Race 1	DRAKE MEDOX 1600			
ROMEO WHISKEY (B Hutton) was slow away (2L).				
JESSHANIMO (A Forbes) and ROMEO WHISKEY both over-raced in the middle stages.				
RAP N TAP (R Norvall) raced three wide without cover throughout.				
GOOGLE ME (M Du Plessis) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of CALL THE SHOTS (T Thornton) near the 800 metres.				
RED STORM (S Spratt) was held up passing the 400 metres.				
GOOGLE ME was briefly held up near the 300 metres.				
JESSHANIMO shifted out under pressure hampering MITZI MITOSIS (R Hutchings) near the 300 metres. A Forbes was				
issued with a warning.				
When questioned into the performance of the favourite BACH rider M Wenn felt that when the pace quickened once they				
passed the 400 metres the gelding was left a little flat footed, but finished the race off well.				
After questioning senior riders it was the consensus view that Slow 9 was still the most appropriate description.

PASSING PARADE (J Parkes), SUNBEAM (M Coleman) and DUBLIN (K Chiong) were all slow to begin.

POGUE (S Collett) over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

CELTIC BOY (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover throughout.

COURIER (B Grylls) shifted out under pressure passing the 350 metres making slight contact with **OFFANGONE** (R Smyth) on a couple of occasions.

After further consultation with senior riders the track was upgraded to Slow 8.

Race 3 THE PARISH FUNDRAISER 1200

MELODY CELEBRE (J Whiteside) and ROSE TATTOO (S Spratt) were both slow to begin.

SAVANNAH AL JAMAL (P Taylor) lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 4 GRAEME THOMSON ANTIQUE JEWELLERY 2200

BUCKLES (N Harris) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering **MASTER MICHAEL** (B Hutton) and **XALTED** (J Parkes) which both lost ground.

BROMPTON (M Cheung) was slow to begin and over-raced in the early stages.

BUCKLES had to be checked passing the winning post on the first occasion when **LITTLE MATEY** (P Turner) shifted in. When being checked **BUCKLES** shifted out on to **XALTED** which also had to be checked. Also hampered in this incident were **IRENE ALICE** (T Thornton) and **BAHHTON** (R Hutchings). P Turner admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 12 August until the conclusion of racing on 21 August 2013 (5 riding days).

Near the 400 metres **JACK ROMANOV** (A Forbes) shifted out away from **JUST GOT HOME** (B Grylls) forcing **STAGEHAND** (M Du Plessis) and **BUCKLES** wider on the track with **BUCKLES** shifting into the line of **BAHHTON** which was hampered.

P Turner (LITTLE MATEY) dropped his whip passing the 250 metres.

Race 5 COLLIERS INTERNATIONAL 2100

SOLYN (P Turner) began awkwardly.

TE KINGI (J Parkes) and REGALO REAAL (M Du Plessis) were both slow away.

ROSEVALE (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover.

ROSEVALE lay out rounding the final turn and continued to lay out under pressure in the final straight finishing wide on the track.

MAHARISHI (S Collett) shifted out under pressure inconveniencing **A SOLDIERS SONG** (T Thornton) passing the 300 metres.

Race 6 PROFESSIONALS OSBORNE REALTY LTD 1400

B Foote the trainer of **GINJA NINJA** was charged under Rule 537(a) for late declaration of rider and was fined the sum of \$100.

JOHN GRAY (T Thornton) was crowded on jumping away due to runners on either side shifting ground.

SHINING ARMOUR (B Hutton) put its head in the air when being restrained in the early stages.

MATOST (L Innes) lay out rounding the top bend.

JOHN GRAY raced keenly in the middle stages.

S Spratt was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 17 August until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24 August, 4 riding days, after admitting a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that she used the whip excessively on her mount **CORNELIUS** prior to the 200 metres. In assessing penalty the Judicial Committee took into account Ms Spratt's poor record.

M Du Plessis was fined \$200 after admitting a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used the whip excessively on his mount **THE FLYING AFFAIR** prior to the 200 metres.

Race 7 VETERINARY ASSOCIATES EQUINE & FARM 1600

BEVERLEY BECK (R Norvall) began awkwardly.

LADY OF TROY (S Collett) shifted out leaving the barriers forcing **KUWAIT** (B Hutton) out on to **DANCE** (M Du Plessis) which was hampered.

DANCE over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the 300 metres **DANCE** when shifting in to obtain clear running made contact with **ROSIE RULES** (B Grylls) which then raced in restricted room for a short distance.

KUWAIT was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 COLLETT/MCRAE RACING STABLES 1600

FINANCIAL TERRORIST was a late scratching at 3.09 pm on veterinary advice after sustaining lacerations to the near hind leg en route to the races.

RAFA (R Smyth) and PLAYBOY (B Grylls) were slow to begin.

MAREKA MISS (K Leung) had to be steadied away from the heels of MOVE FASTER (J Parkes) shortly after jumping

away.

PLAYBOY over-raced in the early stages and raced ungenerously when being restrained off heels near the 1200 metres. **PLAYBOY** continued to over-race through the middle stages.

LION RED (B Hutton) shifted outwards under pressure over the final 150 metres.

NUKUMAI (P Taylor) was crowded between **SWEET RITA** (M McNab) and **NANCYLEE** (L Innes) near the 100 metres when both those runners shifted ground.

J Parkes was fined \$250 after admitting a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used the whip excessively on his mount **MOVE FASTER** prior to the 200 metres.
