RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CR GRACE STEEPLECHASE 4150M
<p>RIPDIDDLER was inclined to over-race in the early stages</p> <p>HONEY (J Forbes) jumped indifferently early, losing ground getting well back and after jumping the fence near the 3500m was withdrawn from the race. When questioned J Forbes said the mare raced erratically early and jumped indifferently proving difficult for her to control. Trainer K Myers advised Stewards that HONEY would be retired.</p> <p>WILBUR commenced to give ground passing the 1400 metres and was pulled up near the 900 metres.</p> <p>AUTHENTIC hit the fence near the 1200 and lost ground.</p> <p>RIPDIDDLER hit the fence near the 1000 resulting in the saddle shifting forward placing rider G Walsh at a disadvantage.</p> <p>MCCULLEY misjudged the final fence and fell inconveniencing the trailing AYATOLLAH, MISTER DEEJAY, REYNARDS BRO and BALLY HEIGHTS all having to take evasive action.</p> <p>In attempting to run down the second last fence, RIPDIDDLER jumped awkwardly and dislodged G Walsh who was attended to by St John's personnel and referred for treatment for a suspected broken nose.</p>	
Race 2	WATER FORCE/WELL DRILLERS WANGANUI MAIDEN 1600M
<p>GIPSY STAR dislodged S Doyle on route to the start and after galloping a considerable distance was re-captured and cleared to start after undergoing a veterinary examination.</p> <p>ANNHEE SAPLAYA was slow away.</p>	

<p>DANCE IN THE PARK was slow over the early stages and settled back. PREMEAUX over-raced when running wide passing the 1200. EARL SPENCER was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout. Near the 400 metres D Bradley the rider of ST'RUTH was observed to take a hold when FLOOZIE CAT (J Riddell) shifted out when marginally clear in order to continue to improve. J Riddell was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding the performance BOOM BOOM BRAHMA, T Thornton said the mare failed to see out the 1600 metres. J Parkes advised that OH THAT'S NICE raced greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 3	H&T AGRONOMICS/AGRICOM 3YO MAIDEN 1200M
<p>BAM BAM shifted out on jumping bumping with LOLA which shifted out into the line of FIVE TARTS which was checked and lost ground. ROD'S LINCOLN was slow to begin. THORN PASS was held up rounding the turn before obtaining clear running near the 200 metres Apprentice rider L Whelan reported that HE'S GOLD had raced greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 4	NUFARM HANDICAP 2100M
<p>WAITAHA TOA and SUPERTURF were slow to begin. JOSEPHINE clipped the heels of OUR GAZZA near the 1200 metres. Rider D Walsh was of the opinion JOSEPHINE struggled under the 59.5 kilos on the improved Slow 9 track.</p>	
Race 5	JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY HANDICAP 2200M
<p>MR COOL BOY raced three-wide without cover in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward near the 1600 metres to sit outside the leader. SELWYN raced three-wide without cover over the final 1400 metres. READY EDDIE was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring SELAMAT which was inclined to lug outwards throughout. CITADELLE was inclined to shift ground inward under pressure over the final 200 metres.</p>	
Race 6	FARMERS TRANSPORT HANDICAP 1400M
<p>BARSTORM was slow to begin. FLEMINGTON shifted in on jumping away hampering GOLDEN MISS which lost ground. IAMISHWARA commenced to over-race for a short distance passing the 1100 metres. ARNOLD raced wide throughout without cover. RED MAFIA was inclined to lay out under pressure over the final stages and had to be straightened. Apprentice L Whelan advised that FOR PETESAKE travelled poorly throughout and was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary inspection of FOR PETESAKE which tailed off revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 7	WRIGHT LIVESTOCK/MANAWATU TOYOTA HANDICAP 1400M
<p>DRAGON BEAUTY and RALPH'S GIFT bumped when the start was made. SOUTHERN SECRET raced wide without cover throughout. DRAGON BEAUTY lay in under pressure down the final straight and had to be straightened on several occasions. D Walsh (DRAGON BEAUTY) dropped his whip near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of RALPH'S GIFT, R Hannam could offer no tangible excuses but was of the opinion that the gelding may benefit from a freshen up.</p>	
Race 8	PILET CONTRACTING/PIONEER SEEDS HANDICAP 1200M
<p>TALK THE TORQUE was slow in the early stages. SHE'S SLINKY raced three-wide without cover throughout. REPLACE lay out in the early part of the final straight dictating COOL MOON and ATOZED wider. SAM I AM and SHE'S SLINKY brushed near the 150 metres COOL MOON lay in and bumped with REPLACE near the post. When questioned regarding the run of TALK THE TORQUE, M Dravitski reported the gelding was unsuited by the track conditions down near the rail.</p>	
Race 9	MERIAL ANCARE METRIC MILE 1600M (GROUP 3)
<p>COMMETT and ALL IN CLOVER were slow to begin. ORMOND ROAD raced very wide without cover throughout.</p>	

INTRANSIGENT; THRIVE and **KARLA BRUNI** bumped near the 1000.

SACHA was unable to quicken sufficiently into a narrow run near the 200 metres prior to being angled inwards to improve.

THUNDERBIRD ONE and **ONE ABOVE** bumped when in restricted room passing the 200 metres

When questioned regarding the run of **THUNDERBIRD ONE**, **J Riddell** said that when placed under pressure prior to turning for home the gelding failed to quicken as he expected.

Race 10

MARSH INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP 1600M

JOJO began awkwardly.

SUGGEST was slow to begin.

QUALITY ROYAL was crowded on jumping away when runners on either side shifted ground. **QUALITY ROYAL** then raced wide throughout.

QUALITY ROYAL hung out on the turn and forced **SUGGEST** over extra ground.

QUEEN OF ROCK was held up early in the final straight.

D Walsh reported that **QUALITY ROYAL** hung out throughout.

When questioned into the run of **I SUGGEST**, rider **R Hannam** was of the opinion that the mare may be better suited to a more rain affected track.
