## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	GRAND TAVERN 2200		
MAY (M Hills) began awkwardly, shifting in, then being steadied when becoming awkwardly placed.			
LADY LINDAUER (J Oliver) lost its footing jumping away, losing ground (5L).			
MAYBE LATER (R Myers) shifted in jumping away, making contact with APRIL JOY (K Leung) forcing that runner			
inwards, who then made contact with the hind quarters of CHEQUESINTHEMAIL (A Forbes) which became briefly unbalanced.			
Passing the 2100 metres CHEQUESINTHEMAIL had to steady off the heels of APRIL JOY which was taken in by			
LONGVIEW (S Spratt). S Spratt was advised that a warning would be placed on her record, and she was reminded to			
exercise greater care when shifting ground.			

BERLUSCONI (T Thornton) and MAY both over-raced through the early stages.

**FIREPOWER** (L Innes) lay out when making the first bend passing the 1800 metres. **SILK CHARDONNAY** (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres. **CHEQUESINTHEMAIL** was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure early in the final straight.

Race 2 MAINFREIGHT 1400 3YO

**ROSADO** (K Leung) began awkwardly, shifting out, inconveniencing **TOETWOTOE** (N Harris) which lost ground. **READY TO RUMBLE** (J Whiteside) reared in the barriers and as a result was slow away.

**TOTAL RESPONSE** (M Dee) began awkwardly then clipped a heel of **PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE** (M Du Plessis) and faltered losing ground. **PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE** then shifted out, hampering **IN THE CLOUD** (M Hills). Contributing was inward movement from **EL TYSON** (S Collett) which had begun awkwardly.

**HARDCORE ROCK** (M Cameron) lay in and raced ungenerously between the 800 metres and the 500 metres, and then was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**EL TYSON** shifted out under pressure approaching the 200 metres, inconveniencing **ROSADO**.

Race 3 DONAGHYS LESSN 1400 3YO

Mr C Wood presented **MYSTIC BLUE** to race in blinkers and a tongue tie which had not been declared. Mr C Wood defended the charge which was adjourned by the Judicial Committee pending further information to be supplied by Mr C Wood.

MYSTIC BLUE (R Myers) began awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with CHOYSA (S Spratt).

THE FRENCH WAY (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly, shifting in, hampering DESTROYER (M Sweeney).

TIARA (L Innes) began awkwardly, losing ground.

Approaching the 1100 metres **DELAGO'S SECRET** (M Cameron) had to be steadied off the heels of **MAKARSKA** (M Coleman) which shifted in, with the pace then steadying. As a result **THE FRENCH WAY**, **CHOYSA**, **TIARA** and **MYSTIC BLUE** all commenced to over-race with **THE FRENCH WAY** then shifting in passing the 1000 metres and falling back on to **LAC LA RONGE** (M Hills) which had to be steadied. **GLAMOUR BOY** (D Nolan) then became awkwardly placed on the heels of **LAC LA RONGE** and was hampered. M Coleman was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

**MYSTIC BLUE** then continued to over-race through the middle stages, and passing the 700 metres made contact with **TIARA** with **MYSTIC BLUE** becoming unbalanced and losing its footing. **MYSTIC BLUE** was then held up early in the final straight before obtaining clear running passing the 150 metres.

**THE FRENCH WAY** raced in restricted room early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

**DELAGO'S SECRET** lost its off hind plate during the running.

# Race 4 DAILYFREIGHT 1400

**ANNAMEIKA** (M Dee) was removed from the barriers after kicking out and was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.23 pm. **ANNAMEIKA** was showing signs of mild lameness in the off hind leg.

LIBERARE (M Coleman) EVA KEENEVA (B R Jones) ROADIE (M Cameron) GIULIETTA (S Collett) all began awkwardly.

Approaching the 1000 metres **QUEEN OF CLUBS** (N Harris) had to be steadied off the heels of **EL GUAPO** (A Forbes) which shifted in. **QUEEN OF CLUBS** then made contact with **FUSSY HUSSY** (T Thornton).

Near the 1000 metres **FLYING ORCA** (M Cheung) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **WAYWARD WONDER** (A Taylor) which had shifted in with **FLYING ORCA** having to be steadied. As a result **MISS DIRECTIONAL** (C Grylls) which was following **FLYING ORCA** had to be steadied.

**ROADIE** made the final turn awkwardly, laying out and then was further inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres by **GIULIETTA** which shifted out.

Near the 400 metres **FUSSY HUSSY** shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **QUEEN OF CLUBS**.

# Race 5 DONAGHYS PROMONENSIN 1200

The start of this race was delayed due to **SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS** proving difficult to get to the barriers.

SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS (M Dee) began awkwardly, shifting in, crowding FELICITY HALL (M Du Plessis).

**STAGE DOOR** (T Thornton) shifted out shortly after jumping away, crowding **BRANDY** (P Turner) which lost ground. **MATAGOURI** (M Cameron) was slow away.

FELICITY HALL over-raced in the early stages.

When linking on to the course proper approaching the 800 metres **IMPACT** (M Hills) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **STAGE DOOR** and then shifted out making contact with **FELICITY HALL** which in turn made contact with **PUNT HILL** (S Spratt).

The weakening **PUNT HILL** was inconvenienced approaching the 300 metres when **KATIE'S COVE** (L Innes) shifted out to obtain clear running. **KATIE'S COVE** raced greenly in the final straight.

# Race 6 TASMAN TIM 1200

FOURTOTHEFLOOR (A Collett) and TROIA (L Innes) came together jumping away when both runners had begun awkwardly.

LOLA (M Cameron) began awkwardly.

**DIAMOND REFUSAL** (P Turner) began awkwardly, losing ground.

FLASH FORWARD (M Dee) was slow away.

**BINGO** (A Forbes), **FOURTOTHEFLOOR** and **TROIA** all over-raced in the early stages.

Approaching the 1100 metres **TROIA** had to steady off the heels of **KING PHEROZ** (M Wenn) which shifted in. Shortly after **SUAREZ** (B R Jones) which had lay away from **LOLA** lay in making contact with **TROIA** for a distance.

Approaching the 1000 metres **FOURTOTHEFLOOR** lay in crowding **BINGO** which had to steady losing ground.

**FLASH FORWARD** (M Dee) had to be steadied approaching the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **TROIA**.

Approaching the 400 metres **FOURTOTHEFLOOR** then lay out crowding **BINGO** on to **TROIA** with both **BINGO** and **TROIA** becoming unbalanced. **TROIA** then lay out for the remainder of the race when placed under pressure.

Passing the 200 metres **BINGO** shifted out slightly to obtain clear running making contact with **FLASH FORWARD** with **BINGO** becoming unbalanced and further laying out unbalancing **FLASH FORWARD**.

Approaching the 100 metres **SPEEDY JAX** (M Hills) shifted in slightly under pressure, making contact with **OUR MOLLY MALONE** (T Thornton) which reacted adversely and shifted away abruptly, crowding **SUAREZ** which had to steady, losing ground. M Hills was advised to exercise greater care.

## Race 7 DONAGHYS PROABAMEC 1200

**LITTLE PEPPER** was late scratched at 2.15 pm due to the downgrade in track conditions.

**KHISDAR** (R Smyth) shifted out jumping away, crowding **PHARSALUS** (M Du Plessis). Contributing was inward movement from **SNIPPECHEE** (T Thornton).

**DIDGERIDOO** (M Dee) shifted in shortly after jumping away, making contact with **HARDTALUVA** (M Wenn).

LILLY BELLE (B R Jones) was slow away.

Approaching the 1000 metres **BIG BANG BABY** (T Wenn) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **LITTLE ROCKET** (A Taylor) which had to steady, with **BIG BANG BABY** then making contact with **DIDGERIDOO** which then shifted away from that runner, inconveniencing **THEBESTOFYOU** (D Nolan).

Passing the 350 metres **THEBESTOFYOU** shifted to the outside of **DIDGERIDOO** to obtain clear running, with **DIDGERIDOO** then shifting out slightly, dictating **THEBESTOFYOU** outwards, inconveniencing **LATE DECISION** (M Cameron) which was forced over extra ground.

**MATIMBA** (K Leung) shifted out abruptly under pressure over the final 100 metres.

**KHISDAR** lost the near hind plate during the running.

**BIG BANG BABY** lost the off fore plate during the running.

When questioned regarding the performance of **LILLY BELLE** rider B R Jones advised Stewards that the mare would appreciate further easing of the ground.

## Race 8 DONAGHYS TEATCARE 1600

CHAMPAGNE GIRL (R Myers) was slow away.

SILVER MINX (K Leung) and DESCHABEEL (M Coleman) both began awkwardly.

**BANBURY LAD** (A Collett) had to steady shortly after jumping away when crowded between **ELIE SAAB** (M Du Plessis) and **BUCKLEBURY** (L Innes).

PINK DIAMOND (L Magorrian) over-raced through the early stages.

Passing the 1100 metres **O'ROC 'N RAG** (P Turner) shifted in and away from **SWEETAZCUZ** (B R Jones) crowding **PINK DIAMOND** which had to steady. **PINK DIAMOND** continued to over-race through the middle stages and passing the 1000 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **O'ROC 'N RAG** and shifting out then making the bend awkwardly.

**DESCHABEEL** ducked in passing the 200 metres inconveniencing **BANBURY LAD** which had to steady.

## Race 9 CAPISTRANO LODGE 1600

**COOLIBAH** (S Collett) and **TREMAIN** (C Grylls) both began awkwardly.

**COSTUME** (M Du Plessis) and **MONS CALPE** (T Thornton) came together jumping away, with both runners becoming unbalanced.

I'LL'AVA'ALF (A Jones) and ALL ABOUT FUN (M Dee) both raced wide without cover throughout.

**ARTIFACT** (P Turner) was held up early in the final straight.

Passing the 350 metres COOLIBAH shifted out making contact with CENTAVADA (M Sweeney).

Passing the 200 metres IMAGUNAKEPA (BR Jones) raced in restricted room between TREMAIN and DUBAI SHUFFLE

(N Harris) both of which shifted ground, with **IMAGUNAKEPA** having to steady. Riders N Harris and C Grylls were reprimanded by Stewards and advised they must exercise greater care. Passing the 100 metres **DUBAI SHUFFLE** lay out under pressure forcing **TREMAIN** wider on the track.
