RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ITM PASLODE 1200M

SHE'S SLINKY was crowded on jumping away.

O'RIGHT ZEN began awkwardly shifted in and hampered SHE'S SLINKY.

SNOW EXCUSE began awkwardly and was further hampered when runners either side shifted ground.

TALK THE TORQUE over raced in the early and middle stages.

FOR PETESAKE raced three wide without cover throughout.

D Turner the rider of **TALK THE TORQUE** was advised to exercise care after when shifting out on the point of the turn, momentarily hampered the weakening **O'RIGHT ZEN**.

R Hutchings reported that **SNOW EXCUSE** got its tongue over the bit during the running.

D Johnson the rider of **O'RIGHT ZEN** was reminded of her obligations with regard to a runner out of contention.

Race 2 SPORTYS BAR & CAFÉ 1600M

CISKAY was slow to begin and was further hampered when **DEFENCITI** shifted in.

CORNELIUS blundered on jumping away

ISHIAROSE raced three wide without cover over the early and middle stages prior to being allowed to stride forward near the 800 metres.

When questioned into the run of **LA STELLINA** rider K Smith had no tangible excuse other than the mare may have been unsuited to the heavy going near the rail. K Smith was also reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of a whip on a horse out of contention.

Race 3 ITM BLUM 1400M

RAMPANTEXCUSE and **EKKO BEECHES** came together and bumped heavily at the start, resulting in **EKKO BEECHES** becoming unbalanced, losing momentum and settling back.

I SUGGEST began awkwardly and lost ground.

When questioned regarding the run of **GENERAL LEE** rider M Du Plessis reported the gelding had travelled comfortably in the going however when pressured passing the 600 metres, failed to run on and was disappointing. The Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of **GENERAL LEE** which failed to reveal any abnormality.

When questioned regarding the run of **DUKE OF DIRK**, apprentice rider B Grylls reported her mount was unsuited to the heavy track.

GENERAL LEE became fractious after being loaded into the barriers. Rider M Du Plessis admitted a misconduct charge under Rule 340 in that he struck **GENERAL LEE** about the head with his foot after being loaded into the barrier. After considering all relevant matters the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 4 ITM WINSTONE WALLBOARD 1400M

FLOOZIE CAT shifted in on jumping away, crowding NGAWHINI and KATIE MCKEEN which lost ground.

STELLA began awkwardly.

DUFFERS CREEK raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading.

NGAWHINI when racing keenly had to be steadied going into the bend passing the 800 metres, when awkwardly placed on the heels of **HANNAH MARY**.

Apprentice jockey P Turner admitted a charge under Rule 619 in that he changed his gear after weighing out. After considering all relevant submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$200.

Race 5 ITM PINK BATTS 2000M

BIRCHINO was slow into stride.

LASSWADE raced in restricted room near the end of the back straight.

Race 6 LA NUOVA APPARELMASTER OPEN 2000M

SEA EAGLE was slow to begin.

MUFFIN MAN reared leaving the barrier and was further hampered when I'M NOT TICKLISH shifted in.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SEA EAGLE** rider D Bradley reported that the mare had travelled poorly throughout and felt something may have been amiss. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of **SEA EAGLE** which failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer K Little advised that the mare would be spelled.

When questioned regarding the run of **CHILL BILL** rider M Cameron reported that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 7 ITM INTERPROVINCIAL CHALLENGE

STORMIN NORMAN began awkwardly.

PENCURI was slow away.

JACKSUN had to steady when in restricted room near the 1300 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **OUR ALCHEMIST** rider D Walker reported that the gelding had been unsuited to the loose track.

When questioned on the run of **POOKA'S SISTER** both rider R Hutchings and Trainer J Wheeler were of the opinion that the mare did not back up from its previous run.

Race 8 SEATON PARK 1800M

MAEVE DAVONE which was fractious in the barrier began awkwardly.

TORRADO was crowded shortly after the start when runners from either side shifted ground.

ASTANA and **GOLDIE CANTRIDE** were slow to begin.

Near the 8000 metres **PALRAF** and **GOOGLE ME** were tightened when racing in restricted room with **PALRAF** losing ground. When questioned into the run of **MAEVE DAVONE**, rider K Myers could offer no excuse.

Race 9 EKRAAR & ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ LINWOOD PARK OPEN DAY TOMORROW 1800M

PERMESSO began awkwardly and made contact with ARANDOM.

LEAPER FAITH bumped at the start and got back.

B Lammas (JAZZ ROCK) and R Hutchings (LION RED) were of the opinion that their respective mounts had failed to handle the loose nature of today's track.

ARANDOM lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres and near the 100 metres shifted out making contact with **BONNY HEIGHTS** on three occasions. A resultant protest was lodged by J Parkes the rider of **BONNY HEIGHTS** placed 2nd

alleging interference by **ARANDOM** (M Dee) placed 1st over the final stages. After hearing evidence and viewing video footage the JCA upheld the protest and the final placings now read 8, 3, 11,2.

M Dee was issued with a warning and advised that when his mounts commence to shift ground he is expected to stop and straighten sooner than he did on this occasion.
