RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HI DOW PAIN POD MAIDEN DASH (1200m)

ABSOLUTION and GEEZ ALL HEART were both slow to begin.

Passing the 800 metres **GEEZ ALL HEART** had to steady when attempting a marginal run to the inside of **LUVLYBUBBLY**.

D'JAKE was held up in the early part of the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres.

LUVLYBUBBLY was held up for several strides passing the 200 metres and had to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner **WHACKOMACO** rider D Walsh advised that the gelding had become very worked up prior to the race, had raced keenly when in the lead and when placed under full pressure passing the 500 metres failed to respond to his urgings and was disappointing.

A post-race veterinary inspection of **WHACKOMACO** revealed no abnormalities.

Race 2 PORT FM & PATAPAN MAIDEN MILE (1600m)

BONNY SPRING and **COS I CAN** were both slow to begin.

ASHBURY JACK raced keenly in the early stages.

INDIANA JONES raced three wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 1400 metres **BONNY SPRING** had to steady when crowded for room by **FULLOVTRIX** who was carried inwards by **FRENCH LESSON** (V Johnston) who had begun to race keenly and become awkwardly placed on the heels of **SHE'S PAYBACK**. V Johnston was advised to exercise care.

FRENCH LESSON raced keenly for several strides passing the 1000 metres.

CHAIROS had to shift ground inwards at the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner **INDIANA JONES** rider A Denby advised that the gelding had been wide without cover throughout with this effort telling over the final stages. She also added that this was the gelding's second run in five days and may not have backed up.

Rider V Johnston was issued a warning under Rule 638(3)(b) for use of the whip between the 400 metres and 200 metres.

Race 3 ANNE GLENDINING @ CRT REAL ESTATE RATING 65 (1600m)

CORAZANA was slow to begin.

KARAKA JACK blundered on jumping and lost ground.

REALLY RUSTY raced keenly and threw its head in the air when being steadied in the early stages.

KARAKA JACK raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

COUP ROTORUA raced three wide without cover throughout.

KARAKA JACK had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres.

When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner **JUST BOLTING** rider J Bullard advised Stewards the gelding had been very disappointing after travelling well and believed the gelding did not see out the distance of today's race.

Race 4 TEMUKA TRANSPORT (1967) LTD RATING 65 SPRINT (1200m)

SPARK IT UP was slow to begin.

SHOWBRERA was slow over the early stages.

ROC CITY had to be steadied passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **CHARLESTOWN**.

WANNABEAWALLABETOO lay in over the concluding stages with the rider swapping the whip to the left hand.

Stewards questioned rider C Johnson regarding the performance of **ASK ME**. Mr Johnson advised the mare had never travelled throughout and had been disappointing.

Race 5 COUPLAND'S BAKERIES GERALDINE CUP RATING 75 (1200m)

GOOD EXCUSE shifted out abruptly at the start inconveniencing **DILLINGER** who lost ground as a result. **KATRIFFIC** raced keenly when leading.

Race 6 PITMAN RACING STABLES ANNIVERSARY DAY CUP RATING 85 (1200m)

LONDON DREAM underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers and was cleared to start.

PARTY CAT was inclined to lay inwards through the early stages and hampered **EMERALD QUEEN** passing the 900m.

EMERALD QUEEN raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

THEMONEYZMINE also raced keenly and wide through the early to middle stages.

BERENICE raced wide without cover throughout.

DAVONE CODE was held up in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

ZAH GIRL and **LONDON DREAM** made firm contact passing the 100 metres with both runners becoming momentarily unbalanced.

Race 7 ONCEUPONATIME & D'CASH MAIDEN STAYERS (2200m)

MASTERZED was a late scratching on veterinary advice after being found to be lame in the off hind leg. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to the gelding resuming.

DESERT GIRL was slow to begin.

SENORETTE raced keenly through the early stages.

Passing the 1800 metres **GREY TOM** made the bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track with **LADY GUINEVERE** being forced wider as a result.

Passing the 1700 metres **DOWN HERE UP THERE** began to race keenly as the pace eased.

SENORETTE raced wide without cover from the 1600 metres.

Approaching the 450 metres ALJAYAYCH had to steady when making contact with the back of HAWKESBURY.

Passing the 400 metres **LADY GUINEVERE** became unbalanced and had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of **GREY TOM. GREY TOM** lay out throughout the run home.

ALJAYAYCH (L Callaway) shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages and passing the 150 metres made firm contact with **HAWKESBURY**. L Callaway was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).

Inside the last 50 metres HAWKESBURY had to steady when ALJAYAYCH continued to shift ground inwards and

D'CHAPARRAL shifted ground outwards.

Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection of **ALJAYAYCH** after it was observed to be noticeably lame in the near fore with this examination revealing a ruptured flexor tendon. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.
