RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ECHOES OF HEAVEN & EKRAAR @ LINWOOD PARK STUD
MOVE FASTER (D Walker) began awkwardly, shifted out and made contact with FRITZY BOY (N Teeluck) before settling back. DAIELLO (D Bradley) was slow to begin and then raced keenly in the early and middle stages. N Teeluck (FRITZY BOY) was advised to exercise care after he allowed his mount to shift out shortly after turning for home and forced DAIELLO over extra ground. GOSSIPING (C Johnson) raced in restricted room rounding the home bend until near the 200 metres.	
Race 2	CREATIVE CATERING 3YO MAIDEN
JUSTLIKEYASISTER (K Chiong) shifted in abruptly on jumping away bumping with ZEDITAVE ROSE (M Dee) . GINGER SPICE and KIWI ROSE (D Walker) were crowded shortly after the start between BISHOPBRIGGS (J Riddell) and HONEY QUEEN (N Teeluck) . JUSTLIKEYASISTER was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout. HONEY QUEEN was held up rounding the turn until near the 250 metres.	
Race 3	COURTESY FORD HANDICAP
FLORAL SCENT (K Chiong) shifted in abruptly on jumping away severely hampering MR INK (R Myers) which clipped a	

heel and blundered. Also affected in this incident were **COFFEE (C Johnson)** and **BATMAN (M Dee)** which were tightened.

DI'S BOY (M Dravitzki) jumped away awkwardly

WATCH YOUR MAN (D Walker) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

Near the 250 metres **MR INK** shifted out abruptly under pressure into the line of **SAM I AM** which was improving to its outside resulting in **SAM I AM (D Turner)** clipping the heel of **MR INK** and blundering. After hearing evidence and viewing footage, the incident was considered beyond the control of **R Myers**.

D Bradley reported that **PRINCESS LINCOLN** was under pressure very early in the race and was unable to finish the race off when required. He was of the opinion the mare would benefit from being ridden further back than today. A subsequent veterinary inspection of **PRINCESS LINCOLN** revealed no abnormalities.

When questioned on the improved performance of **WATCH YOUR MAN** trainer E Carson advised that the gelding had at its previous start at Manawatu on 5 July been in the worst of the going on the inside and appreciated today's conditions.

Race 4 | **OTAKI CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES 28TH NOV & 18TH DEC MAIDEN**

KAYLEEN (C Anderson) was slow to begin losing several lengths.

ALL ZEDIN DONE (D Walker) was slow to begin.

SPEED QUEEN (K Chiong) lay out shortly after leaving the barriers resulting in crowding to **OPIUM (M Dee)** which lost ground as a consequence.

SPEED QUEEN commenced to over-race approaching the 1000 metres and near the 900 metres became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **DEAGON (J Riddell)** and had to be steadied.

SHUTHEGATE (C Grylls) raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Over the final stages, **DEAGON** shifted ground under pressure

C Anderson (KAYLEEN) was reminded of his obligations with regard to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

NIPPA MARY lost the near side front plate during the running.

Race 5 | **NEW WORLD LEVIN HANDICAP**

FLIPPANT (D Walker) was slow away and was then obliged to race four-wide rounding the first turn and three-wide thereafter.

C Johnson could offer no tangible excuse other than **KARAKA JACK** may not have been suited by the puggy track conditions after the gelding was beaten before the 600 metres and finished a long last. A subsequent veterinary examination of **KARAKA JACK** revealed the gelding suffered an arterial fibrillation. Trainer P Rudkin was advised that the gelding must obtain a veterinary clearance including an ECG examination and trail satisfactorily before next racing.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **OURFOREIGNMINISTER, C Grylls** could offer no excuses. Trainer **R Otto** advised the gelding would now be retired.

Race 6 | **COURTESY FORD RYDER STAKES – Listed**

NECTACOLECTA (R Myers) and **BEL SORRISO (B Lammas)** bounded as the start was made.

LINCOLN STREET (J Riddell) began awkwardly and blundered, shifting in and crowding **ENCHANTREZZ (D Turner)** and **JOLLY GIRL (V Johnston)**.

PURCENTAGE began awkwardly.

LINCOLN STREET was obliged to race wide throughout.

LINCOLN STREET was inclined to lay in during the early part of the home straight and near the 250 metres when being corrected shifted out into the line of **NECTACOLECTA (R Myers)** which had to be steadied.

NIKI PIKI MILO raced greenly throughout the final straight.

When questioned into the run of **LINCOLN STREET, J Riddell** had no tangible excuse. Trainer **L Latta** advised the colt would now be spelled.

Rider **B Lammas** reported that **BEL SORRISO** may be better suited to a more rain affected track.

Race 7 | **DIAL A PRAYER @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD HANDICAP**

SORTEMOUT (J Riddell) and **ELATED (M Dravitzki)** were slow to begin.

DANCE IN THE PARK (C Grylls) began very slowly losing several lengths and then raced wide in the early stages.

MISCHIEVOUS MIS (D Walker) raced four-wide from the 1000 metres.

FLOOZIE CAT (D Bradley) had to steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **NGAWHINI (D Turner)** passing the 400 metres.

Race 8 | **SUPER LIQUOR LEVIN HANDICAP**

VICKI ANNE (M Dee) stood flat footed when the barriers were released losing several lengths.

BEAU ZED (D Turner) was slow to begin.

GOLD CARD (A Taylor) raced keenly in the early stages.

KATIE MCKEEN (K Chiong) raced three-wide in the early and middle stages.

ANOTHERCHANCETAKEN (D Bradley) raced wide in the middle stages.

ABSTAIN (R Myers) raced wide from the 1000 metres.

D Walker advised that **ZEDEEDUDADEEKO** would be better served by a more rain affected track than today.
