Race 1	Avondale Supporters Club 2100
<p>SAINT PIRAN (T Harris) shifted out when leaving the barriers inconveniencing LOCHWOOD (M Cropp) which was forced on to BELLA CAVALLA (D Nolan).</p> <p>LOCHWOOD was inclined to get its head up when over-racing on a slow pace through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>GOOGLE ME (A Ihaka) lay out rounding the final turn.</p> <p>TOMMY RIKI (S Phelan) shifted ground under pressure near the 100 metres and when being corrected inconvenienced ISTIMAGIC (C Studd) near the 50 metres.</p>	
Race 2	Tulloch Café 1400
<p>TRADING PLACES (S Spratt) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ANOTHER EDITION (T Thornton) began awkwardly with FULL COUNT (O Bosson) shifting away from that runner hampering ZAH BIG BOY (S Collett).</p> <p>JOEY JONZ (B Hutton) began awkwardly.</p> <p>JOEY JONZ raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1100 metres and shifted out into the line of AEROSPACE (R Hutchings) which was hampered.</p> <p>FALCON REGIMENT (C Grylls) raced keenly in the lead down the back straight getting its head up and racing ungenerously</p>	

when being restrained to trail near the 900 metres.

JOEY JONZ raced greenly in the final straight being inclined to shift out abruptly when struck with the whip having to be straightened on numerous occasions.

Race 3	Congratulations Lauren Boyle

RIVER CITY (A Forbes) was slow to begin.

NO REDEMPTION (M Cameron) began awkwardly making contact with **LUCY BEE** (S Spratt).

ANAHEIM (O Bosson) began awkwardly and shifted in forcing **SENATORIAL** (L Innes) on to **NO REDEMPTION** and **LUCY BEE** which were further hampered.

ROYAL ENCHANTRESS (S Collett) raced three wide without cover.

RIVER CITY had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

AMARLIA (R Smyth) made slight contact with **GARDEN OF GOLD** (M Du Plessis) when shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **NO REDEMPTION** Rider M Cameron advised that after suffering interference at the start the mare had raced greenly throughout and he recommended to the connections that they consider the application of blinkers.

Race 4	La-Z-Boy 1200

KING PANAMERA (R Smyth) and **SPRINGLOADED** (T Thornton) both began awkwardly.

KING PANAMERA raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres getting its head up.

KING PANAMERA then made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly and continued to race ungenerously shifting out across the heels of **BLUE STREAK** (M Du Plessis) hampering **SPRINGLOADED** which was forced wider on the track.

BLUE STREAK hung outwards rounding the bend.

KING PANAMERA ducked inwards abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 50 metres.

Race 5	Takanini Feeds 2100

RED HOT (C Studd) was slow to begin.

SECOND IN COMMAND (C Dell) made the first turn near the 1800 metres awkwardly and shifted out hampering **REVENGE** (T Harris).

REGALO REAAL (A Ihaka) raced wide without cover until near the 1500 metres.

PHEROZARDO (A Kuru) raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

CURRENCY SPIKE (M Mitchell) lay out under pressure early in the straight crowding **BEAU RANSOM** (M Cropp) on to the hind quarters of **REGALO REAAL** near the 300 metres. As a result **REGALO REAAL** was turned inwards with all three runners buffeting for a short distance. M Mitchell was issued with a warning. Further inquiries are to be made into the conduct of Rider A Ihaka during the investigation into the incident.

AROSE (D Nolan) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until shifting out near the 100 metres with **BOLD RANSOM** (R Hutchings) then shifting away from **AROSE** inconveniencing **PHEROZARDO**.

Race 6	Ivan Sapich Memorial 2100

TED'LL DO (C Dell) began awkwardly inconveniencing **CARBIDE** (M Cameron).

GO JOELI (B Hutton) raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned into the performance of the favourite **OTTO THE GREAT** Rider M Hills stated that the horse travelled well but once into the final straight failed to respond when placed under pressure. The gelding underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 7	Westbrook Winery 1200

SUN HAVEN (S Spratt) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **WHO SAID** (O Bosson) which then shifted in forcing **FREE DRINKS** (D Johnson) in on to **CHUCKY'S BRIDE** (B Hutton) which had to steady losing ground.

YEAH BRO (P Taylor) was slow away.

CERULEAN over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the 1000 metres **FAIRY CAKE** (C Grylls) had to be steadied off the heels of **BIG VOICES** (M Cameron) which shifted in. **FAIRY CAKE** then continued to race ungenerously for a distance.

MAHBEER raced fiercely in the early stages with Rider R Smyth having difficulty restraining the gelding which clipped a heel and blundered passing the 800 metres. **MAHBEER** then continued to race wide for the remainder of the race.

YEAH BRO raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages and had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **SUN HAVEN** shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of **MAHBEER** which became briefly unbalanced.

Passing the 400 metres **CERULEAN** (T Thornton) when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with **YEAH BRO**.

WHO SAID and **SUN HAVEN** both shifted out under pressure over the final 200 metres.
