| Race 1 | BNZ PARTNERS FAREWELL TO DAVE 1400 |
| <p>FREEDOM (K Joyce) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>HAPPY MAN (C Grylls) was slow to begin then further hampered when runners to either side shifted ground. HAPPY MAN then raced greenly in the early stages.</p> <p>K Myers admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount SCORCHING to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of IMAGUNAKEPA (P Turner) which was forced into the line of TOKOMUTU JUDGE (M Sweeney) which was checked near the 1000 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended Ms Myers from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 September up to and including racing on Friday 20 September (3 days), and in addition imposed a fine of \$600.</p> | |
| Race 2 | TOM & DON'S TRIBUTE TO DUNSTAN DAVE 1400 |
| <p>CEE TEE ARE (A Taylor) and PAJARO (M Du Plessis) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>ZAH OFF (S Collett) was slow to begin then further hampered when HIDRIFTER (J Oliver) shifted in.</p> <p>EMBLEM (M Sweeney) was crowded between DANDEE BOY (B R Jones) and CHANTILLY ROSE (T Thornton) passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>MANNY (O Bosson) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>CEE TEE ARE made contact with the running rail going into the bend near the 800 metres when racing in restricted room.</p> <p>MANNY made the 800 metre turn awkwardly.</p> <p>STRICTLY LIMITED (A Jones) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>When attempting to improve to the outside of DANDEE BOY, ZAH OFF (S Collett) was taken out by that runner near the 300 metres forcing CHANTILLY ROSE wider.</p> <p>MANNY shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.</p> | |

NOSECONDPRIZE (M Hills) was slow to begin before being further hampered when **HIDDEN KEY** (M Du Plessis) jumped in sharply leaving the barriers. **HIDDEN KEY** was then hampered by **CARMEN SANDIEGO** (K Myers) which shifted out after jumping away.

MR GARCIA (O Bosson) began a little awkwardly.

UNDERTHERADAR (M Cameron) over-raced for a distance when being restrained near the 1200 metres.

MR GARCIA raced three wide without cover.

CARMEN SANDIEGO was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **MR GARCIA** near the 200 metres with **MR GARCIA** being inclined to lay in.

I'M ALL YOURS (C Grylls) had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres.

MR GARCIA was eased down over the final stages. Rider O Bosson advised that after travelling wide the gelding had lay in once placed under pressure in the straight and had been unable to quicken. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

GO JOELI (O Bosson) jumped away awkwardly.

SIR AMRON (J Jago) over-raced in the early stages.

DELICIANO (B Grylls) got its head up when being steadied shortly after the start.

When questioned regarding the performance of **DELICIANO** apprentice B Grylls advised that the mare had travelled comfortably in the early and middle stages, but had failed to quicken as anticipated when asked to do so, adding that in her opinion the mare would benefit from the outing.

MISS FOXWOOD (M Du Plessis) began a little awkwardly.

Passing the 1000 metres **MATAURI BAY** (M Hills) shifted out across the heels of **AZERBAIJAN** (D Johnson) when being steadied hampering **SING LIKE ELLA** (M Dee).

ALCHEMY'S FLIGHT (M Cameron) over-raced through the middle stages when racing outside the leader.

SING LIKE ELLA (M Dee) ducked in becoming unbalanced passing the 450 metres, and was not persevered with in the final straight. Rider M Dee advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action rounding the bend. **SING LIKE ELLA** underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
