MR HARE was steadied to avoid the heels of BEAU AGEN near the 600 metres, dropping back on to GOOD RISK, which was					
hampered.					
GOOD RISK was briefly held up early in the final straight.					
HERE'S DE CONSUL had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened by its rider on					
two occasions.					
KING OF ROCK lost the right hind plate during the running.					
When questioned into the run of LORD OF THE STARS, which finished well back rider J Parkes advised that the gelding had					
felt a little indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

MISS DAISY lost its footing jumping away.					
LUSTRE lay out shortly after leaving the barriers crowding PERRY MASON and MACNAMARA.					
JOE COOL was slow to begin.					
FALZANO had to be steadied off the heels of MISS DAISY (D Johnson) which shifted in passing the 1000 metres when not					

fully clear. D Johnson was advised to exercise more care.
GEMMA LASS raced three wide without cover.
BRAXY'S IMAGE raced wide throughout.
GEMMA LASS lost the left hind plate near the 600 metres.
