Rider S Doyle reported that **KITCH** hung out for the final 800 metres.

Race 3

BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL FILLIES AND MARES 1400M

GOLDEN SHELLS raced without a back plate after it became dislodged behind the barrier prior to the start. **SINGLE GIRL** was slow to begin.

TULLYHO and I'M BELLA began awkwardly.

MRS CLOONEY raced three wide without cover over the final 800 metres.

KAYZED was held up near the 500 metres and obtained clear running entering the final straight near the 350 metres. When questioned regarding the run of **LUCY LINCOLN**, rider B Grylls stated that after being obliged to race three wide in the early and middle stages, the mare had to work hard to maintain its position from near the 800 metres and had little left in the Heavy10 over the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **POCKET ACES**, rider J Parkes was unable to offer any excuse.

Race 4 BEALE TRUCKING LIMITED DASH 1200M

HERECOMESTHEBRIDE began awkwardly and lost ground.

THE BOUNCER had to be steadied near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **HONEY QUEEN**, which shifted in.

JOE BONANNO was obliged to race wide without cover over the final 800 metres.

Rider K Smith reported that **ARCHANGEL** hung out over the final 800 metres and could not be fully tested throughout the final straight.

Race 5 WENHAM GRAIN AND SEED 1200M

DAUFINO and THE GREAT WHITE came together and bumped shortly after the start.

DAUFINO race three wide without cover throughout.

ANNIESSTAR, when racing keenly, became awkwardly placed on the heels of DORIAN near the 900 metres.

T Russell (ANNIESSTAR) was advised to exercise care after shifting out near the 150 metres, inconveniencing THE GREAT WHITE.

When questioned into the run of THE GREAT WHITE, rider D Walsh advised that the gelding hung throughout.

Race 6 SMITH ENGINEERING SPRINT 1200M

MINYARNA, was crowded on jumping away when QUAKE shifted out.

ARIBASAN was slow to begin.

When questioned into the run of NIGHTCLUBS, rider J Riddell could offer no excuse.

QUAKE shifted out under pressure near the finish.

TIKVAH raced wide without cover throughout.

R Hannam, rider of **ROSE AND CROWN**, reported the filly to be comfortable in the going but lacked concentration and in his opinion may benefit with the addition of blinkers.

Race 7 WHARITI MEATS 2011 LIMITED STAYERS 2100M

ALLEZ ROSE was slow to load and connections were advised that a warning will be placed on ALLEZ ROSE with regard to its barriers manners.

ZEDEEDUDADEEKO shifted in abruptly at the start hampering **THE DOLPHIN**.

ALLEZ ROSE shifted out abruptly at the start, hampering BEEBEE STAR, which became unbalanced.

JABEZ was obliged to race wide throughout.

BEEBEE STAR when being angled outwards near the straight entrance forced FRED FLINSTONE wide on the track.

A post-race veterinary examination of ALLEZ ROSE revealed no abnormalities. Race 8 MANAWATU AUTO GLASS AND GLAZING LIMITED HANDICAP 1

Race 8MANAWATU AUTO GLASS AND GLAZING LIMITED HANDICAP 1600MTrainer H Matthews was fined \$50 under Rule 616(2) after presenting GET THE MESSAGE without notified gear (blinkers).

SIR COSWORTH began awkwardly and lost ground.

GET THE MESSAGE raced wide without cover throughout.

TIDAL WAVE hung out throughout the final straight and passing the 200 metres shifted out abruptly, having to be straightened by its rider.

When questioned regarding the performance of **INNUENDO**, rider R Hutchings reported the gelding was unsuited to the track.
