POGUE raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

Passing the 150 metres **LIGHT THE WAY** (P Taylor) shifted out to obtain clear running inconveniencing the weakening **PASSING PARADE**.

POGUE returned to the enclosure with blood present in one nostril. After undergoing a veterinary examination **POGUE** was found to have a laceration to the nostril.

O Bosson, the rider of **PASSING PARADE**, reported that his mount felt to have pulled up mildly lame in the right fore leg. A post-race veterinary examination however failed to find any obvious abnormality.

When questioned regarding the performance of **DUBAI WOLF** rider D Johnson stated that the gelding had only travelled fairly and once placed under pressure in the final straight had been unable to quicken.

100 metres inconveniencing HYDROGEN (K Leung).

BALLROOM had to be steadied when racing in restricted room near the 400 metres hampering **IRENE ALICE** (A Collett). When questioned regarding the poor performance of **TRAVELLER** Rider O Bosson advised that the gelding had travelled like a winner until the 600 metres but once asked to quicken had compounded quickly. A post-race veterinary examination of **TRAVELLER** did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Following this race P Taylor advised he was unwell and after being examined by the Course Doctor was stood down from his remaining ride as he was suffering from asthma.

Race 7

I Lupton replaced P Ormsby on **RANGATIRA**.

SNODROPTWINKLETOES (K Veenendaal) over-raced in the early stages.

VICTORY MORGAN (G Walsh) put in a poor jump at the second on top of the hill on the first occasion.

KARLOS (C Thornton), SPORTAVIAN (S Phelan) and KIDUNOT (R Doherty) all put in poor jumps at the water jump being the eighth fence.

RANGATIRA (I Lupton) got in close to the first of the double on the final circuit.

SPORTAVIAN was retired from the race on top of the hill on the final occasion when well beaten.

RANGATIRA put in a poor jump at the second last fence near the 600 metres.

RANGATIRA landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.

S Houston, the rider of **IMA HEROINE**, advised that the mare had not travelled comfortably throughout on the strong tempo of today's race with the improved track conditions also being against the mare's chances.

IMA HEROINE and **KARLOS** both lost the right front plate during the running.

SNODROPTWINKLETOES lost the left front plate during the running.

Race 8 Lindauer Mile

RIGHTEO (M Hills) lay in when leaving the barriers crowding **CELTIC STAR** (D Johnson) on to **MOVE FASTER** (D Nolan) which in turn made contact with **BOY** (O Bosson) forcing that runner across the heels of **THE SHACKLER** (M Sweeney).

THE SHACKLER over-raced when disputing the pace through the middle stages and was inclined to hang outwards. **THE SHACKLER** continued to hang out rounding the final turn and in the straight.

MOVE FASTER shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres crowding **THE SHACKLER** for some distance. D Nolan was issued with a warning and advised that he must make a far greater attempt to straighten his mount more quickly than he had on this occasion. Contributing to the crowding received from **THE SHACKLER** was some inward movement from **GURUS SPIRIT** (K Chiong). K Chiong was advised to exercise more care.

RAFA (R Smyth) shifted out under pressure near the 50 metres when only marginally clear of **MOVE FASTER**.

M Sweeney (THE SHACKLER) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 9 Coca-Cola 2200

JUST GOT HOME (B Grylls) and INTRANSIGENT (N Harris) were slow away.

INTRANSIGENT over-raced in the early and middle stages.

JUST GOT HOME raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages being inclined to get its head up.

JUST GOT HOME was held up rounding the final turn having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres.

SAVED BY THE BELL (M Sweeney) hung outwards rounding the final turn and continued to hang out in the straight. **CHAPINTA** (D Johnson) was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the poor performance of **INTRANSIGENT** Rider N Harris advised that the horse's chances had been adversely affected by over-racing badly and once placed under pressure approaching the final turn had then been unable to quicken. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 10 Auckland Co-op Taxis Mile

BR Jones had advised prior to race day that due to the effects of a virus he had been unable to waste sufficiently to make the weight for **SAFE ACCESS** but due to a mis-understanding this information had not been passed on by connections prior to race day. P Taylor was then advised as the replacement rider but after being stood down after his ride in race 6 C Dell was permitted to ride **SAFE ACCESS** due to no senior rider being available.

STELLA (L Magorrian) began awkwardly losing ground.

IPONI (K Leung) was slow to begin.

Passing the 1500 metres STELLA had to be restrained off the heels of SAFE ACCESS (C Dell) which shifted in.

FINANCIAL TERRORIST (D Johnson) over-raced when being restrained passing the 1200 metres with **STELLA** then becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels for a distance having to be firmly restrained. **FINANCIAL TERRORIST** then over-raced through the middle stages.

KATINKA (J Whiteside) shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight finishing wide out on the track.
