The number 6 gate was slow to open however the chances of ARONSAY were not affected with the gelding going on to win			
the race.

WHAT A FIND had to steady after jumping the fence passing the 2400 metres.			
AVID RULER gave ground from the 1100 metres.

TULLUMAYO began awkwardly and got back as a result. BELT UP and TENNESSEE WHISKEY raced keenly in the early stages. TULLUMAYO raced wide throughout.

Race 3 SPEIGHT'S STEEPLECHASE (4280m)

K Veenendaal (injured) was replaced by M Cropp as the rider of LAGERFELD.

The start of this race was delayed due to the fence near the 1400 metres being closed off.

PAKITIN PETE tended to over race in the middle stages .

WINNING GENES dipped on landing at the fence by the 1000metres.

PERFECT EXCUSE dislodged rider G Walsh when making a faulty leap near the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection of **PERFECT EXCUSE** revealed the gelding to have a ruptured flexor tendon. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to **PERFECT EXCUSE** racing again. Rider G Walsh was attended to by St John Ambulance paramedics and cleared.

Race 4 PATAPAN NOW STANDING AT BELMONT PARK RATING 65 (1200m)

INCONTROL was late scratched at 2.15 pm on veterinary advice. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance must be produced prior to the filly racing next.

MASTER CHIEF and **TACTICALL** were slow to begin.

DAVONE CODE was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.

TERELLE lay inwards rounding the final bend having to be straightened and continued to lay in throughout the straight with the rider swapping whip hands.

BARBERRY ROZE raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres.

Race 5 CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY DASH RATING 85 (1200m)

As B Lammas was unable to make his contract weight on **THAT'SOUREXCUSE** he was replaced by R Hannam. B Lammas admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) with the JCA suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 4 days effective 16 to 20 July 2013 inclusive.

LIGHT'S UP was slow to begin.

HEZA KOOL KAT was hampered at the start when THAT'SOUREXCUSE shifted outwards.

HEZA KOOL KAT improved wide from the 900 metres.

GOLDEN GLOBE hung out rounding the home turn and continued to lay out in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **LIGHT'S UP**, rider C Johnson advised that the mare had felt lethargic throughout and despite his urgings over the concluding stages had failed to run on. A post race veterinary inspection of **LIGHT'S UP** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 6 D'CASH MILE RATING 85 (1600m)

STELLA BELLA raced wide in the early stages.

KEEP THE COURAGE improved wide from the 900 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **TRISTAN'S CHOICE** raced in restricted room until shifting ground outwards off the heels of **COAT OF ARMS** near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 7 PORT FM MAIDEN (1600m)

QUEST FOR LUCK raced keenly in the early stages.

WHY WAIT got its head up while being restrained when in restricted room passing the 1300 metres when **CONTADOR** shifted inwards on the point of the bend. Rider S Wynne was reminded of her obligations in regard to being clear when shifting ground. **CONTADOR** raced wide throughout.

Race 8 ONCEUPONATIME STAYERS RATING 65 (2100m)

BRAEHILL was hampered at the start when FLYING SPORTSMAN shifted in on jumping.

TICKLE MY FANCY raced wide throughout.

BRAEHILL raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

ALPINE PEARL gave ground from the 800 metres to eventually finish in last position. Rider S Wynne reported that the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.

Passing the 400 metres **TICKLE MY FANCY** had to steady when in restricted room.
