## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>CENTRAL SI OWNERS &amp; TRAINERS ASSN HURDLE (3000m)</b>
<p>A Kuru was permitted to ride <b>WHAT A FIND</b> 1 kg over his declared riding weight due to the lack of available jumping riders. The number 6 gate was slow to open however the chances of <b>ARONSAY</b> were not affected with the gelding going on to win the race.</p> <p><b>FAREWELL FLIGHT</b> jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>MUZZA</b> tended to jump high throughout.</p> <p><b>WHAT A FIND</b> had to steady after jumping the fence passing the 2400 metres.</p> <p><b>AVID RULER</b> gave ground from the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>AVID RULER</b> was pulled up after jumping the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>GARGAMEL</b> made a poor leap at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>KEEP IT TIGHT</b> made a poor leap at the last fence when tiring, dislodging rider K Veenendaal. K Veenendaal was transferred to hospital and stood down for the mandatory three week period after losing consciousness, and will be required to produce a medical clearance prior to riding again. A post race veterinary inspection of <b>KEEP IT TIGHT</b> did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>SHaweigh Maiden Sprint (1200m)</b>

<p><b>TULLUMAYO</b> began awkwardly and got back as a result.  <b>BELT UP</b> and <b>TENNESSEE WHISKEY</b> raced keenly in the early stages.  <b>TULLUMAYO</b> raced wide throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S STEEPLECHASE (4280m)</b>
<p>K Veenendaal (injured) was replaced by M Cropp as the rider of <b>LAGERFELD</b>.  The start of this race was delayed due to the fence near the 1400 metres being closed off.  <b>PAKITIN PETE</b> tended to over race in the middle stages .  <b>WINNING GENES</b> dipped on landing at the fence by the 1000metres.  <b>PERFECT EXCUSE</b> dislodged rider G Walsh when making a faulty leap near the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection of <b>PERFECT EXCUSE</b> revealed the gelding to have a ruptured flexor tendon. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to <b>PERFECT EXCUSE</b> racing again. Rider G Walsh was attended to by St John Ambulance paramedics and cleared.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PATAPAN NOW STANDING AT BELMONT PARK RATING 65 (1200m)</b>
<p><b>INCONTROL</b> was late scratched at 2.15 pm on veterinary advice. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance must be produced prior to the filly racing next.  <b>MASTER CHIEF</b> and <b>TACTICALL</b> were slow to begin.  <b>DAVONE CODE</b> was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.  <b>TERELLE</b> lay inwards rounding the final bend having to be straightened and continued to lay in throughout the straight with the rider swapping whip hands.  <b>BARBERRY ROZE</b> raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY DASH RATING 85 (1200m)</b>
<p>As B Lammas was unable to make his contract weight on <b>THAT'SOUREXCUSE</b> he was replaced by R Hannam. B Lammas admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) with the JCA suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 4 days effective 16 to 20 July 2013 inclusive.  <b>LIGHT'S UP</b> was slow to begin.  <b>HEZA KOOL KAT</b> was hampered at the start when <b>THAT'SOUREXCUSE</b> shifted outwards.  <b>HEZA KOOL KAT</b> improved wide from the 900 metres.  <b>GOLDEN GLOBE</b> hung out rounding the home turn and continued to lay out in the final straight.  When questioned regarding the performance of <b>LIGHT'S UP</b>, rider C Johnson advised that the mare had felt lethargic throughout and despite his urgings over the concluding stages had failed to run on. A post race veterinary inspection of <b>LIGHT'S UP</b> did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>D'CASH MILE RATING 85 (1600m)</b>
<p><b>STELLA BELLA</b> raced wide in the early stages.  <b>KEEP THE COURAGE</b> improved wide from the 900 metres.  Passing the 300 metres <b>TRISTAN'S CHOICE</b> raced in restricted room until shifting ground outwards off the heels of <b>COAT OF ARMS</b> near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>PORT FM MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>QUEST FOR LUCK</b> raced keenly in the early stages.  <b>WHY WAIT</b> got its head up while being restrained when in restricted room passing the 1300 metres when <b>CONTADOR</b> shifted inwards on the point of the bend. Rider S Wynne was reminded of her obligations in regard to being clear when shifting ground. <b>CONTADOR</b> raced wide throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME STAYERS RATING 65 (2100m)</b>
<p><b>BRAEHILL</b> was hampered at the start when <b>FLYING SPORTSMAN</b> shifted in on jumping.  <b>TICKLE MY FANCY</b> raced wide throughout.  <b>BRAEHILL</b> raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.  <b>ALPINE PEARL</b> gave ground from the 800 metres to eventually finish in last position. Rider S Wynne reported that the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.  Passing the 400 metres <b>TICKLE MY FANCY</b> had to steady when in restricted room.</p>
