## **RACE COMMENTS:**

# Race 1 DATACOMMS PLUS HURDLE (2900 metres)

This race commenced 15 minutes late, at 12.10pm, due to the late arrival of the ambulance. Club officials were to make inquiries as to the delay.

**LION MAN** shifted in at the start and tightened **GAGARIN**, which got back. Also affected was **SHOW THE BEEL**, which settled back.

The saddle on **YIPSON** (M Gillies) slipped forward entering the home straight on the first round placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder.

M Gillies, the rider of **YIPSON**, was advised of his obligations to be clear after he allowed his mount to shift in passing the post on the first occasion, hampering **STORMIN NORMAN**.

S Fannin (**GAGARIN**) was advised to exercise care when shifting ground after he allowed his mount to shift in near the 800 metres, resulting in **YIPSON** being dictated into the line of **NO GOVERNANCE**, which was momentarily hampered.

**STORMIN NORMAN** landed awkwardly after jumping the second-last fence.

**HOWBADAMI** was retired from the event after jumping the second-last fence when well back and out of contention. When questioned, rider S Phelan said that he felt something maybe amiss with **HOWBADAMI**. A post-race veterinary inspection which revealed the gelding to be lame in the right foreleg with the connections advised that a clearance would

be required before next racing.

A post-race veterinary examination of **LION MAN** revealed the gelding to be showing signs of tying up.

When questioned regarding the performance of **PROLOGUE**, rider I Lupton reported that after over-racing throughout the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination of **PROLOGUE** failed to reveal any abnormality.

# Race 2 CB NORWOOD DISTRIBUTORS LTD HURDLE (2900 metres)

The start of this event was altered to 12.42pm.

**ROOF OF RECKONING** bounded at the start and lost ground.

SEA EAGLE was slow to begin.

**GENERAL LEE** mixed its jumping in the early stages. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality. **YAMANAURA** hit the fence near the 600 metres.

**M McNelis** (**GET FLASH**) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(2) after he commenced his victory salute immediately prior to the winning post.

### Race 3 HARRIS CONTRACTING SANSON / MAKOWHAI FARMS LTD (2100 metres)

The start of this event was altered to 1.10pm.

**TIME FOR GOLD** jumped outwards abruptly at the start into the line of **BILLY ELLIOT**, which was crowded, losing ground.

**JOE COOL** was slow to begin, and when doing so, made contact with the side of its gate and as a result settled at the rear of the field.

**BILLY ELLIOT** raced wide without cover throughout.

TIZZA SECRET lay inwards in the early stages of the final straight and had to be straightened.

**TIME FOR GOLD** was inclined to shift ground outward under pressure over the final stages.

# Race 4 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE STEEPLECHASE (4200 metres)

**CARINYA** landed awkwardly and blundered after jumping the first fence.

**CARINYA** misjudged the fence passing the 1200 metres on the first occasion and lost ground and also jumped the next fence awkwardly.

**AUTHENTIC** jumped inwards at the fence near the 1000 metres and clipped the inside wing.

When questioned into the run of **UPPER CUT** rider I Lupton said the gelding over-raced early and then struggled to maintain its position on the flat between fences, but in his opinion may improve with the run.

Over the final stages **ELECTRICLITE** (M Mitchell) shifted out under pressure into the line of **UPPER CUT**, which was finishing on, resulting in **UPPER CUT** having to shift ground inwards to improve. M Mitchell was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

**TOBOUGGIE NIGHTS** struggled throughout and finished well back. Rider P Ormsby had no excuse. A veterinary examination revealed a slow post-race recovery.

### Race 5 NOARO FARM / BAGRIE CONTRACTING AMATEUR (2100 metres)

MR CHEZ was inclined to get its head up in the early stages when being restrained.

**BALLROOM** jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

LADY'O was slow to begin.

BOYSZONE, which raced three wide without cover throughout, raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**CLAPATHUNDA** lay in near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.

JACKABEAN shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

# Race 6 HOPKINS FARMING GROUP / GREIG FARMING LTD MAIDEN (2100 metres)

**ANUTHA HULA, MOUNTBATTEN** and **CARTAGENA** were all crowded leaving the barrier between **REDEEM**, which lay out, and **ASRAF**, which hung in.

**HUNKY DORY** began awkwardly.

N Teeluck (**HUNKY DORY**) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he allowed his mount to shift in near the 200 metres when not clear of **CARTAGENA**, which had to be steadied.

Rider D Walker could offer no excuse for the performance of ANUTHA HULA, which was distanced at the finish.

D Bradley reported that **CARTAGENA** hung throughout and proved a difficult ride.

## Race 7 GAVIN TEAL CONTRACTING / SRD FARMING MAIDEN (1200 metres)

**VERACIOUS** reared behind the barrier and dislodged rider R Hannam, who was cleared to ride but following the running of race 7, stood himself down from his remaining two rides due to feeling the effects.

**HYMN** was crowded leaving the barrier between **MISS APPLETON** which began awkwardly and shifted out and **GOLDEN SHELLS** which jumped inwards.

BLAME DE ANGELS was slow away.

NOSECONDPRIZE began awkwardly and was slow away.

MALONE shifted out under pressure early in the run home, momentarily hampering SUSSED.

MISS APPLETON shifted in abruptly near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

# Race 8 EAMES AG / CORBETT BROS / IW SCOTT & SONS MAIDEN (1600 metres)

K Smith replaced R Hannam on MISS MOORE.

The C&D Bothwell partnership was issued with a warning under Rule 537(a) for the late declaration of a rider for HI FIVER

(R Myers).

FALSE EMPATHY was very slow away (6L).

THE CAPER over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Passing the 600 metres, **SASHAY**, which was improving wide on the track, slipped and lost its footing and when being corrected shifted in severely hampering **FRENCH PERFUME**. All riders were addressed by the stewards and after discussion agreed to continue on with the meeting.

Over the final stages SASHAY shifted in under pressure and bumped HI FIVER near the post.

## Race 9 NOEL PETT SUPPORTERS CLUB HANDICAP (1400 metres)

Due to the lack of senior riders available, M Dravitzki replaced R Hannam on CALEY ROSE.

BEEBEE STAR stood flat-footed in the gates and lost ground (3L).

**SINGLE MISSION** shifted out further than what K Smith intended to when being angled outwards near the 350 metres and in doing so dictated **RIVERMAN JACK** and **CEE TEE ARE** over extra ground.

Near the 250 metres **GOLD WEDDING**, which was improving to the outside of **STELLA BELLA (K Chiong)**, was forced outwards into the line of **ANDALOU**, which was hampered when **STELLA BELLA** shifted ground outwards under pressure. K Chiong was advised to exercise care. Also contributing was inward movement from **SINGLE MISSION (K Smith)**, which raced greenly under pressure. **SINGLE MISSION**, when being corrected, shifted out abruptly and tightened **RIVERMAN JACK**, which was improving to its outside. K Smith was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.
