RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Joy Scarfe Memorial 2100

MASTER IP (C Grylls) which had been fractious in its barrier stall began awkwardly hampering WHISTLING STRAITS (J McDonald).

SPICEY AS (R Smyth) raced three wide without cover around the first turn.

THE TERMINATOR (L Magorrian) and **SEED OF SPEED** (M Cameron) bumped near the 250 metres with **SEED OF SPEED** being inclined to lay in.

THE TERMINATOR rolled out rounding the final turn presenting a run for **MASTER IP** to its inside. L Magorrian was shown video footage in the presence of his employer Mr R James.

Race 2 Chilltech 1200

MAILLY (M Sweeney) was slow to begin before being further hampered by **RED LAMAR** (M Cameron) which shifted outwards abruptly when leaving the barriers.

NO REDEMPTION (P Taylor) began awkwardly losing ground.

RED LAMAR (M Cameron) hung outwards when weakening rounding the final turn hampering BORRETT BOY (M McNab)

and **DRAGONSTONE** (J Whiteside) which were both forced wider on the track.

HUMAN TORCH (O Bosson) shifted in slightly under pressure approaching the 200 metres making contact with **DELVEEN** (J McDonald) resulting in both those runners becoming unbalanced.

NO REDEMPTION was held up early in the final straight and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

Rider M Cameron was questioned into the performance of **RED LAMAR** and said that after beginning awkwardly had continued to hang throughout the race and also said that as the gelding was fresh up from a spell it would be expected to show improvement in its next race day start.

Race 3 Ship Repair NZ 1000

AFFOGATO (S Collett) and **DUNOON** (M Cameron) both began awkwardly and came together making heavy contact badly unbalancing Rider S Collett (**AFFOGATO**) who was dislodged from her mount.

EYE CONTACT (M Hills) shifted out when leaving the barriers hampering **CELTIC BOY** (B Hutton), which lost ground, and to a lesser degree **LIA** (P Taylor).

POSTD'OR (M Sweeney) was a shade slow to begin and was then hampered shortly after the start by the riderless horse.

Race 4 BBS Timbers 1000

JUST EVA (R Norvall) began a little awkwardly and then had to be steadied when crowded shortly after the start.

MAJARAR (P Taylor) had to be steadied away from the heels of **SAVE THE MELODY** (S Collett) approaching the 800 metres. Shortly after **SAVE THE MELODY** got its head up when being steadied dropping back on to **MAJARAR** which was further hampered.

SAVE THE MELODY again raced ungenerously when being restrained crossing the junction on to the Course Proper passing the 700 metres.

Near the 600 metres **CEDAR ROSE** (M Sweeney) had to be restrained off the heels of **GIRL OF MY DREAMS** (B Hutton). Near the 250 metres **SAVE THE MELODY** ducked inwards when Rider S Collett momentarily lost the use of her left rein.

COLOURS (L Innes) made contact with **DREAMER** (M Cameron) when laying in near the 50 metres.

Race 5 Hubands Heat Pumps & Airconditioning 1400

RULALINE (M Hills) shifted in when leaving the barriers bumping HENNESSY BLACK (L Innes).

Near the 1300 metres **CAST KING** (BR Jones) shifted in crowding **HENNESSY BLACK**, **OUR KISMET** (O Bosson), **MAIDEN WARRIOR** (M McNab), **LADY PHOENIX** (M Cameron), **ANOTHER EDITION** (P Taylor) and **ENCHARM** (M Sweeney) with **HENNESSY BLACK**, **OUR KISMET** and **ENCHARM** being the worst affected losing ground. Jockey BR Jones admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 27 July 2013 up to and including racing on 8 August 2013, 6 riding days.

RULALINE raced three wide without cover.

Approaching the 1000 metres **ANOTHER EDITION** got its head in the air and raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of **LADY PHOENIX** when the pace eased.

Passing the 1000 metres **CAST KING** and **MISS MEENA** (B Hutton) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **OUR KISMET** which was being steadied when the pace eased and shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of **RULALINE**. **MISS MEENA** then continued to race ungenerously for a short distance.

Race 6 Whangarei Aluminium 1400

TWIST OF FATE (BR Jones) was slow away.

ROYAL SCEPTRE (L Magorrian) began awkwardly.

ROYAL SCEPTRE which was recovering after beginning poorly had to be steadied off the heels of **DRAGONKEEPER** (M Cheung) which shifted in near the 1200 metres when not fully clear. M Cheung was advised to exercise care and ensure that he is fully clear when shifting ground in future.

SMEDLEY (S Collett) had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of **SUMOTORI** (B Hutton) going into the bend near the 800 metres. B Hutton was advised to exercise more care.

Passing the 550 metres **PERFECT KATCH** (M Cameron) steadied off the heels of **SMEDLEY** and went back on to **TWIST OF FATE** which had to be steadied.

PERFECT KATCH had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

COACHLINE (O Bosson) had difficulty obtaining clear running near the 150 metres and when shifting in attempting a marginal run to the inside of **DENMARK** (C Grylls) made contact with the hind quarters of **CLUBS CHOICE** (M Hills) which became unbalanced. O Bosson was issued with a warning.

TWIST OF FATE lost the near hind plate during the running.

GOYESCAS (J McDonald) and BOB VALDEZ (V Gatu) were slow to begin.

DESIGNACAT (R Smyth) began awkwardly.

OTTO THE GREAT (M Hills) began awkwardly from the outside barrier and shifted outwards abruptly in the initial strides.

OTTO THE GREAT over-raced in the middle stages and when being restrained hampered **LITTLE BUTTERFLY** (B Hutton) near the 1100 metres. Also inconvenienced was **BOY** (M Sweeney).

BOB VALDEZ raced three wide without cover.

GOYESCAS had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until inside the final 100 metres.
