RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	K R BELL ELECTRICAL 1600
<p>SUGGEST GOLD (J Wong) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered by FAIRY CAKE (M Coleman) which shifted out shortly after the start.</p> <p>ARCEE (V Gatu) jumped away awkwardly, and then was placed in restricted room when KATY O'BEEL (N Harris) shifted in.</p> <p>VROD (S Collett) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Passing the 1500 metres COPPER QUEEN (U Holmquist) shifted in slightly making contact with VROD. COPPER QUEEN then reacted poorly shifting out abruptly, into the line of EL PISTOLA (T Thornton) which was hampered, losing ground.</p> <p>ABSOLUTE GEM (C Dell) commenced to over-race crossing on to the course proper near the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed inside BAD TASTE (R Smyth) which was over racing, becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of JOCHEN RINDT (M Wenn). ABSOLUTE GEM then made contact with the hind quarters of FAIRY CAKE which became unbalanced and shifted out abruptly, badly hampering ABSOLUTE GEM which lost considerable ground. As a result EVA QUICK STEPH (A Jones) which was following was also hampered. Apprentice rider R Smyth was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>ARCEE raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of KATY O'BEEL rider N Harris could offer no tangible excuses.</p>	

Race 2	PETER HOWLAND'S BEAUREPAIRES MATAMATA 1600
<p>STYLE IS ETERNAL (T Wenn) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out abruptly, hampering CHARLIE BOY (M Wenn) which had been slow to begin.</p> <p>PRIZE LAD (J Wong) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in making firm contact with RICH TED (B R Jones).</p> <p>QUANTUM MAELSTROM (M Coleman) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>QUANTUM MAELSTROM was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 3	ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1200
<p>YSABELLA BRAVE (U Holmquist) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out, making contact with PERIA PRINCESS (M Sweeney) which became unbalanced.</p> <p>DAHLS DELIGHT (M Wenn) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DELLA LAMOUR (L Satherley) lay out when making the final bend.</p>	
Race 4	ELECTRICO LIMITED 1200
<p>ROLL WITH PULSE (M Coleman) was slow to begin.</p> <p>TRONIC ROSE (T Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MR MENDELSSOHN commenced to over-race in the early stages with the saddle slipping forward approaching the 800 metres placing rider C Grylls at a distinct disadvantage.</p> <p>IRISH HEARTBEAT (M Hills) raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 5	SENSORTRONIC SCALES 1400
<p>JUST JULIET (C Dell) began awkwardly, shifting out and making contact with LOVER BOY (M Wenn).</p> <p>ZEDENUF (J Oliver) began awkwardly, shifting out, making contact with ABBEY ROSE (J Wong) which had knuckled leaving the barrier. ABBEY ROSE then shifted out and crowded APACHEE TAAT (U Holmquist) which had begun poorly.</p> <p>MR TOPZ (R Hutchings) and ELLE GRACE (S Collett) were slow to begin.</p> <p>Linking on to the course proper passing the 1200 metres MAN ABOUT TOWN (V Gatu) lay in and away from KANALI (C Grylls) making contact with ABBEY ROSE.</p> <p>EL SPARKY (M Coleman) raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>Approaching the 900 metres MR TOPZ raced ungenerously when being restrained. As a result APACHEE TAAT became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels approaching the 800 metres running wide.</p> <p>Approaching the 400 metres ABBEY ROSE shifted out under pressure with MR TOPZ shifting away from that runner, crowding ELLE GRACE. As a result APACHEE TAAT became awkwardly placed on the heels of ELLE GRACE.</p> <p>EL SPARKY was held up when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres HEART OF GRACE (A Jones) commenced to shift in under pressure with MAN ABOUT TOWN then shifting out when struck with the whip, crowding MR TOPZ which then had to be steadied, losing ground. Also inconvenienced was ABBEY ROSE. Apprentice riders A Jones and V Gatu were both reprimanded by Stewards and further advised warnings would be placed on their records.</p>	
Race 6	REID & HARRISON (1980) LIMITED 1600
<p>KATORIE (M Cameron) was slow to begin.</p> <p>CARDON BOY (L Satherley) knuckled leaving the barrier.</p> <p>ALL ABOUT FUN (P Turner) lay out when leaving the barriers, crowding SO KEEP ME (T Wenn).</p> <p>HEZ COOL (A Jones) shifted in soon after leaving the barrier despite the efforts of its rider, crowding SILK CHARDONNAY (M Coleman) which was hampered. HEZ COOL then shifting in further crowding NGATIRA GOLD (T Thornton), OOMPA (J Wong), CHART THE STARS (A Taylor), ATTICA (R Hutchings) and CARBIDE (C Grylls) with CHART THE STARS, ATTICA and CARBIDE all having to steady losing ground.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD had to steady approaching the 300 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of OOMPA the connections advised that the gelding would prefer more rain-affected footing.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of KATORIE rider M Cameron advised that the filly would be more suited when ridden in the open clear of other runners. KATORIE underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SO KEEP ME received veterinary attention following the race for a haematoma on the right foreleg.</p>	
Race 7	NZI 2000
<p>FAIR FLEET (U Holmquist) and NANCYLEE (R Hutchings) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>BAHHTON (C Grylls) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Passing the 1700 metres BAHHTON raced ungenerously when being restrained.</p>	

TE KINGI (R Smyth) commenced to race keenly passing the 1000 metres.

BAHHTON and **RUSSIANOV** (T Thornton) came together passing the 500 metres.

Race 8

ALLIED SECURITY 2000

SUNTORY (A Taylor) began awkwardly shifting in and crowding **ARZAK** (M Cameron) on to **KAKAHU NELL** (K Leung) which was hampered.

RETROSPECT (R Hutchings) was a little slow to begin.

LUCKY CHARM (B R Jones) began awkwardly shifting out on to **BALLYPIPER** (J Wong) which was then further crowded by **LUCKY TONIGHT** (C Grylls) shifting in.

KOKANEE GOLD (S McKay) began awkwardly, shifting out and making contact with **SNEAKY FEELINGS** (A Jones).

STRAIGHT FURROW (P Turner) raced wide without cover when making the first bend.

Passing the 800 metres **SNEAKY FEELINGS** knuckled and fell dislodging rider A Jones. **COOL ONE** (C Dell) and **LUCKY CHARM** which were following were both hampered by the fallen horse dislodging their respective riders. Hampered as a result were **ROOF OF RECKONING** (U Holmquist), **EL CORBY** (L Satherley) and **BALLYPIPER**. All riders that were dislodged were cleared by medical staff, but are to undergo further medical examinations prior to riding tomorrow.

SNEAKY FEELINGS received veterinary treatment for minor head trauma and generalised bruising.

LUCKY CHARM received veterinary treatment for a minor abrasion to a front leg.

Trainer J Ruddell undertook to report the condition of **COOL ONE**.
