Race 7 – McMillan Equine Feeds Rating 65 1250m

B Lammas the rider of **HAILES ABBEY** defended a charge under Rule 649(1)(a) in that he did a wrongful act with respect to weighing by changing from a light pair of boots, in which he weighed out, in to a heavy pair of boots after weighing out. The JCA found the charge proved and after submissions on penalty suspended B Lammas's licence to ride in races for a period of two weeks effective 13 August to 26 August 2013 (inclusive) and in addition imposed a fine of \$300.

#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	SPEIGHT'S PREMIER HURDLE (3100m)			
RIPDIDDLER and FAITES VOS JEUX both put in a poor leap over the 2900 metre hurdle.				
<b>RIPDIDDLER</b> made contact with the jump passing the 800 metres.				
Race 2	ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ LINWOOD PARK STUD PREMIER (2000m)			
<b>RED MAGIC</b> was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres.				
Passing the 150 metres GAGARIN and OUR ALCHEMIST bumped.				
Race 3	GLADSOME LODGE PREMIER (1400m)			

**TERELLE** raced keenly in the early stages.

**THAT'SOUREXCUSE** hung outwards badly from the 600 metres, raced very wide in the straight and was eased down. Trainer L Latta was advised the gelding will be required to trial before racing again. A post-race veterinary inspection of **THAT'SOUREXCUSE** did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

D Walsh, the rider of **BLACK BERRY PUNCH**, reported that his mount hung outwards in the straight and proved difficult to ride out.

Race 4 ZILCO PREMIER (1250m)

**REDFERN** and **HEZA KOOL KAT** were slow to begin.

**REGALIA** raced wide throughout.

Race 6

**FIDDLER'S GREEN** raced in restricted room rounding the turn and passing the 250 metres was held up for a short distance. Rider H Tinsley stated that **FIDDLER'S GREEN** had been reluctant to run on when in tight quarters early in the final straight however when presented with clear racing room passing the 200 metres had run on well.

When questioned regarding the run of **UNBELIEVEABELLE**, rider K Myers was unable to offer any tangible excuse for the performance and stated that the mare was disappointing.

Race 5 BRACKENFIELD HUNT PREMIER OPEN (1400m)

B Lammas was replaced on **TICK TOCK TURBO** by D Bradley after B Lammas was unable to lose the required weight due to being required in a judicial hearing. In the circumstances the Stewards determined that no action would be taken against Mr Lammas on this occasion.

KHEMOSABI was inclined to lay out under pressure over the final 250 metres.

**ELUSIVE TRACY** compounded over the concluding stages being distanced at the finish. A veterinary examination revealed **ELUSIVE TRACY** to have suffered an arterial fibrillation. Trainer A Bidlake was advised that a veterinary clearance, including a satisfactory ECG examination, would be required prior to the mare next racing.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of **KHEMOSABI**, trainer P Gordon advised in his opinion the gelding had benefited from the shorter distance of today's event and the back-up from racing last Saturday.

RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 139<sup>TH</sup> GRAND NATIONAL STEEPLECHASE (5600m)

**SNODROPTWINKLETOES** commenced to race fiercely after jumping the first fence proving difficult to settle for some distance.

**KIDUNOT** lost ground at the fence near the 4500 metres.

**HONEY** landed awkwardly at the jump near the 2000 metres.

WAITAHA TOA was inclined to over race in the middle stages.

**KIDUNOT** got in close and misjudged the second of the double near the 1200 metres, unbalancing the rider for a short distance.

**HONEY** dipped on landing at the fence near the 1000 metres and lost ground.

**EL PATRON** landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 800 metres, unbalancing the rider.

THE ROSE hung out under pressure rounding the final bend and in the final straight.

KARLOS suffered an injury to the right front cannon bone and was attended to by the course veterinarian.

M Mitchell (**CAPE KINAVERAL**) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the final 200 metres. After consideration the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Stewards filed an information with the Judicial Committee in regard to rider I Lupton's use of the whip on **BRUSHMAN** prior to the 200 metres, however due to I Lupton leaving the course without permission the matter has been adjourned to a time and date to be fixed.

A Kuru (KARLOS) was issued with a warning in respect of use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

# Race 7 HeatStore PREMIER (1600m)

SUPERTURF shifted out on jumping crowding WILLY DUGGAN out onto PENCURI which was hampered.

AL ASKAN began awkwardly and was slow away.

COAT OF ARMS raced keenly in the early stages.

**WILLY DUGGAN** hung out under pressure in the final straight and near the 100 metres shifted out crowding **SUPERTURF**. When questioned regarding the run of **GOLDEN MISS**, rider K Myers could offer no tangible reason for the performance.

# Race 8 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO WINTER CLASSIC (1800m)

**NEGOTIATE** was slow to begin.

When questioned regarding the run of **INTRANSIGENT**, rider D Walsh reported that, in his view, the impost of 59 kgs had been disadvantageous to the gelding's chances.

When questioned regarding the run of THRIVE, rider K Myers could offer no tangible excuse for the performance.

When questioned regarding the run of **RISING TIDE**, rider J Riddell advised that the gelding was unsuited to the holding nature of the track and in his opinion would appreciate greater distance.

Race 9 VERNON & VAZEY PREMIER (1800m)

AMIGO was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers when KERRYTOWN LADY shifted in.

GOSSIP GIRL was crowded and buffeted for several strides passing the 450 metres between KERRYTOWN LADY and GOOD

# ONE GLADY.

**BELLE D'OR** raced in restricted room for the majority of the final straight and only obtained clear running passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **CISKAY**, rider D Walker advised that his mount was under pressure a long way out and failed to respond in the straight. A post-race veterinary inspection of CISKAY revealed no obvious abnormalities.
