Race 1	GOURMET DELICIOUS LTD 1150

POWERPLAY (M Coleman) raced keenly in the middle stages

HEYDENTAL TOURIST (K Leung) was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

Received covering R Hutchings and M McNab

POWERPLAY was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

AGENT ZIVA (P Turner) was inclined to lay in over the final fifty metres.

Rider M Du Plessis notified the Stewards that **STARGURU** had felt indifferent in its action. The mare underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be sore in right foreleg and will now be taken home for further veterinary examination. The connections undertook to advise Stewards of any further findings. A vet clearance will be required before the mare races next.

Race 2 TAB TE AWAMUTU ON CAMBRIDGE ROAD 1150

IFFLEY ROAD (M Dee) was slow to begin.

INTERCITY GIRL (J Jago) jumped away awkwardly with its rider becoming unbalanced for a short distance.

KAHALA (R Hutchings) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 400 metres **BLUE STREAK** (M Hills) when shifting out to obtain clear racing room made contact with **GOING PLACES** (V Gatu) forcing that runner over extra ground.

When questioned into the performance of the favourite **IFFLEY ROAD** rider M Dee advised the Stewards that the filly was unable to make up the ground after being slow away but could offer no other reason for the filly's performance.

Race 3 ROSETOWN GLASS 1150

The start of this race was delayed for 3 minutes 30 seconds after **ARMANI** (M Dee) dislodged the rider on its way to the barriers. After being re-captured the gelding underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start.

ARMANI jumped away awkwardly shifting out making firm contact with **REYNEN ROSE** (M Wenn) forcing that runner out onto **STEFFI'S SECRET** (M Cameron) which was hampered losing ground. Also losing ground was **ARMANI**.

ALL NIGHT DELIGHT (A Taylor) raced wide throughout.

BELLAIRE (T Thornton) got its head up when-over racing passing the 800 metres and continued to over-race for a short distance.

SIR SUNNY (D Hain) had difficulty in obtaining clear running in the final straight when inclined to lay-in under pressure.

Race 4 WELCOME TE AWAMUTU PROBUS CLUB 1580

MANANA (A Collett) was slow to begin then was further hampered when PRETTY DUCKIES (S Collett) shifted in.

ROMPERS (M Wenn) shifted in shortly after leaving the barrier placing **I'M ALL YOURS** (M Du Plessis) and **MOPANE** (L Magorrian) in restricted room for a short distance.

MANANA raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Passing the 1100 metres **ARMANDO** (R Hutchings) had to be steadied off the heels of **READY TO ROCKNROLL** (D Nolan) which shifted in when awkwardly placed on the heels of **MOPANE.**

ROMPERS lost both front plates during the running.

MOPANE shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned into the performance of **I'M ALL YOURS** rider M Du Plessis felt the gelding would prefer to race over more ground than on this occasion. Trainer D Rogerson agreed with the rider but also felt that the gelding had settled back further than intended.

Race 5 PAPER PLUS & TOYWORLD 1400

ISEEMAGIC (A Collett) was slow to begin then raced wide in the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure in the final straight failed to respond. When questioned, rider A Collett could offer no other reason for the filly's performance.

Passing the 1300 metres **SCREW LOOSE** (M Sweeny) was crowded to the inside of **CHAPEL BELLS** (T Thornton) which shifted in and away from **REBISHA** (S Collett) contributing was **POROTENE LOLLIPOP** (R Hannam) which shifted out and away from **IN A MINUTE** (M Du Plessis).

POROTENE LOLLIPOP was inclined to lay out making the bend nearing the 1150 metres awkwardly

VESTA (M Cameron) over-raced throughout the early stages.

IMMINENT (P Turner) was inclined to lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure.

Race 6 FARRELLY CALF REARING 1150

LOTUS LAUD (M Wenn) and RED MOON (M Hills) were slow to begin.

KONTIKI (T Wenn) shifted out abruptly on jumping away hampering **HEIGH UP KEEP** (C Grylls) **WHO WHY** (J Jago) **ERNIE** (M Du Plessis) **DYNAMITE GIRL** (R Hutchings). Trainer of **KONTIKI** F Drummond was informed that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners.

Passing the 75 metres **DELLA LAMOUR** (T Thornton) shifted out and away from **KONTIKI** having to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **DAN THE MAN** (K Joyce).

T Thornton rider of **DELLA LAMOUR** dropped her whip short of the winning post.

Trainer of **DYNAMITE GIRL** G Richardson informed the Stewards that on returning to the stabling area the mare was observed to have blood present in a nostril and was deemed to be a bleeder and would be stood down for the mandatory three months. He also indicated the mare would not be preserved with as a racing proposition.

Race 7 MAGNUM INDUSTRIES 1400

ISTILANE (T Thornton) was slow to begin and was further hampered when runners on either side shifted ground.

EDWARD THE EIGHT (A Collett) **SING HANG STAR** (M McNab) and **WHITLEY CHAPEL** (C Grylls) were all slow to begin. **IGNISHUN** (M Dee) stumbled on leaving the barrier.

Approaching the 1150 metres **LIGHT THE WAY** (P Taylor) steadied when over-racing and went back onto **GIRLS DON'T CRY** (M Hills) which shifted out abruptly off that runners heels and continued to over-race for some distance.

Approaching the 1000 metres **ASSERTIVE** (L Magorrian) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **LIGHT THE WAY**.

LA TOURNEAU (P Turner) and ASSERTIVE made contact of several occasions over the final 150 metres.

When questioned into the performance of the favourite **LADY GRANGELEA** M Sweeney advised the Stewards that as he had drawn a wide barrier the mare was obliged to race wide throughout but could no other reason for the mares performance.

THE DARLING ONE (M McNab), DAY WALKER (M Sweeny) and ROLL WITH PULSE (T Wenn) were all slow to begin.		
DAY WALKER and BILLIE JEAN KING (M Dee) were both obliged to race wide without cover throughout.		
SULTRY ASSASSIN (M Du Plessis) was help up passing the 400 metres having to shift out across the heels of BILLIE		
JEAN KING to obtain clear running.		
C Dell the rider of AIRFIELD ROAD dropped his whip passing the 250 metres.		
Near the 200 metres CAT WOMAN (L Callaway) was briefly held up having to shift out across the heels of GENDARME		
(L Magorrian) to obtain clear running.
