Race 1	Gilmours Tauranga 3YO				
SILVER ECLIPSE (L Innes) and LAUGH (M Dee) came together leaving the barriers when both runners began awkwardly.					
SHEZHARDTOCATCH (P Taylor) began awkwardly shifting in inconveniencing AREUFREE (J Jago) which had been a little slow					
to begin.					
SHEZHARDTOCATCH over-raced when being restrained approaching the 900 metres.					
J Jago, the rider of AREUFREE, dropped his whip near the 250 metres.					
SHEZHARDTOCATCH was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.					
Race 2	Frank King 1200				
PANNA COTTA (R Hutchings) shifted in abruptly leaving the barriers crowding CLAREVILLE FLIGHT (P Turner) and EL					
BANDIDO (L Innes) with CLAREVILLE FLIGHT losing ground.					
THE PATRIOT (A Forbes) began awkwardly shifting out briefly crowding THORNBURY (M Dee).					
SATANICO (S Spratt) shifted out leaving the barriers making contact with SILVER PLATTER (K Leung) which became briefly unbalanced.					
PANNA COTTA shifted in approaching the bend near the 900 metres placing UNICORN'S PRESENT (M McNab) and					
SATANICO in restricted room. UNICORN'S PRESENT was then steadied.					
FLOSSY THE CAT (BR Jones) was steadied when in restricted room passing the 900 metres going back on to EL BANDIDO					
which was hampered having to shift out forcing CLAREVILLE FLIGHT wider. CLAREVILLE FLIGHT then raced wide without					
cover.					
THE PATRIOT hung outwards rounding the final turn forcing CLAREVILLE FLIGHT over extra ground. THE PATRIOT					
continued to hang out in the final straight with Rider A Forbes advising that the gelding had raced greenly in its race day					

debut.

EL BANDIDO had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight.

SATANICO shifted out under pressure inconveniencing PANNA COTTA near the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **CLAREVILLE FLIGHT** rider P Turner advised that in his opinion the mare would benefit from the addition of blinkers which he had recommended to the mare's connections.

Crockford Real Estate 2100 Race 3 Shortly after leaving the barriers LADY LINDAUER (J Oliver) shifted out and away from ENCHARM (M Sweeney) making contact with CANDY GIRL (S Spratt) with LADY LINDAUER then laying out further dictating CANDY GIRL into the line of OUR JESSE JANE (M Wenn) which then made contact with the hind guarters of KICK BUTTOWSKI (L Innes) and was checked losing ground. Passing the 1900 metres ENCHARM had to be steadied when crowded by LADY LINDAUER which shifted in. J Oliver was issued with a warning. Also near the 1900 metres KICK BUTTOWSKI had to be steadied away from the heels of MAY (M Dee) which shifted in. M Dee was issued with a warning. MAY made the first bend awkwardly when having a tendency to lay out. OUR JESSE JANE briefly became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHEQUESINTHEMAIL (A Forbes) rounding the final turn approaching the 350 metres. MANGAROA HUSTLER lost the left hind plate during the running. **Gartshore Construction 1600** Race 4 EASY STREET (G Coetzee) began awkwardly. CURTAIN CALL (S Spratt) began awkwardly shifting out and crowding ALEZAN (R Hutchings). ASADAUSKAITE (M Sweeney) began a little awkwardly shifting in inconveniencing SOUND (O Bosson). QUEEN OF CLUBS (K Leung) over-raced when being restrained approaching the 1200 metres. CURTAIN CALL shifted out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing ASADAUSKAITE near the 150 metres. M Sweeney viewed the Stewards' video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest. **CURTAIN CALL** continued to shift out over the concluding stages. QUEEN OF CLUBS shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages. M Sweeney reported that ASADAUSKAITE had felt indifferent in its action over the final stages. A veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality other than the filly appearing to have jarred up on the firm footing. A post-race veterinary examination of FAIRY CAKE which performed poorly did not reveal any abnormality. Rider M Dee advised that the filly had travelled comfortably but once placed under pressure had been quickly beaten and was unable to offer any excuses other than that the filly may be better suited by some easing of the ground. **TOETWOTOE** lost the right front plate during the running. The Genera Genus 1600 Race 5 FLUORO LITE (K Leung) began awkwardly. KELLY O'REILLY (L Innes) was a little slow to begin. Approaching the 1500 metres GREY POWER (M Sweeney) had to be steadied off the heels of BEGUILE (M Wenn) which shifted in. **KELLY O'REILLY** was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout. **MAGIC SHAFT** (A Forbes) had a tendency to over-race on a moderate pace through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance of MAGIC SHAFT rider A Forbes was unable to offer any excuses advising that the gelding had appeared to have switched off. **Tauranga Hardware & Plumbing Centennial 1300** Race 6 ZANKURO (P Turner) was slow to begin. TEN BELLES (S Spratt) over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres and got its head up for a distance when being steadied to avoid the heels of FLEUR DE LUNE (J Jago). TEN BELLES shifted away from ANTONIO LOMBARDO (L Innes) crowding MADE MY POINT (K Leung) near the 200 metres. After being corrected by its rider **TEN BELLES** then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **ANTONIO LOMBARDO** which shifted in near the 150 metres before being corrected. Race 7 Stewart Browne Group 1400 STANICA STAR (M Dee) was a little slow to begin. DAY WALKER (M Sweeney) shifted in leaving the barriers crowding ALMON (M McNab) and KIJANI (R Hutchings). KLITSCHKO (P Turner) had to be steadied shortly after leaving the barriers when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SACRED STAR (LInnes). KATI CAT (R Smyth) commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 1200 metres and continued to do so for a distance.

KATI CAT hung outwards around the bend.

THE HOTZ (T Wenn) lay in under pressure in the final straight.

KLITSCHKO shifted in near the 100 metres hampering the weakening KIJANI. P Turner was issued with a warning.

Race 8 Aztech Signs Tauranga 1400

RICH BILLIE MARSH (M Wenn) shifted in abruptly leaving the barriers hampering **MATAATUA** (P Taylor) which lost ground. **SO BLING** (R Hutchings) and **IVENOIDA** (M Sweeney) began awkwardly.

ALL IN BLUFF (K Joyce) was slow to begin.

FAIRY STORY (S Spratt) was a shade slow to begin.

MANAIA ROSE (K Leung) had to be restrained off heels when over-racing near the 900 metres.

RAVELLO (A Forbes) raced three wide without cover.

When questioned regarding the performance of **FAIRY STORY** rider S Spratt was of the opinion that the filly would benefit from the addition of blinkers and would also now be better suited over more distance.
