RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ROGERSON PLUMBING 1200		
ALLEZ EAGLE (L Innes) shifted out abruptly on jumping away making contact with MISS MOSSMAN (D Johnson) forcing that			
runner out on to READY TO RUMBLE (J Whiteside) with both those runners being hampered as a result.			
FRAAJILISTIC (C (Grylls) was slow away.		

GATEWAY (S Spratt) shifted out across the heels of **A'LAROSE** (A Collett) when being restrained near the 900 metres hampering **ALLEZ EAGLE**.

CRYSTALIGHT (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover throughout.

ALLEZ EAGLE commenced to over-race near the 800 metres when the pace steadied.

COSMIC CUBE (M Cameron) was crowded passing the 200 metres when **GATEWAY** lay in away from **ALLEZ EAGLE**. **COSMIC CUBE** then raced in restricted room and made contact with **GATEWAY** when attempting to maintain its line of running with **GATEWAY** being bumped out on to the heels of **ALLEZ EAGLE** which lay in under pressure resulting in **GATEWAY** being briefly hampered near the 100 metres. L Innes was issued with a warning. L Innes the rider of **ALLEZ EAGLE** then attempted to straighten his mount which continued to shift in crowding **COSMIC CUBE** near the 80 metres. Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of **COSMIC CUBE** viewed the Stewards video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 2 CAMBRIDGE JOCKEY CLUB 1200

WHITLEY CHAPEL (M Sweeney) and SNIPPECHEE (A Collett) both began awkwardly losing ground.

ALMON (M McNab), BACHELOR KEEN (M Du Plessis), POSY (L Innes) and KASHMIR (N Harris) all began awkwardly.

BEAUTY'S BEAST (D Johnson) over-raced in the lead and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

ALMON was held up early in the final straight before being angled outwards into the line of **LADY CHAPEL** which was checked near the 250 metres. **CONQUERING KENNY** (C Grylls) was also hampered in this incident. M McNab admitted a subsequent breach of careless riding and was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 10 October up to and including racing on Thursday 17 October (four riding days).

CONQUERING KENNY raced three wide without cover throughout and made the 800 metre turn awkwardly.

KOOL GAL (M Cameron) was held up until passing the 250 metres.

FLICKA OF GOLD (M Coleman) was unable to obtain clear running in the straight until passing the 100 metres.

WHITLEY CHAPEL had to be steadied across the heels of the weakening TAOIST MASTER (A Forbes) near the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BEAUTY'S BEAST** rider D Johnson stated that the gelding had raced fiercely, and in her opinion may benefit from a break. Trainer Mr D Greene confirmed that he was now likely to send **BEAUTY'S BEAST** for a spell.

Race 3 HAMILTON BUILDING SUPPLIES 1200

MELODY CELEBRE (L Innes) was slow away.

TIGER MOSS (C Grylls) began awkwardly.

COPACABANA (N Harris) began awkwardly and shifted out crowding **AUSTIN ROAD** (M Sweeney) and **KELLY O'REILLY** (K Leung). Contributing was inward movement from **STATHAM** (M Cameron).

STARCHEEKA (D Walsh) was firmly restrained passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **KELLY O'REILLY** and shifted out inconveniencing **AUSTIN ROAD** which was over-racing.

STATHAM over-raced when being steadied going into the 800 metre bend.

TRENDY (M Coleman) and BILLIE JEAN KING (M Hills) both raced wide without cover.

EWENIGHT (M Du Plessis) lay out rounding the bend.

AIRFIELD ROAD (C Dell) lay out under pressure in the final straight. Rider C Dell advised that the gelding had hung outwards from the 800 metres.

Race 4 ELEPHANT PLASTERBOARD AT HBS 1200

PINZAARA (S Spratt) was buffeted on jumping away between **CONRWIN** (K Chiong) and **AIRMAN** (D Johnson) which had begun awkwardly with **AIRMAN** becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

AIRMAN commenced to over-race badly when being restrained near the 1000 metres and continued to do so getting its head up and racing ungenerously hampering **GOLD HUNTER** (S Collett) near the 900 metres and **CONRWIN** near the 850 metres. When having to be checked off the heels of **AIRMAN**, **GOLD HUNTER** shifted in hampering **BRELA BELLE** (A Forbes) and **TANGO TERRIFIC** (D Walsh).

MADAM KIRK (A Jones) and PINZAARA both raced wide without cover.

ROLL WITH PULSE (C Grylls) was held up rounding the final turn, and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

CONRWIN was held up from the 200 metres when well back.

Race 5 TOPSOIL & SAND SUPPLIES (2011) LTD 2100

Trainers A Herbert and M Roustoby were \$50 after presenting **UNDERTHERADAR** without notified gear (blinkers).

EXCUSE ME MADAM (P Turner) which had been slow to begin was further hampered when **HAPPY MAN** (M Du Plessis) shifted out forcing **UNDERTHERADAR** (M Cameron) outwards making contact with **EXCUSE ME MADAM**.

BALLROOM (M Dravitzki) began awkwardly shifting out hampering **LUCY BEE** (A Collett) which lost ground.

CAPO (L Innes) was a little slow to begin, and then commenced to over-race when wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

BACHELOR ZEEL (M Coleman) was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight making contact with **LUCY BEE** near the 300 metres.

Race 6 HINUERA LODGE 1400

GOLDEN DOWNS (S Spratt) began awkwardly shifting out making firm contact with SHADES OF GOLD (A Collett).

THE DARLING ONE (M McNab) shifted in abruptly on jumping away badly hampering **JUST IDEAL** (K Leung) which lost ground. Also hampered in this incident was **CLOS DE TART** (M Cameron).

INIS ROSE (B R Jones) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.

Near the 1100 metres **THE DARLING ONE** shifted in placing **SHADES OF GOLD** in restricted room. When being steadied **SHADES OF GOLD** shifted away from **THE DARLING ONE** crowding **A TOUCH OF RUBY** (M Dee) which made contact with the running rail. Taking into account that **THE DARLING ONE** was inclined to lay in and the racing manners of **SHADES OF GOLD** M McNab was on this occasion issued with a warning, but advised that he must make a far greater attempt to prevent his mounts from shifting ground unless sufficiently clear.

RAVELLO (M Du Plessis) over-raced when racing outside the leader through the middle stages. **GOLDEN DOWNS** was held up early in the final straight. MR RIMFIRE (D Nolan) was held up passing the 300 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres. **INIS ROSE** and **SHADES OF GOLD** came together near the 50 metres. Following this race the track was upgraded to Dead(4). Race 7 IT'S A MESSAGE 1400 WHISTLING DIXIE (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly shifting in and making contact with HARLEQUIN (L Innes) which became briefly unbalanced. THE PAPERBOY (M Cheung) shifted inwards abruptly jumping away hampering ALAGINT (C Grylls) which lost ground. CILLIAN WILL (M Coleman) shifted out abruptly on jumping away making contact with EXABELLE (M Dee) and then had to be steadied when crowded losing ground. ROLE MODEL (D Johnson) and HOLLY DEE (A Forbes) both over-raced in the early stages. **EXABELLE** raced three wide without cover. THE PAPERBOY shifted outwards near the 450 metres hampering the weakening HOLLY DEE (A Forbes). M Cheung was issued with a warning. HOLLY DEE was eased down in the final straight and was found to have bled heavily from both nostrils. As this is the second occasion on which HOLLY DEE has bled the mare is now ineligible for further racing in New Zealand. THE PAPERBOY lost the left front plate and had partly dislodged the left hind plate during the running. Race 8 **VALACHI DOWNS 1400** CHAPARRONE (S Spratt) was slow away. SUM UP (M Hills) and THUNDERBIRD ONE (M Cameron) were a little slow to begin. **MAGIC BELLE** (M Sweeney) over-raced in the lead through the early and middle stages. THUNDERBIRD ONE hung outwards throughout the race taking HAPPY GUYS (M Coleman) over extra ground near the 600 metres. WORTHING (M Dee) lay out rounding the final bend forcing THUNDERBIRD ONE and HAPPY GUYS over extra ground approaching the 400 metres. THUNDERBIRD ONE and HAPPY GUYS came together on several occasions early in the final straight. Race 9 **RAY ERIKSEN'S 70TH BIRTHDAY 1600** SECRET WHISPER (M Dee) began awkwardly losing ground, and was inconvenienced by CELTIC STAR (M Du Plessis) which shifted in. MISS ENDERS (N Harris) and PAYDAY (S Spratt) were both slow away. **FREEDOM** (K Joyce) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **ATACAMA** (M Cheung). FREEDOM, CELTIC STAR (M Du Plessis), BOUVIER (M Wenn), MISTAAR (M Cameron), PAYDAY and SECRET WHISPER all over-raced when the pace steadied near the 1000 metres. **GRANDE BELLEZZA** (T Wenn) raced three wide without cover throughout. LE BON FIN (M Hills) was held up early in the final straight and had to be steadied to avoid the heels of GRANDE BELLEZZA which shifted in near the 300 metres. LA VITESSE (M Coleman) shifted out to obtain clear running near the 250 metres inconveniencing SECRET WHISPER. Race 10 **POSTMANS DAUGHTER 1600** KIDNAPPED (C Grylls) and JOEY JONZ (A Taylor) were both slow away. SEAGOLD (M Dee) and DUBAI SHUFFLE (M Du Plessis) came together jumping away when both runners shifted ground. JOEY JONZ was briefly held up near the 200 metres. WAITAHA TOA 1600 Race 11 ORINTO (M Dee) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with BELORUSSIYA (B R Jones). ORINTO then shifted out away from **BELORUSSIYA** into the line of **MONEYFORJAM** (S Collett) which was checked losing ground. **CLARA JANE** (L Innes) was crowded leaving the barriers. CELTIC CHIEF (J Jago) was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages. CLARA JANE was steadied going into the bend near the 800 metres going back on to ORINTO which shifted out to avoid that runner's heels. **CELTIC CHIEF** which was following then made the 800 metre bend awkwardly. SUPREME LADY (M Wenn) raced wide without cover around the bend. LADY SAYYIDA (M Cameron) was held up rounding the final turn. LE'VANTOS (M McNab) and CLARA JANE came together inside the final 50 metres when both runners shifted ground.
