RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MCDONALD'S HAVELOCK NORTH MAIDEN STAYERS 2100 METRES

GETAWAY which had become fractious in the barriers was removed and underwent a veterinary inspection, being passed fit to run.

PAUL and BLACK DRAGON were slow away.

ANDALOU shifted out leaving the barriers, hampering **BEAUTIFUL MAN**.

BEAUTIFUL MAN over-raced in the early stages.

D Turner (**BLACK DRAGON**) was issued with a warning after he allowed his mount to shift in near the 1600 metres and bumped with **NO COMMISSION**, unbalancing that runner for a short distance.

BEAUTIFUL MAN continued to over-race and shifted out near the 900 metres to avoid heels and in doing so dictated **PAUL** wider on the track.

VENDEMIAIRE had to steady off heels when the pace ahead eased near the 800 metres. Also affected was **NO COMMISSION**, which had to steady. BEAUTIFUL MAN was tightened near the 800 metres when **BLACK DRAGON** (D Turner) improved to its outside. D Turner was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

A short distance further **BEAUTIFUL MAN** had to steady off the heels of **PAUL** and shifted out to improve wide rounding the turn.

HERE'S DE CONSUL and **ZANOTTI** came together near the 300 metres, with **HERE'S DE CONSUL** becoming unbalanced and laying in. Prior to the authorization of dividends the connections of the second placed **ZANOTTI** viewed the stewards' video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest against the first placed **HERE'S DE CONSUL**.

HERE'S DE CONSUL shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages, inconveniencing **BLACK DRAGON** just short of the finish.

Race 2 J M BOSTOCK LTD STAYERS 2100 METRES

Due to the unavailability of a senior rider, apprentice jockey A Forbes replaced B Lammas on **FREDERICK WILLIAM. SAVARHYS** was slow away.

FREDERICK WILLIAM shifted away from PALM ISLAND leaving the barriers, hampering DELICIANO and PIRINITETE.

The saddle shifted forward on **TILDA** near the winning post on the first occasion severely disadvantaging the rider M Du Plessis for the remainder of the race.

SAVARHYS got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1200 metres.

GENUS was held up rounding the final bend and continued having difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight. **RODDICK** was held up near the 200 metres.

DESI GIRL shifted ground under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **GURU GIRL** near the 150 metres.

SEAGOLD was steadled away from the heels of **RODDICK** going into the bend near the 800 metres, dropping back on to **DUAL AGENT**, which was hampered.

Following this event the track was upgraded to Dead (4).

Race 3 TUMU ITM MAIDEN SPRING 1200 METRES

A barrier warning was placed against GOLDEN JUBILEE which proved reluctant to load.

EUCHER shifted out leaving the barriers hampering **PURE BLONDE**, which was forced out on to **EDGE OF GLORY**, which lost ground.

JACQUI TEE began awkwardly.

THE MUSICIAN over-raced badly when crossed by **INDOLLJENCE** passing the 1000 metres. **THE MUSICIAN** continued to over-race making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, hampering **SHOWSTOPPER** and **RACEY TRACEY**.

PURE BLONDE over-raced going into the bend near the 800 metres and had to be firmly restrained off heels and shift out forcing **EUCHER** over extra ground. Also inconvenienced was **DECADENT**. **PURE BLONDE**, **DECANDENT** and **EUCHER** all raced wide without cover.

EDGE OF GLORY had to be steadied off heels near the 600 metres.

RACEY TRACEY ducked outwards hampering **JACQUI TEE** which was forced out on to the hind quarters of **EDGE OF GLORY** near the 200 metres. **JACQUE TEE** was again inconvenienced when **RACEY TRACEY** continued to lay out over the final stages.

GOLDEN BAY was momentarily held up near the 300 metres and again near the 100 metres.

SHOWSTOPPER lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

C Dell (**INDOLLJENCE**) was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish. C Dell reported that the filly had hung throughout the race and had proved difficult to ride.

Race 4 WOOD'N'LODGE SPRINT 1200 METRES

MANU underwent a veterinary examination prior to being loaded away at the start and was passed fit to run.

BRIGHT GLO began awkwardly and was further hampered by **COLOURFUL LADY** which shifted out on jumping away. **TRAVINO** shifted in on leaving the barriers crowding **ELUSIVE RED**.

MADONNA MIA was slow away.

MANGAROA MINI lay out when racing in restricted room near the 1000 metres and went back on to **PARK PRINCESS**, which was hampered.

Near the 900 metres, **MANU** shifted in marginally making contact with **TRAVINO**, which resulted in **MANU** then laying inwards, forcing **TRAVINO** into the line of **JAKOB GAMBINO**. The riders of **TRAVINO** (L Innes) and **JAKOB GAMBINO** (S Spratt) both confirmed their mounts contributed to the incident by overreacting.

COPACABANA over-raced in the middle stages.

COLOURFUL LADY raced wide without cover when over-racing. D Bradley further reported that the mare had hung throughout.

MAGAROA MINI was inclined to lay out under pressure in the home straight.

A post-race veterinary examination of **BRIGHT GLO** found the gelding to be mildly lame in the right foreleg.

Race 5 AGRAFORUM NZ COMCAT 3YO MAIDEN 1400 METRES

LONGBEACH was removed after becoming fractious in the barrier and underwent a veterinary examination before being declared a late scratching at 3.51pm.

LAMBORGHINI and ROD'S LINCOLN were slow to begin.

CHACHI ARCOLA raced three wide without cover throughout.

Near the 500 metres **LAMBORGHINI** shifted out across the heels of the weakening **CHACHI ARCOLA**, hampering **ALADDIN**. Trainer G Searle attributed the improved performance of **FULLY FASHIONED** to the longer distance of 1400 metres and also the improved track conditions.

Race 6 FAWC AT HB RACING NOVEMBER 10TH 1400 METRES

DESERT STAR was slow to begin.

ROCKWEILER and **LITTLE DRAGON GIRL** bumped at the start resulting in **ROCKWEILER** commencing to over-race throughout.

MYMINKCOAT and GOLD both over-raced in the run along the back straight.

O'DARCI raced keenly in the middle stages.

QUEEN OF ROCK raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE FINAL ROUND raced in restricted room near the 400 metres for a short distance.

DESERT STAR was momentarily held up near the 350 metres and had to shift ground outwards to improve.

ROCKWEILER shifted in under pressure near the 200 metres and in doing so hampered FRANKLY.

O'DARCI had to be straightened inside the final 100 metres when racing greenly.

Race 7 TWILIGHT CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES DECEMBER 12TH 1600 METRES

CAPITAL DIAMOND raced three wide without cover.

Near the 900 metres **STORMIN NORMAN** shifted in away from **RINGO** crowding **VOLKSWOOD**, which was checked, losing ground. Stewards were satisfied that the movement of **STORMIN NORMAN** was beyond the control of its rider who took immediate corrective action.

Race 8 LETS GO TO TURKS FINALE 1600 METRES

BROADWALK began awkwardly and got back.

SHEZASTUNNA raced three wide without cover and hung throughout.

BROADWALK was held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres. **SHEZASTUNNA** hung outwards rounding the turn and in the straight shifting away from **PARTY ICE** near the 300 metres and making contact with **HUNTER STREET**.

MISSTEEFLYING was held up until passing the 100 metres and when attempting to improve into a tight run to the outside of **SHEZASTUNNA** was crowded when that runner continued to hang out.
