RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VISIT WHITIANGA HURDLE
<p>PARTY HORSE (D Miller) was slow away.</p> <p>CASH KINGDOM baulked approaching the first fence unbalancing rider J Forbes who was then dislodged jumping the fence – both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>MISS CRAZY DAISY (G Walsh) made contact with REAL TREASURE (S Phelan) on landing after jumping the first fence. The riderless CASH KINGDOM struck and dislodged the wing of the fence near the 250 metres on the first occasion. REAL TREASURE jumped inwards at that fence crowding MISS CRAZY DAISY.</p> <p>MISS CRAZY DAISY put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1500 metres.</p> <p>SKAI GLEN (M Cropp) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>NO CREDIT (R Cully) landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 900 metres.</p>	

<p>NO CREDIT (R Cully) misjudged the second last fence and fell – both horse and rider were injured. S Houston reported that her mount ISDABICKY had felt uneven in its action during the running. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>A post-race endoscopic examination of KING PICCOLO which was found to have blood present in both nostrils confirmed the gelding as a bleeder, and as such is subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing.</p>	
Race 2	HISTORIC IMPERIAL HURDLE
<p>ATOMIC ROAD (N Quinn) over-raced in the lead in the early to middle stages, and was inclined to lug outwards throughout. SHOTGUN (I Lupton) also raced keenly in the early to middle stages when trailing.</p> <p>SHOTGUN misjudged the fence near the 1500 metres.</p> <p>ATOMIC ROAD struck the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SHOTGUN rider I Lupton stated that the gelding had failed to settle on a strong pace, and had hit the fence near the 1500 metres hard. I Lupton further stated that once placed under pressure the gelding had then been quickly beaten.</p>	
Race 3	CAMPBELLS STEAK N ALE HOUSE STEEPLECHASE
<p>SPACE ODDITY (S Houston) put in a poor jump at the first fence.</p> <p>GOOSEBUMPS (D Miller) jumped inwards at the second fence hampering SUPERCHARGED (M Mitchell) which jumped the fence very awkwardly hampering HONEY which then landed awkwardly badly unbalancing rider I Lupton who after attempting to regain his seat was eventually dislodged.</p> <p>SUPERCHARGED badly misjudged the first of the double (third fence) unbalancing its rider who lost the use of his irons and was dislodged a distance after jumping the second of the double.</p> <p>ASWORTHY (C Studd) jumped outwards at the fifth fence hampering SPACE ODDITY which was forced over extra ground.</p> <p>SINISTA (R Cave) badly misjudged the fifth fence and fell heavily. Rider R Cave was attended to by ambulance personnel and transferred to hospital with a suspected fractured collar bone.</p> <p>JAMIE LEE (M Cropp) landed awkwardly after jumping the fifth fence and was further hampered when having to evade the fallen SINISTA.</p> <p>GOOSEBUMPS was hampered by a riderless horse jumping the sixth fence unbalancing rider D Miller.</p> <p>SPACE ODDITY fell at the sixth fence.</p> <p>MARVON DOWNS (R Cully) and JAMIE LEE were both inconvenienced when narrowly avoiding a riderless horse entering the middle on the second occasion.</p> <p>ASWORTHY landed awkwardly after jumping the fence at the foot of the hill on the final occasion dislodging rider C Studd.</p> <p>MARVON DOWNS jumped the last fence awkwardly.</p> <p>JAMIE LEE which returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils was confirmed as a bleeder, and as such is subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing.</p> <p>With the exception of R Cave all other fallen riders and horses were uninjured.</p>	
Race 4	THE IMPERIAL IN THAMES STEEPLECHASE
<p>SMOKE misjudged the second fence and landed awkwardly dislodging rider G Walsh – both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>YORKIE (R Cully) put in a poor jump at the sixth fence.</p> <p>THE ROSE (I Lupton) over-raced in the lead when challenged by the riderless SMOKE passing the 1000 metres on the first occasion.</p> <p>THE ROSE ran down its fences when jumping the five through the middle on the second occasion running wide approaching the bend.</p> <p>YORKIE and AYATOLLAH (S Phelan) both put in poor jumps at the final fence.</p> <p>GO JIMMY GO (M Cropp) was dismounted immediately on pulling up following the race and was led back to the enclosure noticeably lame. A veterinary examination found the gelding to have suffered a tendon injury in the right foreleg with trainer Mr A Meikle being advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to racing again.</p>	
Race 5	BARBARA L ANDERSON FAMILY TRUST 1150
<p>READY TO ROCKNROLL (P Turner) was slow to begin.</p> <p>BUCKLEBURY (L Innes) was hampered leaving the barriers between SUMMER DALE (S Collett) and QUEEN OF EXCUSES (M Dee) which both began awkwardly and shifted ground.</p> <p>SHEZ BUBBLY (K Chiong) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SUMMER DALE had to be steadied near the 1000 metres when crowded for room by QUEEN OF EXCUSES. M Dee was issued with a warning.</p> <p>J Oliver (I'M A CITY GIRL) dropped the right rein entering the final straight near the 400 metres.</p> <p>ROCKY ROAD (A Forbes) which was inclined to shift outwards under pressure early in the final straight shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip near the 250 metres hampering BUCKLEBURY and SUMMER DALE. A Forbes was</p>	

issued with a warning.

Trainer Mr S Tyler was fined \$50 after presenting his horse **I'M A CITY GIRL** without notified gear (blinkers).

Race 6

HOTEL IMPERIAL 1350

HIGH TOWER (C Grylls) was a little slow to begin.

JULIETA (M Dee) had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when crowded for room by **WICKEDLY** (C Dell) which was taken in by **HE'S MYN** (M Cameron). M Cameron was advised to exercise more care.

JULIETA was inclined to over-race in the middle stages getting its head up when being restrained to avoid the heels of **WICKEDLY** (C Dell) near the 800 metres.

NGATIRA GOLD (T Thornton) hung outwards throughout making the final bend very awkwardly.

EN'JOYOUR LINDAUER (J Oliver)(and **HIGH TOWER** raced wide throughout.

HIGH TOWER lost the off hind plate during the running.

J Oliver was fined \$150 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) in that he used his whip excessively on his mount **EN'JOYOUR LINDAUER** prior to the 200 metres.

Race 7

PENINSULA MOTEL 1670

ALL ABOUT FUN (P Turner) shifted out leaving the barriers crowding **MONEY BAGS** (M Dee) which was steadied losing ground.

BEAU RANSOM (M Sweeney) got its head up when being steadied to avoid heels when the pace eased going into the bend near the 800 metres.

ALL ABOUT FUN was inclined to shift out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **SEAMS LIKE MAGIC** (D Johnson) passing the 100 metres.
