RACE COMMENTS:

Woottons Auto Motor Scooter 1400 Race 1

BOGART (D Johnson) began awkwardly and then was inconvenienced by BITETHEBULLET (L Innes) which shifted out with **BOGART** then losing ground.

STRADA LASS (M Du Plessis) was a little awkward to begin.

Approaching the 1300 metres SAINT PIRAN (S Collett) commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained making contact with the hind quarters of JOEY JONZ (B Hutton) which then shifted out abruptly hampering GOIN TO THE CHAPEL (S Spratt) which was also racing ungenerously.

SAINT PIRAN and GOIN TO THE CHAPEL both raced ungenerously with GOIN TO THE CHAPEL shifting in passing the 1100 metres hampering SAINT PIRAN.

Passing the 900 metres JOEY JONZ ran wide when the rider dropped his whip forcing GOIN TO THE CHAPEL wider on the track.

Race 2 Tipple 1400

JANE LOUR (C Dell) began awkwardly.

ANAHEIM (S Spratt) began awkwardly shifting in inconveniencing **CEEBEEL** (R Hutchings).

BASSALEG (O Bosson) began a little awkwardly and then shifted out inconveniencing KEEPIT (B Hutton) which had to steady.

Shortly after the start **RIVA BALLERINA** (J Whiteside) shifted out when being struck with the whip inconveniencing **RANSOMLASS** (R Norvall) which had to steady.

RIVA BALLERINA, **PRIDE AND PASSION** (M Cameron), **ANAHEIM** and **RANSOMLASS** all over-raced in the early to middle stages with **RIVA BALLERINA** blundering approaching the 1000 metres.

ANAHEIM raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 400 metres **JANE LOUR** had to shift out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **RIVA BALLERINA**. Shortly after **JANE LOUR** again shifted out inconveniencing **LUCY BEE** (C Grylls).

Race 3	Crombie Lockwood 2200
SOLYN (P Turner)	and RED HOT (S Spratt) were slow to begin.
Race 4	Dan Sheahan 1200

BORN HAPPY (M Cheung) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **COOL QUEEN** (D Johnson) and then was further crowded when **GARDEN OF GOLD** (M Du Plessis) shifted in with **GARDEN OF GOLD** becoming unbalanced and **BORN HAPPY** then being hampered losing ground.

KEENTORULE (T Wenn) began awkwardly.

MRS BROWNS BOY (R Smyth) shifted in when leaving the barriers placing AFRICAN STAR (M Sweeney) in restricted room with that runner having to steady.

When making the bend passing the 900 metres **SENATORIAL** (L Innes) lay in despite the efforts of its rider crowding **MRS BROWNS BOY** on to **FINNYS GOLD** (B Hutton) with both those runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

Passing the 300 metres **BORN HAPPY** was crowded between **LEANA ME** (J Whiteside) and **FINNYS GOLD** both of which shifted ground before being corrected by their respective riders.

KEENTORULE shifted out under pressure over the final 200 metres dictating **GARDEN OF GOLD** wider on the track. Apprentice Jockey T Wenn admitted a breach of careless riding and after considering submissions, the judicial committee suspended her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 24 July, up to and including 1 August, 4 riding days.

BORN HAPPY lost the off fore plate during the running.

Race 5 Western Leader 1200

BLUE STREAK underwent a veterinary examination after arriving at the barriers and was cleared fit to run.

BLUE STREAK began awkwardly.

PRINCESS HOLLY (M Sweeney) was a little slow to begin.

ROSE TATTOO (M Cameron) lay in passing the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **OH EM GEE** (D Johnson).

Approaching the 600 metres **OH EM GEE** shifted out making contact with **ROSE TATTOO** which was taken wider on the track.

BLUE STREAK received veterinary attention for a minor laceration to the near side hock.
