## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS 2200M</b>
<p><b>BEEBEE STAR</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>LEAPER FAITH</b> over-raced in the early stages and got its head up on several occasions when being restrained.</p> <p>Approaching the winning post on the first round <b>BEEBEE STAR (B Lammas)</b> hung out forcing <b>LEAPER FAITH</b> in to the line of <b>BEAU ZED</b> which had to restrain and shift out wider to avoid heels. When being corrected <b>BEEBEE STAR</b> shifted inwards in to the line of <b>HUCKSTER</b> which had to steady off heels. B Lammas was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p><b>JACHIL</b> raced keenly throughout when wide so was taken forward near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>LEAPER FAITH</b> was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MARKHAMS 1650M</b>
<p><b>TUI TEKA</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MAROTIRI LAD</b> raced keenly through the early and middle stages when leading.</p> <p><b>TUI TEKA</b> was held up rounding the turn.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of <b>LOTTO</b> Rider J Rathbone said the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages and was comfortable in the going, but when placed under pressure passing the 500 metres struggled to improve and despite shifting ground in the home straight bumping with <b>BE YOURSELF</b> on at least two occasions, was disappointing and had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection of <b>LOTTO</b> revealed a slow recovery rate.</p>	

<b>SONNY BEN</b> shifted out under pressure in the home straight but was clear of other runners.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>FOREST OWNER MARKETING SERVICES 1200M</b>
<p><b>MARKS</b> began awkwardly and was slow away. A short distance further near the 800 metres <b>SALLYMONT JEU</b> shifted in abruptly when racing greenly and hampered <b>MARKS</b> for a short distance.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of <b>MARKS</b> Rider D Walker said that despite the colt's tendency to hang it failed to finish the race off and was disappointing.</p> <p>The rider of <b>SALLYMONT JEU</b> (M Hudson) dropped her whip at the top of the home straight.</p> <p>Trainer K Myers presented <b>DELZZUP</b> in the enclosure prior to the race in work shoes which are not permitted. Permission was given to K Myers to allow <b>DELZZUP</b> to race without plates under Rule 613 (d). K Myers admitted a breach of Rule 613 (d) and was fined the sum of \$200.</p> <p><b>DELZZUP</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination revealed a cut to the nostril.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MCCARTHY TRANSPORT 1200M</b>
<p><b>I AM LEO</b> reared at the start losing ground.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>KITTY RUSSELL</b> shifted out and away from <b>I AM LEO</b> and in doing so became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>PIHA</b> and lost ground.</p> <p><b>I AM LEO</b> commenced to over-race in the back straight and when being restrained near the 800 metres shifted in and made contact with the running rail on several occasions. <b>I AM LEO</b> then had to steady off the heels of <b>RAMPANTEXCUSE</b> for some distance rounding the turn.</p> <p><b>PIHA</b> (J Parkes) made the final turn awkwardly when racing greenly. Rider J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding was now looking for a longer distance.</p> <p><b>SALUTE ME</b> shifted out under pressure in the home straight.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ALEXANDER CONTRACTING 1400M</b>
<p><b>HOSTAGE</b> was slow to begin and settled back.</p> <p><b>JOJO</b> (D Turner) hung outwards in the home straight, finishing wide on the track which resulted in <b>LASTING TOUCH</b> and <b>HOSTAGE</b> having to change ground inward to improve near the finish. Apprentice Jockey D Turner was advised that although his mount was hanging outwards he is expected to make more of an effort to straighten when in similar circumstances in future.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of <b>HOSTAGE</b>, Rider R Hutchings advised that his instructions were to settle the mare back which had been its racing pattern at its most recent starts where it had got back and run on over the final stages. R Hutchings advised that his chances of finishing closer may have been affected after being forced wide when attempting to improve rounding the turn and early in the home straight.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>LOADERS WANGANUI 1400M</b>
<p><b>CAMEO LASS</b> raced four-wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 1,200 metres <b>COASTAL MIST</b> when racing keenly had to restrain off the heels of <b>KING NERO</b> for a short distance.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of <b>KING NERO</b>, Rider M Dravitzki was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track.</p> <p><b>COASTAL MIST</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in a nostril. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a cut to the nostril consistent with having hit the front of its gate.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>FOREST OWNER MARKETING SERVICES 1400M</b>
<p><b>GOLDYSOX</b> was crowded leaving the barriers and lost ground when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>LADY CHAOS</b> raced keenly towards the end of the back straight.</p> <p><b>ALVIN PURPLE</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>GOLDYSOX</b> made the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CASSIE ANNE</b> (R Hutchings) was held up early in the home straight and when being taken wide in search of a clear run hampered <b>LADY CHAOS</b> forcing that runner over extra ground. Rider R Hutchings was shown footage of his ride and issued with a warning.</p>
