| Race 1 | CENTENNIAL PARK '1800' |
| <p>HUNKY DORY (J Riddell), VENDEMAIRE (M Cameron) and MAHORA GOLD (M Du Plessis) were all slow to begin.</p> <p>THE LINK (M Hills) hung out rounding the final turn.</p> <p>TE ATATU PRINCESS (K Myers) was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>EVENADUCHESS (M Dee) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of THE LINK entering the final straight near the 250 metres.</p> <p>SOCIETY ROSE (A Jones) was held up for clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>VICEROY (A Forbes) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> | |
| Race 2 | RACING TAUPU MEMBERS '1000' |
| <p>RED CAVIAR (D Johnson) reared at the start and was further hampered by CIRCUS (M Dee) which began awkwardly and shifted in.</p> | |

| <p>DAFT PUNK (C Grylls) was slow to begin being further hampered by KONTIKI (T Wenn) which shifted out leaving the barriers.</p> <p>GRACIELLA (M Cameron) was slow away.</p> <p>DAFT PUNK raced ungenerously when being steadied going into the bend near the 800 metres and made the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>LOTTI O'REILLY (J Oliver) had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of FULL CHARGE (S Spratt).</p> <p>CIRCUS ran wide around the bend into the final straight finishing out wide on the track.</p> <p>THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN (R Myers) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DAFT PUNK shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.</p> | |
| Race 3 | LANCE NOBLE RACING 3YO |
| <p>LUCKY FEATHER (O Bosson) after being fractious in the barriers dropped its head when the barriers opened and began very awkwardly losing ground. Co-trainer Mr T Autridge was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the colt.</p> <p>HARDCORE ROCK (M Cameron) began awkwardly and shifted in hampering ZAMBARI (M Coleman).</p> <p>DARTING (M Ulucinar) began awkwardly.</p> <p>DARTING shifted out abruptly when being steadied near the 1100 metres hampering LUCKY FEATHER.</p> <p>ZAMBARI commenced to over-race badly passing the 1000 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.</p> <p>LUCKY FEATHER raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>DESERT EXPRESS (A Forbes) commenced to hang out passing the 400 metres and continued to shift out despite the efforts of its rider into the line of SIR DARCI (K Myers) which had to be firmly restrained on the point of the turn near the 300 metres to avoid the heels of DESERT EXPRESS. ZAMBARI which was following SIR DARCI then clipped a heel of SIR DARCI and fell heavily. SIR DARCI was not persevered with following this incident. M Coleman was stood down from his remaining rides suffering from bruising and soreness in a shoulder. A medical clearance is required prior to M Coleman riding next.</p> <p>DESERT EXPRESS required veterinary attention following the race after being galloped on requiring suturing of superficial lacerations.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of the fallen ZAMBARI which was bleeding from the nostrils found this to be as a result of lacerations. ZAMBARI was also sore behind.</p> | |

| <p>SACRED SPIN (L Innes) and TRADE TIME (C Grylls) both over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>TRADE TIME raced greenly rounding the final turn and in the straight.</p> <p>MISS SELBY (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> | |
| Race 5 | TIMELESS TAUPO RADIO FREE-FOR-ALL '1000' |
| <p>BENZINI (M Dee) was slow away.</p> <p>OUR FOXY LADY (M Du Plessis) shifted out leaving the barriers causing crowding to QUALITY STREET (R Myers), ELYSIUM (S Collett), KOOL GAL (M Cameron) and PIPEDREAMS (C Grylls) which was forced into the line of BENZINI further hampering that runner.</p> <p>PIPEDREAMS made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.</p> <p>LA TOURNEAU (L Innes) went off stride passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>Approaching the 500 metres ELYSIUM had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of TAOIST MASTER (A Forbes) for several strides.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres PIT A PAT (D Johnson) lay out inconveniencing QUALITY STREET.</p> <p>OUR FOXY LADY was unable to obtain clear running over the final 250 metres.</p> <p>Near the 150 metres QUALITY STREET was crowded by ELYSIUM which was taken in by ASON (M McNab) losing ground.</p> <p>Approaching the 100 metres PIT A PAT continued to lay out, and was then crowded having to be steadied to the inside of ELYSIUM which was taken in by ASON.</p> | |

| <p>ENUFFISENUFF (M Dee) was slow to begin, and was further hampered when JULINSKY PRINCE (J Parkes) shifted in.</p> <p>TRAVINO (S Spratt) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MAGIC SHAFT (A Forbes) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>CASUAL FLING (K Myers) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of BOY STAR (D Johnson) when over-racing approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>JULINSKY PRINCE raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres CASUAL FLING made contact with BOY STAR when shifting out to obtain clear running then had to shift back in being held up for a short distance.</p> | |
| Race 7 | DPA CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS '1300' |

WOW WHATA PRINCESS (J Parkes) and **SLOSHED** (M Du Plessis) were both slow to begin.

HOT CHA (C Grylls) raced ungenerously in the early stages, and made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres forcing **THEDEPOT** (J Riddell) a little wider on the track.

MILAN MISS (M Dee) was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

VICTORY DRAGON (O Bosson) lay out making the final bend, and continued to shift out in the final straight finishing wide on the track.

TSAR REFORMER (S Collett) lay out under pressure in the final straight.
