RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HIGHBURY PARK STUD 2YO

BABILLONI (B R Jones) and EN'JOYOUR LINDAUER (J Oliver) were both slow to begin.

ABBEY ROSE (M Sweeney) hung out in the early and middle stages.

RESULT MERCHANT (D Hain) raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 CLASSIC HITS WITH PAUL & RACHEL IN THE MORNING '1230'

MISS GRACE (B Lammas) was slow to begin.

TWIST OF FATE (B R Jones) shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier, hampering **OUTSIDE CENTRE** (M Sweeney) which lost ground.

I'M A CITY GIRL (J Oliver) raced wide without cover throughout.

JUST JACK (R Hutchings) hung out, throughout the race.

SUBRIDEO (R Stam) shifted out approaching the 250 metres inconveniencing I'M A CITY GIRL.

When questioned regarding the performance of **JUST JACK** apprentice jockey R Hutchings advised that the gelding had raced greenly at its debut with a tendency to hang.

Race 3	CHAPMANS RUFFFT AT HOLIDAY INN ROTORUA '1230'

SINGLE GLANCE (A Forbes) underwent a veterinary examination after arriving at the barrier and was declared a late

scratching at 1.52 pm on veterinary advice as the filly was showing signs of lameness in the near foreleg.

RICH N' ROSES (J Whiteside) and CAST KING (B R Jones) were both slow to begin.

SOLSTAR (B Lammas) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with MAA CHUCK (M Sweeney).

Approaching the 800 metres **BORN HAPPY** (M Cheung) made the bend awkwardly shifting out and hampering **MAA CHUCK** which lost ground.

CAST KING raced wide without cover throughout.

CAST KING was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.

BORN HAPPY returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. A post-race veterinary examination found the blood to be consistent with a laceration to the nostril.

Race 4 PROGRAMMED PROPERTY SERVICES '1230'

HEY BRUCE (S Collett) and **HUG A GINGA** (R Hutchings) were both slow to begin.

BRONDAN (M Hills) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Jockey L Allpress reported that **MY BLOSSOM LADY** had been irregular in its breathing with the mare then undergoing a veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities. Trainer G Richardson undertook to report to Stewards anything that may become apparent in days subsequent.

Race 5 ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS '1400'

HAPPY MAN (K Myers) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LADY OF TROY (M Sweeney) was inclined to lay out throughout the race.

A Taylor (RIVELATORE) dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

Race 6 NZI '1950'

MADLY BENTLEY (T Thornton) shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier making contact with **ANDROID** (L Allpress) forcing that runner out on to **YANGMING** (K Myers) which lost ground.

Passing the 1900 metres **LE BON FIN** (B R Jones) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **GEE OH** (R Hutchings) which shifted in, and as a consequence shifted out, into the line of **ANDROID** which was hampered.

YANGMING raced keenly in the early and middle stages, and had a tendency to lay outwards rounding the final turn.

Passing the 300 metres **ANDROID** had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of **AMANPULO** (A Taylor) which was dictated out by **SEIGAL** (D Walker).

Apprentice jockey A Taylor reported that **AMANPULO** had not felt entirely comfortable during the running. **AMANPULO** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormalities other than evidence of a significant amount of dirt in the nasal area.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ANDROID** rider L Allpress advised that the mare had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

Race 7 ESCAPE TO RYDGES ROTORUA '2200'

CHARLIE'S ANGEL (M Hills) was slow to begin.

GOGINGA (B R Jones) jumped away awkwardly.

VIKING CHIEF (L Allpress) raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 1800 metres.

REVENGE (A Forbes) raced wide without cover in the early stages.

Approaching the 400 metres **VIKING CHIEF** improved into a marginal run to the inside of **SECOND IN COMMAND** (R Smyth) which then lay in, before being corrected. **KOKANEE GOLD** (J Oliver) which was racing to the inside of **VIKING CHIEF** was then severely crowded making contact with the running rail and losing ground. The Stewards were satisfied the actions of **SECOND IN COMMAND** were beyond apprentice jockey R Smyth's control.
