RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TYRES & WHEELS / McCALLUMS DRYCLEAING MAIDEN (1400M)
<p>ALYSSA BELLE shifted out at the start hampering SPIC N SPAN which lost ground. Passing the 1000 metres POACH THE CASH which was racing keenly shifted out dictating KATIE'S DIAMOND wider on the track for some distance. POACH THE CASH shifted in under pressure and in the shadows of the post placed ALYSSA BELLE in restricted room. V Johnson the rider of ALYSSA BELLE viewed replays of this incident before deciding not to proceed with a Protest. Stewards questioned C Johnson regarding the performance of LUKANDER with Mr Johnson advising that the gelding had only battled in today's testing track conditions.</p>	
Race 2	COUNTRY JEWEL / SPAIN & SMITH SHEARING & TAILING CONTRACTORS MAIDEN (1200M)
<p>SETARIME who was slow to begin raced greenly and hung throughout. Passing the 600 metres SETARIME which was continuing to hang shifted wider on the track losing ground. A warning was placed on the racing manners of SETARIME. Apprentice rider A Morgan advised that SETARIME had got its tongue over the bit. When spoken to trainer M Pitman advised he would be making gear adjustments to improve the racing manners of the</p>	

mare.	
Race 3	THE BIOFEED COMPANY HANDICAP (1600M)
<p>AMIGO raced wide over the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 550 metres PETER PARROT raced in restricted room for several strides when attempting a run to the inside of SPARE A FORTUNE.</p> <p>ESPRIT D'OR was obliged to race wide from the 500 metres when improving forward.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favourite KINA WIN apprentice rider A Denby advised the Stewards her mount had been flat throughout, only battled over the concluding stages and had disappointed.</p> <p>Trainer M Pitman advised it was now his intention to retire SPARE A FORTUNE as a racing proposition from his stable.</p>	
Race 4	H.E.N BATT & SON / SADDLERY WAREHOUSE INVERCARGILL HANDICAP (1600M)
<p>DAME LA JANE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to race.</p> <p>CONTADOR raced wide over the early stages.</p> <p>GOLDEN TOWER raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>CONTADOR and COUP ROTORUA were both held up for several strides passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>COUP ROTORUA had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the run home.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres DRUMREIMS shifted out under pressure momentarily hampering HOWLONGDOWEWAIT.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of GOLDEN TOWER rider J BULLARD advised the Stewards his mount had only battled over the concluding stages however would derive benefit from today's outing.</p>	
Race 5	VINCENT LANGFORD MEMORIAL / LINTON CONTRACTING MAIDEN (1600M)
<p>ENCHANTER was slow to begin.</p> <p>INDIANA JONES raced wide throughout.</p> <p>KING KONG raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres MISSCATTLECREEK (D Prastiyou) which was laying out shifted out when struck with the whip in the left hand crowding and unbalancing I'M EMPTY (S Muniandy).</p> <p>Apprentice rider D Prastiyou in the presence of Mr E Winsloe admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) Careless Riding. After viewing the relevant replays and hearing evidence and submissions from apprentice Prastiyou, Mr Winsloe and the Stewards the JCA suspended Mr Prastiyou's riding licence for 2 days effective from 19th September to 27th September inclusive.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of SEE YOU AT DIVAS rider T Moseley advised the Stewards that the mare was not suited by the sit and sprint nature of the race but added SEE YOU AT DIVAS would gain benefit from today's race.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of KING KONG trainer J Dalton advised the Stewards the gelding had been working well during the week and had benefited from the extra distance of today's race.</p>	
Race 6	NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING / BULLIED ENGINEERING HANDICAP (1200M)
<p>STRIKE UP THE BAND raced keenly through the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres ON THE TAKE (R Doherty) shifted out forcing STRIKE UP THE BAND out into the line of GALLIVANT with both these runners being buffeted and losing momentum.</p> <p>Apprentice rider R Doherty admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) Careless Riding. After viewing the relevant replays and hearing evidence and submissions the JCA suspended Mr Doherty's riding licence for 2 days effective from 22nd September to 28th September inclusive.</p>	
Race 7	ADVANCE AGRICULTURE & CLOVERTONE HANDICAP (1200M)
<p>ARISTA began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>LA GIRL also began awkwardly.</p> <p>ARISTA raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres LA GIRL which was racing keenly shifted out abruptly when awkwardly placed on the heels of TUATAP.</p> <p>TUATAP was inclined to hang out on the home bend.</p> <p>NAVIGATOR had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.</p> <p>Stewards requested a post-race veterinary examination of LA GIRL which returned to the birdcage with blood present in both its mouth and left nostril. The subsequent examination revealed a laceration inside the left nostril and a tooth missing consistent with the mare having struck its head.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of NAVIGATOR rider R Doherty advised his mount had travelled well throughout however when placed under pressure had failed to respond and proved disappointing.</p>
