## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>JIMMY "THE PUMPER" CASSIDY – 100 GROUP ONE</b>
<b>BLACK DRAGON</b> (D Turner) was slow away. <b>ANDALOU</b> (B Lammas) was crowded leaving the barriers. <b>ANDALOU</b> was steadied when racing in restricted room near the 1800 metres. <b>PAUL</b> (K Smith) raced three wide without cover around the first bend before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres. <b>SEAWEED</b> (K Kalychurun) race wide without cover throughout. <b>DALKEITH</b> (R Norvall) had to steady when in restricted room near the 600 metres. <b>PLATINUM MARSEILLE</b> (J Parkes) was held up for a short distance on entering the home straight. <b>BLACK DRAGON</b> finished some distance last and rider D Turner advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no significant abnormalities.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ELECTROLUX BBQ – STAYING THE DISTANCE</b>
<b>GREANDE</b> (H Tinsley) began awkwardly. <b>GRENADE</b> (H Tinsley) raced three wide without cover throughout. <b>MASH</b> (B Lammas) made contact with <b>IMA PERFECT GUY</b> (T Thornton) when attempting to obtain clear racing room near the 400 metres. B Lammas was advised to exercise care. <b>DESI GIRL</b> (J Parkes) lay inwards in the final straight.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SILVER FERN FARMS MAIDEN SPRINT</b>

**HYMN** (A Taylor) was slow away.

**TAKEMEHOMEBABE** (T Thornton) hung outwards throughout the race.

**HONEY QUEEN** (K Smith) raced greenly and near the 1000 metres shifted outwards abruptly hampering **ITSAGEM** (A Frye).

**HONEY QUEEN** then raced three wide without cover and continued to race greenly in the home straight. Rider K Smith recommended to the connections that the blinkers be removed prior to the filly's next start.

**ZVONAREVA** (C Grylls) was momentarily held up passing the 250 metres.

**HYMN** hung inwards under pressure over the concluding stages and had to be straightened. As a result the mare was unable to be fully ridden out to the line. Rider A Taylor advised that the mare had raced greenly throughout.

Over the final stages **TAKEMEHOMEBABE** and **ZVONAREVA** bumped.

When questioned regarding the performance of **CARMODY** rider J Riddell was of the opinion that the gelding may have been feeling the firm nature of the footing.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ORTON CATERING SPRINT</b>

**ROCKWEILER** (J Riddell) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.

**THATS HOW WE ROLL** (M Dee) was slow away.

**GOLD MOET** (H Tinsley) over-raced when disputing the lead in the middle stages.

**ROCKWEILER** got its head up when being restrained off heels approaching the 600 metres and shifted out hampering **LADY OF TROY** (R Norvall).

**THAT'S HOW WE ROLL** disappointed finishing last. Rider M Dee had no excuse and stated his mount was outpaced throughout.

A post-race veterinary inspection of **THAT'S HOW WE ROLL** failed to reveal any abnormality.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>THE FURNWARE CUP</b>

**NEEDLLY (S Wong)** was slow away.

**TOMA VALEA** (T Thornton) was held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

**REVELATOR** (M DEE) was held up early in the final straight and raced in restricted room to the inside of weakening **HAYLEY ROSE** (A Taylor) near the 200 metres.

**REVELATOR** returned to the enclosure with blood present in its left nostril. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a laceration consistent with having hit the front of its gate when being fractious in the barrier prior to the start.

**MANU** (J Riddell) over-raced in the early stages and was left three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

**SONATA** (B Lammas) was held up passing the 200 metres having to be steadied and shift out across the heels of

**DUNTOILIN** (C Grylls) to obtain clearing running near the 75 metres.

When questioned into the run of **WEISSMULLER** rider J Parkes stated the gelding over-raced throughout and had little left at the finish.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TWILIGHT XMAS AT THE RACES DEC 12<sup>TH</sup> MILE</b>

**KARMAZYN** (S Doyle) made the bend near the 1400 metres getting its head up, dropping back onto **BONAPPETIT** (R Hannam).

**KARMAZYN** and **BONAPPEITE** over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**MISS DIRECTIONAL** (B Lammas) raced three wide without cover.

Near the 350 metres **NEED A DIAMOND** (L Whelan) which was weakening had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MISS DIRECTIONAL**.

**RACQUETOR** (C Grylls) had to be steadied when improving up onto the heels of **SATAY** (T Thornton) near the 150 metres

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>FAWC! MAIDEN</b>

**JACQUI TEE** (K Kalychurun) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

**PEERAGE** (M Dee) raced three wide without cover and had tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages.

**JACQUI TEE** had to be steadied off the heels of **ACQUIESCE** (D Turner) near the 800 metres getting its head up and making the turn awkwardly.

**PEERAGE** lay out rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight.
