## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DATACOMMS PLUS HURDLE (2900 metres)
<p>This race commenced 15 minutes late, at 12.10pm, due to the late arrival of the ambulance. Club officials were to make inquiries as to the delay.</p> <p><b>LION MAN</b> shifted in at the start and tightened <b>GAGARIN</b>, which got back. Also affected was <b>SHOW THE BEEL</b>, which settled back.</p> <p>The saddle on <b>YIPSON</b> (M Gillies) slipped forward entering the home straight on the first round placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder.</p> <p>M Gillies, the rider of <b>YIPSON</b>, was advised of his obligations to be clear after he allowed his mount to shift in passing the post on the first occasion, hampering <b>STORMIN NORMAN</b>.</p> <p>S Fannin (<b>GAGARIN</b>) was advised to exercise care when shifting ground after he allowed his mount to shift in near the 800 metres, resulting in <b>YIPSON</b> being dictated into the line of <b>NO GOVERNANCE</b>, which was momentarily hampered.</p> <p><b>STORMIN NORMAN</b> landed awkwardly after jumping the second-last fence.</p> <p><b>HOWBADAMI</b> was retired from the event after jumping the second-last fence when well back and out of contention.</p> <p>When questioned, rider S Phelan said that he felt something maybe amiss with <b>HOWBADAMI</b>. A post-race veterinary inspection which revealed the gelding to be lame in the right foreleg with the connections advised that a clearance would</p>	

<p>be required before next racing.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of <b>LION MAN</b> revealed the gelding to be showing signs of tying up.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>PROLOGUE</b>, rider I Lupton reported that after over-racing throughout the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination of <b>PROLOGUE</b> failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>CB NORWOOD DISTRIBUTORS LTD HURDLE (2900 metres)</b>
<p>The start of this event was altered to 12.42pm.</p> <p><b>ROOF OF RECKONING</b> bounded at the start and lost ground.</p> <p><b>SEA EAGLE</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GENERAL LEE</b> mixed its jumping in the early stages. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>YAMANAURA</b> hit the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>M McNelis (GET FLASH)</b> was issued with a warning under Rule 638(2) after he commenced his victory salute immediately prior to the winning post.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>HARRIS CONTRACTING SANSON / MAKOWHAI FARMS LTD (2100 metres)</b>
<p>The start of this event was altered to 1.10pm.</p> <p><b>TIME FOR GOLD</b> jumped outwards abruptly at the start into the line of <b>BILLY ELLIOT</b>, which was crowded, losing ground.</p> <p><b>JOE COOL</b> was slow to begin, and when doing so, made contact with the side of its gate and as a result settled at the rear of the field.</p> <p><b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>TIZZA SECRET</b> lay inwards in the early stages of the final straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p><b>TIME FOR GOLD</b> was inclined to shift ground outward under pressure over the final stages.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE STEEPLECHASE (4200 metres)</b>
<p><b>CARINYA</b> landed awkwardly and blundered after jumping the first fence.</p> <p><b>CARINYA</b> misjudged the fence passing the 1200 metres on the first occasion and lost ground and also jumped the next fence awkwardly.</p> <p><b>AUTHENTIC</b> jumped inwards at the fence near the 1000 metres and clipped the inside wing.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>UPPER CUT</b> rider I Lupton said the gelding over-raced early and then struggled to maintain its position on the flat between fences, but in his opinion may improve with the run.</p> <p>Over the final stages <b>ELECTRICLITE</b> (M Mitchell) shifted out under pressure into the line of <b>UPPER CUT</b>, which was finishing on, resulting in <b>UPPER CUT</b> having to shift ground inwards to improve. M Mitchell was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>TOBOUGGIE NIGHTS</b> struggled throughout and finished well back. Rider P Ormsby had no excuse. A veterinary examination revealed a slow post-race recovery.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>NOARO FARM / BAGRIE CONTRACTING AMATEUR (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>MR CHEZ</b> was inclined to get its head up in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p><b>BALLROOM</b> jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>LADY'O</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BOYSZONE</b>, which raced three wide without cover throughout, raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>CLAPATHUNDA</b> lay in near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p><b>JACKABEAN</b> shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>HOPKINS FARMING GROUP / GREIG FARMING LTD MAIDEN (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>ANUTHA HULA</b>, <b>MOUNTBATTEN</b> and <b>CARTAGENA</b> were all crowded leaving the barrier between <b>REDEEM</b>, which lay out, and <b>ASRAF</b>, which hung in.</p> <p><b>HUNKY DORY</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p>N Teeluck (<b>HUNKY DORY</b>) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he allowed his mount to shift in near the 200 metres when not clear of <b>CARTAGENA</b>, which had to be steadied.</p> <p>Rider D Walker could offer no excuse for the performance of <b>ANUTHA HULA</b>, which was distanced at the finish.</p> <p>D Bradley reported that <b>CARTAGENA</b> hung throughout and proved a difficult ride.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>GAVIN TEAL CONTRACTING / SRD FARMING MAIDEN (1200 metres)</b>
<p><b>VERACIOUS</b> reared behind the barrier and dislodged rider R Hannam, who was cleared to ride but following the running of race 7, stood himself down from his remaining two rides due to feeling the effects.</p> <p><b>HYMN</b> was crowded leaving the barrier between <b>MISS APPLETON</b> which began awkwardly and shifted out and <b>GOLDEN SHELLS</b> which jumped inwards.</p> <p><b>BLAME DE ANGELS</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>NOSECONDPRIZE</b> began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p><b>MALONE</b> shifted out under pressure early in the run home, momentarily hampering <b>SUSSED</b>.</p> <p><b>MISS APPLETON</b> shifted in abruptly near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>EAMES AG / CORBETT BROS / IW SCOTT &amp; SONS MAIDEN (1600 metres)</b>
<p>K Smith replaced R Hannam on <b>MISS MOORE</b>.</p> <p>The C&amp;D Bothwell partnership was issued with a warning under Rule 537(a) for the late declaration of a rider for <b>HI FIVER</b></p>	

(R Myers).  
**FALSE EMPATHY** was very slow away (6L).  
**THE CAPER** over-raced in the early and middle stages.  
Passing the 600 metres, **SASHAY**, which was improving wide on the track, slipped and lost its footing and when being corrected shifted in severely hampering **FRENCH PERFUME**. All riders were addressed by the stewards and after discussion agreed to continue on with the meeting.  
Over the final stages **SASHAY** shifted in under pressure and bumped **HI FIVER** near the post.

Race 9	NOEL PETT SUPPORTERS CLUB HANDICAP (1400 metres)
Due to the lack of senior riders available, M Dravitzki replaced R Hannam on <b>CALEY ROSE</b> . <b>BEEBEE STAR</b> stood flat-footed in the gates and lost ground (3L). <b>SINGLE MISSION</b> shifted out further than what K Smith intended to when being angled outwards near the 350 metres and in doing so dictated <b>RIVERMAN JACK</b> and <b>CEE TEE ARE</b> over extra ground. Near the 250 metres <b>GOLD WEDDING</b> , which was improving to the outside of <b>STELLA BELLA (K Chiong)</b> , was forced outwards into the line of <b>ANDALOU</b> , which was hampered when <b>STELLA BELLA</b> shifted ground outwards under pressure. K Chiong was advised to exercise care. Also contributing was inward movement from <b>SINGLE MISSION (K Smith)</b> , which raced greenly under pressure. <b>SINGLE MISSION</b> , when being corrected, shifted out abruptly and tightened <b>RIVERMAN JACK</b> , which was improving to its outside. K Smith was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.
