RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 DHL COUNTIES CUP NOV 23 1200

CILLIAN WILL (R Smyth) was slow to begin, and then hampered by ANNIEITIZ (J Jago) which shifted in.

GARDEN OF GOLD (J Whiteside) got its head up when making the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres, laying out for the remainder of the race.

S Spratt (VITESSE ROSE) and R Smyth (CILLIAN WILL) were both reminded of their obligations to whip use, prior to the 200 metres.

Race 2 SHAMEXPRESS 1200

BOY (M Hills) was slow to begin.

WAINUI PRINCE (T Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

HAPPYTO KEEPA (K Leung) was inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SILVERDALE** rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had travelled comfortably in the early and middle stages, but once placed under pressure in the final straight had failed to respond as

anticipated, further adding that **SILVERDALE** had not been entirely comfortable in the track conditions when asked to quicken.

BOY lost the off front plate during the running.

Race 3 VERSATILE BUILDINGS 2400

ATLANTIS (M Hills) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered when runners on either side shifted ground.

BOLD RANSOM (A Collett) jumped away awkwardly.

PHEROZARDO (B R Jones) raced keenly in the early stages.

Passing the 1300 metres BOLD RANSOM raced in restricted room to the inside of PHEROZARDO which shifted in. BOLD

RANSOM was then steadied. B R Jones was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must leave sufficient room.

SOLYN (P Turner) commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. Rider P Turner advised that the mare had not felt comfortable nearing the end of the back straight and had failed to respond to pressure. **SOLYN** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed an irregular heart rate, and a slow recovery. The connections of **SOLYN** have advised that it is now their intention to spell the mare.

Following the Race, P Taylor (**BALLYPIPER**) approached the Stewards, requesting to see medical staff. After undergoing an examination P Taylor was stood down from his remaining rides. P Taylor is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Race 4 WWW.THEINFORMANT.CO.NZ 1400

Trainer P Lock was fined \$50 by the JCA for presenting **SWAP FOR KASH** (J Whiteside) to race with the incorrect saddle cloth.

MISTAAR (S Spratt) was slow to begin.

ELUDE (D Johnson) raced keenly in the early stages.

SWAP FOR KASH was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

SWAP FOR KASH was inclined to lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure.

PAN DULCE (R Smyth) raced greenly under pressure over the final 100 metres.

J Whiteside (**SWAP FOR KASH**) was advised that a warning would be placed on her record as she had used the whip in a manner deemed to be excessive by the Stewards prior to the 200 metres.

Race 5 NIAGARA AT LIME COUNTRY 1600

JOEY JONZ (A Taylor) over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages, and passing the 1000 metres shifted out when making the first bend with **BACHELOR ZEEL** (D Johnson) becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels, having to steady.

KATINKA (J Whiteside) commenced to hang out when making the first bend passing the 1000 metres, and continued to do so for the remainder of the bend forcing **JESSHANIMO** (A Collett) wider on the track.

JOEY JONZ ducked out under pressure approaching the 50 metres inconveniencing BACHELOR ZEEL.

The connections of the second placed horse **BACHELOR ZEEL** wished to view Stewards footage following the race alleging interference inside the final 100 metres, electing not to proceed with an objection.

Race 6 AUCKLAND THOROUGHBRED OWNERS ASSOCIATION 1600

KAAP'S PRINCESS (P Turner) and IPONI (K Leung) were both slow to begin.

DANCING ON TABLES (S Spratt) over-raced in the early stages.

MARMI (M McNab) and LADY OF TROY (R Smyth) both raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **SEAMS LIKE MAGIC** rider A Taylor advised that the mare had travelled well in the early and middle stages, but had failed to respond once placed under pressure entering the final straight. **SEAMS LIKE MAGIC** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormalities.

Race 7 WESTBURY STUD KARAKA CLASSIC 1600

POSTMANS DAUGHTER (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

DANZA LAD (K Chiong) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Approaching the 400 metres MATOST (M Wenn) shifted out when looking to obtain clear running making contact with the hind quarters of JOHN GRAY (T Thornton). JOHN GRAY then lay in crowding MATOST, simultaneously MAGIC BELLE (J Whiteside) shifted out to obtain clear running placing POSTMANS DAUGHTER and MISS PELEAR (M Hills) in restricted room. As a result MATOST was checked losing ground and MISS PELEAR had to be steadied. J Whiteside was advised that a warning would be placed on her record, and that she must make a greater attempt to straighten her mounts when they are inclined to shift ground.

MAGIC BELLE continued to lay out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing **MATOST** passing the 150 metres.

Apprentice rider K Chiong (**DANZA LAD**) admitted a breach in that she used the whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres, with the JCA imposing a fine of \$250.

Race 8 FUNTIME FOODS 1600

MIDNITE RENDEZVOUS (P Turner) was slow to begin.

CANDY GIRL (B R Jones) and **BOLD MARINER** (D Nolan) began awkwardly.

ANAHEIM (K Leung) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, and passing the 1200 metres, shifted back on to **PACO KID** (S Spratt) which was hampered. **PACO KID** then raced over-raced for a distance.

CANDY GIRL lost the near front plate during the running.
