BRAVE BUCCANEER (C Studd) began awkwardly, losing ground.				
BRAVE BUCCANEER was crowded between YAMANAURA (R Cully) and IT'S A MESSAGE (M Mitchell) when jumping the				
second fence.				
IT'S A MESSAGE put in a poor jump at the third and fifth fences.				
ST PICASSO (M Cropp) landed awkwardly after jumping the fourth fence.				
WINNIPEG (S Houston) jumped indifferently throughout becoming tailed off.				
SKAI GLEN (A Kuru) raced ungenerously approaching the last fence shifting in.				
XALTED (P Ormsby) and IT'S A MESSAGE both put in poor jumps at the last fence, losing momentum.				
Race 2	COOMBE & ASSOCIATES STEEPLECHASE			
THE ROSE (I Lupton) raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and was inclined to run down its fences throughout.				
MARVON DOWNS (S Phelan) put in a poor jump at the fifth fence, landing awkwardly.				
GENEROUS TYPE (G Walsh) landed awkwardly after jumping the sixth fence.				
GENEROUS TYPE put in a poor jump landing awkwardly at the 15 th fence.				
SNODROPTWINKLETOES (J Rathbone) put in a poor jump landing awkwardly at the second to last fence.				

GENEROUS TYPE was pulled up prior to jumping the final fence when out of contention. **GO JIMMY GO** (M Cropp) hit the final fence, landing awkwardly and losing momentum.

Race 3 WHYTELINE LTD STEEPLECHASE

O'CONNOR (A Kuru) put in a poor jump at the fifth fence, landing awkwardly.

ROSETOWN JOE (C Perrett) attempted to run off, before jumping the fence near the 1100 metres, falling. Hampered as a result were **TALLENTIRE** (S Phelan), **AT THE TOP** (I Lupton), **ROBERTY BOB** (C Studd), **O'CONNOR** and **DANE RULER** (M Mitchell). Rider C Perrett was transported to Waikato Hospital for further evaluation. C Perrett is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next. **ROSETOWN JOE** underwent a veterinary examination which found the gelding to be showing signs of lameness in the shoulder. Trainer W Lund is to provide a veterinary clearance for **ROSETOWN JOE** prior to the gelding racing next.

O'CONNOR landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence.

Race 4 K E HILL CONTRACTING 1150

Permission was given to co-trainer C Ormsby to race PASSING PARADE (O Bosson) in a tongue tie.

WICKEDLY (C Dell) and PASSING PARADE came together jumping away, losing ground.

VANILLA LAD (S Collett) began awkwardly, inconveniencing ALICE WEB ELLIS (K Chiong).

METALLIC (D Johnson) was slow away.

Approaching the 900 metres **MISS ZETA** (T Wenn) shifted out away from **BETTER KEEP UP** (P Turner) into the line of **HE'S MYN** (M Cameron) which became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels.

VANILLA LAD made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres when racing a little ungenerously.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ALICE WEB ELLIS** apprentice jockey K Chiong advised that the filly had not shown the early speed she had anticipated and had then raced greenly amongst the field for the remainder of the race. K Choing further advised **ALICE WEB ELLIS** may be now better suited to racing over more ground.

VANILLA LAD lost the off fore plate during the running.

Race 5 SUZUKI 1350

STELLA (B Hutton) and **CARTELORA** (M Sweeney) made contact leaving the barrier when both runners shifted ground. **SUGAR DADDY** (C Dell) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered when **KONTIKI** (O Bosson) shifted out abruptly with **SUGAR DADDY** losing ground.

BLACKWOOD (D Hain) over-raced in the middle stages.

FLASH FORWARD (S Collett) was inclined to lay out in the final straight.

Jockey O Bosson reported that **KONTIKI** had hung outwards throughout the race.

Race 6 GOLD FM 2100

KEEPA LADY (A Tata) was slow to begin, and was further hampered when **ATOMIC ROAD** (S MacNab) shifted in forcing **KOKANEE GOLD** (S Wenn) into that runner's line.

KEEPA LADY over-raced in the early stages.

Passing the 1400 metres **C'MON** (C Rusling) raced in restricted room to the inside of **SNEAKY SHAN** (A Barlow) which was taken in slightly by **ATOMIC ROAD**. As a result **C'MON** had to steady with **REAL TREASURE** (M Roustoby) then becoming awkwardly placed, clipping a heel and blundering. Footage of this incident proved inconclusive with rider S MacNab being advised to exercise greater care. As a result **REAL TREASURE** shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of **KOKANEE GOLD** which became unbalanced.

Approaching the 600 metres **REAL TREASURE** shifted out abruptly, forcing **RAISAFUASHO** (J McKay) over extra ground. M Roustoby was advised to exercise greater care.

RAISAFUASHO lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

KEEPA LADY lost the off front plate during the running.

Race 7 GOLDDIGGERS PAEROA 2100

CHLOE KEEPER (R Norvall) and LOCHWOOD (M Hills) both jumped away awkwardly. Crowded as a result was BEAU RANSOM (B Lammas).

TEQUILA AT MIDNITE (A Jones) raced three wide without cover throughout.

JACHIL (K Kalychurun) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Passing the 200 metres **CARADONNA** (B Hutton) shifted in to obtain clear running.

Race 8 THANK YOU ST JOHN PAEROA VOLUNTEERS 1670

POSTAGE (D Johnson) and WRECKING CREW (L Magorrian) were both slow to begin.

KING PANAMERA (R Smyth) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ALL ABOUT FUN (M Sweeney) shifted out over the concluding stages with **POSTAGE** having to be steadied away from that runner's heels. M Sweeney was advised to exercise greater care.

When questioned regarding the performance of **KING PANAMERA** apprentice jockey R Smyth advised that the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages, but had not responded as well as anticipated when placed under pressure passing the 600 metres and could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.
