RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DATACOMMS PLUS HURDLE 2900M
<p>APPLAUD and JAMAA began awkwardly. GOGINGA was slow. GOGINGA landed awkwardly after the jump near the 600 metres on the first round. JAMAA jumped indifferently in the early stages. HARVEST THE GOLD hit the fence near the 600 metres on the last round and lost ground.</p>	
Race 2	NORWOODS FARM MACHINERY PALMERSTON NORTH 2900M
<p>WEE BISKIT landed awkwardly at the second fence, unbalancing the rider and when being corrected shifted out forcing ZANE BAY over extra ground. AFFAIRE D'HONNEUR jumped the second fence awkwardly. AFFAIRE D'HONNEUR put in a poor jump at the fence near the 200 metres on the first round and tightened JULES VERNE. WEE BISKIT landed awkwardly at the fence near the 600 metres. JULES VERNE raced in restricted room on the fence near the winning post on the first occasion. RIPDIDDLER had to be eased near the 1500 metres when PAY THE FOX went to the front and shortened stride abruptly. RIPDIDDLER then shifted outwards hampering WEE BISKIT, which lost ground.</p>	

<p>PAY THE FOX and AFFAIRE D'HONNEUR were retired from the race prior to entering the final straight when well back and out of contention.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of AFFAIRE D'HONNEUR, rider M Mitchell reported that after two poor jumps in the initial stages the gelding lost its confidence.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance PAY THE FOX, rider S Phelan could offer no excuse.</p>	
Race 3	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY RONGOTEA AMATEUR 2100M
<p>Trainer D O'Leary was fined \$50.00 after presenting CARINYA to race without the notified blinkers.</p> <p>CARINYA jumped away awkwardly, inconveniencing MISTER DEEJAY.</p> <p>The saddle on CARINYA shifted forward near the 900 metres, placing rider K Petersen at a disadvantage for the remainder.</p> <p>Near the 200 metres MCCULLEY, STORM HOME and KRASE came together and bumped when positions became tight.</p> <p>SELAMAT was inclined to lug outwards throughout.</p> <p>M Fenwick, the rider of SELAMAT, was dislodged prior to weighing in.</p>	
Race 4	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY DANNEVIRKE STEEPLECHASE 4200M
<p>YORKIE jumped extravagantly in the early stages.</p> <p>DUMINY put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>YORKIE gave ground passing the 900 metres and was withdrawn from the race near the 600 metres when well back.</p> <p>OHOPEE landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 900 metres.</p> <p>BINKLEBONK was withdrawn after jumping the second to last fence when well beaten.</p>	
Race 5	NEW HOLLAND MAIDEN 2100M
<p>PARTY HORSE and BARMASAI were slow.</p> <p>ALLEZ ROSE was inclined to race greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 6	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY HOROWHENUA 1400M
<p>BY THE POWERS over raced in the early and middle stages and near the 900 metres, shifted out forcing POCKET ACES over extra ground.</p> <p>INNUENDO was inclined to shift ground under pressure throughout the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of WINTER CAT which ran last, rider B Grylls said the filly was comfortable in the going and had no excuse.</p>	
Race 7	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY MARTON 1200M
<p>ST'RUTH was slow to begin.</p> <p>SAGRANTINO raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SAGRANTINO lugged out throughout the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of DISCO INFERNO, rider M Cameron had no excuse.</p>	
Race 8	NORWOOD AGRICULTURE EQUIPMENT HANDICAP 1400M
<p>FAIR SCRIPT began very awkwardly losing ground (5L).</p> <p>D'TOP began awkwardly.</p> <p>SPORTS COAT got its head up shortly after the start when being restrained. SPORTS COAT raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SEDUCER had to change ground outward to improve near the 200 metres when ZENNO ROLLS ROYCE (M Dravitzki) shifted in. M Dravitzki was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of CALEY ROSE, which finished well back, rider M Cameron advised that the mare would be better suited to a more rain affected going.</p>	
Race 9	KUBOTA MAIDEN 1600M
<p>SHANGHAI LIL jumped away awkwardly, inconveniencing SERGEANT LINCOLN.</p> <p>FALSE EMPATHY was slow to begin.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of PARTY ROCK, rider B Lammas was of the opinion that the gelding was unsuited to today's heavy track conditions.</p>	

Rider L Isherwood (**LOVETOKEEP'ER**) was issued with a warning regarding the use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.
