## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GRAND TAVERN 2200
<p><b>MAY</b> (M Hills) began awkwardly, shifting in, then being steadied when becoming awkwardly placed.</p> <p><b>LADY LINDAUER</b> (J Oliver) lost its footing jumping away, losing ground (5L).</p> <p><b>MAYBE LATER</b> (R Myers) shifted in jumping away, making contact with <b>APRIL JOY</b> (K Leung) forcing that runner inwards, who then made contact with the hind quarters of <b>CHEQUESINTHEMAIL</b> (A Forbes) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>Passing the 2100 metres <b>CHEQUESINTHEMAIL</b> had to steady off the heels of <b>APRIL JOY</b> which was taken in by <b>LONGVIEW</b> (S Spratt). S Spratt was advised that a warning would be placed on her record, and she was reminded to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>BERLUSCONI</b> (T Thornton) and <b>MAY</b> both over-raced through the early stages.</p>	

**FIREPOWER** (L Innes) lay out when making the first bend passing the 1800 metres.  
**SILK CHARDONNAY** (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.  
**CHEQUESINTHEMAIL** was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure early in the final straight.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MAINFREIGHT 1400 3YO</b>

**ROSADO** (K Leung) began awkwardly, shifting out, inconveniencing **TOETWOTOE** (N Harris) which lost ground.  
**READY TO RUMBLE** (J Whiteside) reared in the barriers and as a result was slow away.  
**TOTAL RESPONSE** (M Dee) began awkwardly then clipped a heel of **PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE** (M Du Plessis) and faltered losing ground. **PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE** then shifted out, hampering **IN THE CLOUD** (M Hills). Contributing was inward movement from **EL TYSON** (S Collett) which had begun awkwardly.  
**HARDCORE ROCK** (M Cameron) lay in and raced ungenerously between the 800 metres and the 500 metres, and then was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.  
**EL TYSON** shifted out under pressure approaching the 200 metres, inconveniencing **ROSADO**.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>DONAGHYS LESSN 1400 3YO</b>

Mr C Wood presented **MYSTIC BLUE** to race in blinkers and a tongue tie which had not been declared. Mr C Wood defended the charge which was adjourned by the Judicial Committee pending further information to be supplied by Mr C Wood.  
**MYSTIC BLUE** (R Myers) began awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with **CHOYSA** (S Spratt).  
**THE FRENCH WAY** (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly, shifting in, hampering **DESTROYER** (M Sweeney).  
**TIARA** (L Innes) began awkwardly, losing ground.  
Approaching the 1100 metres **DELAGO'S SECRET** (M Cameron) had to be steadied off the heels of **MAKARSKA** (M Coleman) which shifted in, with the pace then steadying. As a result **THE FRENCH WAY**, **CHOYSA**, **TIARA** and **MYSTIC BLUE** all commenced to over-race with **THE FRENCH WAY** then shifting in passing the 1000 metres and falling back on to **LAC LA RONGE** (M Hills) which had to be steadied. **GLAMOUR BOY** (D Nolan) then became awkwardly placed on the heels of **LAC LA RONGE** and was hampered. M Coleman was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.  
**MYSTIC BLUE** then continued to over-race through the middle stages, and passing the 700 metres made contact with **TIARA** with **MYSTIC BLUE** becoming unbalanced and losing its footing. **MYSTIC BLUE** was then held up early in the final straight before obtaining clear running passing the 150 metres.  
**THE FRENCH WAY** raced in restricted room early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.  
**DELAGO'S SECRET** lost its off hind plate during the running.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>DAILYFREIGHT 1400</b>

**ANNAMEIKA** (M Dee) was removed from the barriers after kicking out and was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.23 pm. **ANNAMEIKA** was showing signs of mild lameness in the off hind leg.  
**LIBERARE** (M Coleman) **EVA KEENEVA** (B R Jones) **ROADIE** (M Cameron) **GIULIETTA** (S Collett) all began awkwardly.  
Approaching the 1000 metres **QUEEN OF CLUBS** (N Harris) had to be steadied off the heels of **EL GUAPO** (A Forbes) which shifted in. **QUEEN OF CLUBS** then made contact with **FUSSY HUSSY** (T Thornton).  
Near the 1000 metres **FLYING ORCA** (M Cheung) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **WAYWARD WONDER** (A Taylor) which had shifted in with **FLYING ORCA** having to be steadied. As a result **MISS DIRECTIONAL** (C Grylls) which was following **FLYING ORCA** had to be steadied.  
**ROADIE** made the final turn awkwardly, laying out and then was further inconvenienced approaching the 400 metres by **GIULIETTA** which shifted out.  
Near the 400 metres **FUSSY HUSSY** shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **QUEEN OF CLUBS**.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>DONAGHYS PROMONENSIN 1200</b>

The start of this race was delayed due to **SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS** proving difficult to get to the barriers.  
**SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS** (M Dee) began awkwardly, shifting in, crowding **FELICITY HALL** (M Du Plessis).  
**STAGE DOOR** (T Thornton) shifted out shortly after jumping away, crowding **BRANDY** (P Turner) which lost ground.  
**MATAGOURI** (M Cameron) was slow away.  
**FELICITY HALL** over-raced in the early stages.  
When linking on to the course proper approaching the 800 metres **IMPACT** (M Hills) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **STAGE DOOR** and then shifted out making contact with **FELICITY HALL** which in turn made contact with **PUNT HILL** (S Spratt).  
The weakening **PUNT HILL** was inconvenienced approaching the 300 metres when **KATIE'S COVE** (L Innes) shifted out to obtain clear running. **KATIE'S COVE** raced greenly in the final straight.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>TASMAN TIM 1200</b>
<p><b>FOURTOTHEFLOOR</b> (A Collett) and <b>TROIA</b> (L Innes) came together jumping away when both runners had begun awkwardly.</p> <p><b>LOLA</b> (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DIAMOND REFUSAL</b> (P Turner) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p><b>FLASH FORWARD</b> (M Dee) was slow away.</p> <p><b>BINGO</b> (A Forbes), <b>FOURTOTHEFLOOR</b> and <b>TROIA</b> all over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>Approaching the 1100 metres <b>TROIA</b> had to steady off the heels of <b>KING PHEROZ</b> (M Wenn) which shifted in. Shortly after <b>SUAREZ</b> (B R Jones) which had lay away from <b>LOLA</b> lay in making contact with <b>TROIA</b> for a distance.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres <b>FOURTOTHEFLOOR</b> lay in crowding <b>BINGO</b> which had to steady losing ground.</p> <p><b>FLASH FORWARD</b> (M Dee) had to be steadied approaching the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>TROIA</b>.</p> <p>Approaching the 400 metres <b>FOURTOTHEFLOOR</b> then lay out crowding <b>BINGO</b> on to <b>TROIA</b> with both <b>BINGO</b> and <b>TROIA</b> becoming unbalanced. <b>TROIA</b> then lay out for the remainder of the race when placed under pressure.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres <b>BINGO</b> shifted out slightly to obtain clear running making contact with <b>FLASH FORWARD</b> with <b>BINGO</b> becoming unbalanced and further laying out unbalancing <b>FLASH FORWARD</b>.</p> <p>Approaching the 100 metres <b>SPEEDY JAX</b> (M Hills) shifted in slightly under pressure, making contact with <b>OUR MOLLY MALONE</b> (T Thornton) which reacted adversely and shifted away abruptly, crowding <b>SUAREZ</b> which had to steady, losing ground. M Hills was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>DONAGHYS PROABAMEC 1200</b>
<p><b>LITTLE PEPPER</b> was late scratched at 2.15 pm due to the downgrade in track conditions.</p> <p><b>KHISDAR</b> (R Smyth) shifted out jumping away, crowding <b>PHARSALUS</b> (M Du Plessis). Contributing was inward movement from <b>SNIPPECHEE</b> (T Thornton).</p> <p><b>DIDGERIDOO</b> (M Dee) shifted in shortly after jumping away, making contact with <b>HARDTALUVA</b> (M Wenn).</p> <p><b>LILLY BELLE</b> (B R Jones) was slow away.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres <b>BIG BANG BABY</b> (T Wenn) became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>LITTLE ROCKET</b> (A Taylor) which had to steady, with <b>BIG BANG BABY</b> then making contact with <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> which then shifted away from that runner, inconveniencing <b>THEBESTOFOYOU</b> (D Nolan).</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres <b>THEBESTOFOYOU</b> shifted to the outside of <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> to obtain clear running, with <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> then shifting out slightly, dictating <b>THEBESTOFOYOU</b> outwards, inconveniencing <b>LATE DECISION</b> (M Cameron) which was forced over extra ground.</p> <p><b>MATIMBA</b> (K Leung) shifted out abruptly under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p> <p><b>KHISDAR</b> lost the near hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>BIG BANG BABY</b> lost the off fore plate during the running.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>LILLY BELLE</b> rider B R Jones advised Stewards that the mare would appreciate further easing of the ground.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DONAGHYS TEATCARE 1600</b>
<p><b>CHAMPAGNE GIRL</b> (R Myers) was slow away.</p> <p><b>SILVER MINX</b> (K Leung) and <b>DESCHABEEL</b> (M Coleman) both began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>BANBURY LAD</b> (A Collett) had to steady shortly after jumping away when crowded between <b>ELIE SAAB</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>BUCKLEBURY</b> (L Innes).</p> <p><b>PINK DIAMOND</b> (L Magorrian) over-raced through the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres <b>O'ROC 'N RAG</b> (P Turner) shifted in and away from <b>SWEETAZCUZ</b> (B R Jones) crowding <b>PINK DIAMOND</b> which had to steady. <b>PINK DIAMOND</b> continued to over-race through the middle stages and passing the 1000 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>O'ROC 'N RAG</b> and shifting out then making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DESCHABEEL</b> ducked in passing the 200 metres inconveniencing <b>BANBURY LAD</b> which had to steady.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>CAPISTRANO LODGE 1600</b>
<p><b>COOLIBAH</b> (S Collett) and <b>TREMAIN</b> (C Grylls) both began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>COSTUME</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>MONS CALPE</b> (T Thornton) came together jumping away, with both runners becoming unbalanced.</p> <p><b>I'LL'AVA'ALF</b> (A Jones) and <b>ALL ABOUT FUN</b> (M Dee) both raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>ARTIFACT</b> (P Turner) was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres <b>COOLIBAH</b> shifted out making contact with <b>CENTAVADA</b> (M Sweeney).</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres <b>IMAGUNAKEPA</b> (BR Jones) raced in restricted room between <b>TREMAIN</b> and <b>DUBAI SHUFFLE</b></p>	

(N Harris) both of which shifted ground, with **IMAGUNAKEPA** having to steady. Riders N Harris and C Grylls were reprimanded by Stewards and advised they must exercise greater care.  
Passing the 100 metres **DUBAI SHUFFLE** lay out under pressure forcing **TREMAIN** wider on the track.
