	

KEEPIT (B Hutton shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres.	
Race 4	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION SPRINT
HULA BELLE (A Forbes) was slow away. AMBITIOUS PRINCE (M Cameron) began awkwardly. KAAP'S PRINCESS (M Wenn) began awkwardly and was further hampered when crowded shortly after leaving the barriers. WAINUI PRINCE (T Thornton) raced wide without cover throughout. HOT CHA (P Turner) shifted out under pressure in the final straight.	
Race 5	TEAM WEALLEANS 2100
Rider B R Jones (SERGIOS) reported to the Starter that after completing his preliminary and when turning around to proceed to the start the gelding appeared to have punched through an old rabbit hole. The start of this race was officially amended to 2.41 pm while remedial work was carried out. MANGAROA MISS (S Collett) was slow away. SAUCY PENNY (P Turner) began awkwardly, then shortly after shifted out crowding MANACOR (R Hutchings) and ARISE (K Myers), and contributing was inward movement from SERGIOS (B R Jones). Passing the 900 metres SKAI RULER (T Thornton) began to give ground quickly and went back on to LUCKY RUBY (M Sweeney) which had to steady and shift out across that runner's heels. Shortly after LUCKY RUBY was again hampered by TALOS (A Taylor) which was weakening when under pressure. SAUCY PENNY shifted out under pressure in the final straight. SKAI RULER underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have an irregular heart beat. Trainer S Wenn was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to SKAI RULER racing again. Mr Wenn indicated that he would not be persevering with SKAI RULER as a racing proposition. TALOS underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainer Mrs D Rogerson was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness including satisfactory ECG results following a trial would be required prior to TALOS racing next.	
Race 6	J SWAP CONTRACTORS LTD 1600
This race ran approximately 4 minutes late due to the delay in the previous race. NOTTOOBAD (S Collett) began awkwardly losing ground. SKY HI BABY (C Dell) shifted inwards leaving the barriers hampering DELACROIX (M Cameron) which lost ground. Near the 1300 metres SO BLING (T Thornton) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of MR CHEZ (A Taylor) which shifted in abruptly away from SLUMDOG MILLIONAIRE (T Wenn) which had been taken in slightly by JACK ROMANOV (A Forbes). A Forbes was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. CLAREEN (M Hills) over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 350 metres SLUMDOG MILLIONAIRE had to steady when crowded to the inside of CLAREEN which shifted in.	
Race 7	BOP MARQUEE & PARTY HIRE SPRINT
JUST JULIET (A Forbes) and BELLBIRD (R Hutchings) were slow away. ANNAMEIKA (L Allpress) raced ungenerously shortly after leaving the barriers and shifted out crowding MISS ZETA (T Wenn) out on to MR TRIXSTAR (C Dell) which was checked losing several lengths. ANNAMEIKA continued to race ungenerously making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly hampering CARMODY (B R Jones). Passing the 300 metres UMIZOOMI (P Turner) shifted in and away from ANNAMEIKA which was laying in under pressure. Passing the 200 metres COMMAND (A Taylor) shifted out under pressure taking ANNAMEIKA out into the line of BELLBIRD which became awkwardly placed on heels. ANNAMEIKA had to steady off the heels of COMMAND over the concluding stages which shifted out under pressure.	
Race 8	NEW WORLD WHAKATANE 1600
OH HOW BAZAAR (M Wenn) was struck by the side of its barrier stall when jumping away. REEPERBAHN (M Hills) shifted in leaving the barriers badly hampering SHE'LBLITZEM (B R Jones) which lost several lengths. DIKTATOR (K Myers) and OH HOW BAZAAR came together near the 1400 metres. REEPERBAHN over-raced in the early and middle stages. R Norvall the rider of ARCHIE was issued with a warning for unnecessary use of the whip on a runner that was not responding.
