SUPPLEMENTARY:

Hawkes Bay Racing – Saturday 5 October 2013 Race 3, Rush Munro's Spring Carnival Sprint Trainer Mr C Wood reported that OPEN 'N' SHUT had got down on its heels during the race and he would be looking to apply bumper bandages at its next raceday appearance.
Cambridge Jockey Club – Friday 4 October 2013 Race 4, Elephant Plasterboard at HBS 1200 Trainer S Lucock reported to Stewards that TANGO TERRIFIC had blood in its near side nostril prior to being transported from the racecourse. Mr S Lucock had TANGO TERRIFIC endoscoped on the geldings arrival to his stable which found the TANGO TERRIFIC to have aggravated an existing ulcer.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB Insurance Pearl Series 2YO Bonus
<p>PALACE ROCK (D Johnson) and IFFITEL (T Thornton) were both slow away.</p> <p>AVISTO (A Forbes) and KSCHESSINSKA (M Dee) both raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>After making the final turn wide AVISTO raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight finishing wide on the track.</p> <p>WAY IN (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure from the 300 metres racing greenly for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>DAYTIME ROBBERY returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and underwent a subsequent veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination. DAYTIME ROBBERY was deemed to be a bleeder and as such is to face a mandatory three month stand down from racing in New Zealand.</p>	
Race 2	Tulloch Café 1400
<p>APACHEE TAAT (M Dee) and BUDWISER (A Forbes) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>CAPSTAND (R Smyth) shifted in when leaving the barriers, inconveniencing MORETTI (M Cameron) and BUCKLEBURY (L Innes).</p> <p>HAZELLE (S Collett) was a little slow to begin and then was further inconvenienced having to steady.</p> <p>Approaching the 1200 metres BUCKLEBURY shifted in when not clear of LITTLE RED DEVIL (A Collett) dictating that runner into the line of APACHEE TAAT which was severely checked. L Innes admitted a breach of careless riding and after hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Innes' license to ride in races 13 – 19 October 2013 inclusive, 5 riding days. Hampered as a result were MOONSHINE HILL (C Grylls) and PIAZZETTA (M Coleman).</p> <p>CAPSTAND raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>POCKET OF ACES (K Joyce) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Approaching the 300 metres HAZELLE shifted out to obtain clear running, making contact with BUDWISER.</p> <p>PIAZZETTA was held up passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>LITTLE RED DEVIL shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres making contact with PIAZZETTA inside the 50 metres forcing that runner off its rightful line of running. Following the race the connections of the second placed horse PIAZZETTA lodged an objection against the first placed horse LITTLE RED DEVIL alleging interference inside the final 100 metres. After hearing submissions the JCA upheld the protest with the placings now reading 1st PIAZZETTA, 2nd LITTLE RED DEVIL, 3rd BUCKLEBURY, 4th MOONSHINE HILL. Apprentice Jockey A Collett defended a resulting breach of careless riding. The Judicial Committee found the breach proven and suspended A Collett's license to ride in races 13-19 October inclusive, 5 riding days.</p> <p>POCKET OF ACES returned to the enclosure showing signs of lameness. After undergoing a veterinary examination POCKET OF ACES was found to have a tendon injury to the off fore leg. Trainer T Estreich was advised that POCKET OF ACES would be required to have a veterinary clearance prior to racing next. Trainer T Estreich indicated to Stewards he was unlikely to persevere with POCKET OF ACES as a racing proposition.</p> <p>APACHEE TAAT received veterinary attention after receiving lacerations to the off hind leg during the running.</p>	
Race 3	Music Works 1200
<p>GUARDIAN (S Spratt) began awkwardly, shifting in, making contact with SINISTER MAN (C Grylls) which then raced ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p>PERSUASIVE (M Coleman) jumped in the air when the start was made after being fractious in the barriers.</p> <p>ALL THE WAY (P Taylor) shifted out abruptly jumping away and then over-raced through the early stages.</p> <p>VEEAREOBRO (D Johnson) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SINISTER MAN (C Grylls) over-raced in the early stages and made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres forcing PERSUASIVE over extra ground. SINISTER MAN continued to over-race through the middle stages.</p> <p>ALL THE WAY raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>DARK AND STORMY (M Du Plessis) lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight and shifted in passing the 200 metres despite the efforts of its rider, inconveniencing GUARDIAN which was weakening.</p> <p>PERSUASIVE was held up early in the final straight shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 4	Funtime Food & Amusement Ltd 1200
<p>CHARLIE PRIDE (T Thornton) and DESTROYER (C Grylls) were slow away.</p> <p>BRITT EKLAND (D Johnson) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages and as the pace steadied FOOTSIE (M Coleman) became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and raced ungenerously for a distance.</p>	

HUSH HUSH (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early stages when being restrained and when the pace steadied was allowed to improve forward, racing wide, before assuming a position outside the leader approaching the 700 metres.

BANBURY LAD (A Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.

BRITT EKLAND over-raced in the middle stages when being restrained off the heels of **HUSH HUSH**.

MOOZOON (S Spratt) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **FOOTSIE** approaching the 350 metres and was steadied for a distance.

BRITT EKLAND lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5	Markovina Vineyard Estate 1200

MRS BROWNS BOY (R Smyth) and **OUR MOLLY MALONE** (T Thornton) came together jumping away when both runners began awkwardly.

I DREAM OF JEANNIE (S Spratt) began awkwardly, losing ground.

OUR MOLLY MALONE raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of **PINK BUBBLES** (D Johnson) which shifted in near the 1000 metres when not sufficiently clear. **OUR MOLLY MALONE** then continued to over-race for a distance. D Johnson was advised that a warning would be placed on her record and that she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

SUAREZ (BR Jones) was held up rounding the final turn.

MRS BROWNS BOY raced ungenerously and hung throughout.

NIP OF GIN (R Aukett) began awkwardly, losing ground.

EKRAARSTATIC (T Thornton) began awkwardly, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **BONAPPETIT** (M Coleman) having to be steadied.

ATLANTE (L Innes) began awkwardly, shifting out, inconveniencing **CYCLONE TRACY** (M Hills).

NIP OF GIN commenced to hang badly in the early stages and run off when making the bend approaching the 800 metres. **NIP OF GIN** was then uncompetitive for the remainder of the race. Trainer S Martin was advised that **NIP OF GIN** would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to being permitted to race again.

FAIRY CAKE (M Dee) raced wide without cover throughout.

CYCLONE TRACY was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed passing the 200 metres.

Race 7	Harcourts Kumeu 1400

GETAWAY (N Harris) shifted out jumping away, making contact with **KINGS CALL** (L Innes).

UNFORGETTABELLE (A Taylor) lay in shortly after jumping away, making contact with **DESCHABEEL** (M Coleman) and then became briefly unbalanced.

GETAWAY raced wide without cover throughout.

Approaching the 400 metres **GETAWAY** appeared to go off stride when racing greenly.

ICE COOL (L Rose) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **CLOVELLY** (A Collett) passing the 100 metres when that runner was dictated in slightly by **FIRST CLASS** (C Grylls).

When questioned regarding the performance of **KINGS CALL** Rider L Innes advised that the gelding had travelled well until placed under pressure where it had failed to respond. **KINGS CALL** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which included an endoscopic examination which could find no abnormality.

OSMUNDA returned to the enclosure with blood present in the off side nostril, undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which found no abnormality.

Race 8	Travel Productions 1400

THE IVY (S Spratt) shifted in abruptly jumping away, hampering **LADY CUMQUAT** (M Hills) and **SOUND** (M Cameron) with both of those runners losing ground.

MAIDEN WARRIOR (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, losing ground.

Passing the 1000 metres **AZERBAIJAN** (C Grylls) had to steady when placed in restricted room to the inside of **FLYING FANTASY** (M Dee) which shifted in when not fully clear. M Dee was advised that he must show better judgement and a warning would be placed on his record.

CAV IN THE CASTLE (J Whiteside) and **COPA VERDE** (K Leung) both raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MY MESTARI (A Forbes) raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres between **COPA VERDE** which shifted in and away from **LADY CUMQUAT** and **QUEEN OF CLUBS** (N Harris) which ducked out.

Race 9	Broker Web 2200
<p>CARADONNA (L Magorrian) raced wide without cover until allowing the mare to improve forward and sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>When questioned M Sweeney, the rider of LUCKY RUBY, was of the opinion that the mare is better suited by rain affected footing.</p>	
Race 10	Brighter Carpets 1200
<p>SIGNORINA (S Spratt) was slow to begin.</p> <p>IT'S GOT TO BE YOU (C Grylls) and CHOP CHOP (L Innes) came together when leaving the barriers with IT'S GOT TO BE YOU then shifting away from CHOP CHOP, becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>THE FRENCH WAY (M Cameron) began a little awkwardly.</p> <p>CHACHI ARCOLA (M Du Plessis) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres STELLA'S HONOUR (M Coleman) shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with CHOP CHOP which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>THE FRENCH WAY was inclined to lay out over the final 200 metres when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 11	Morgan Furniture 1200
<p>Trainer B Wells was fined \$50 for presenting RIOT ACT to race without notified gear (blinkers).</p> <p>The start of race 11 was late due to BASSALEG requiring farrier attention at the start.</p> <p>PIPEDREAMS (C Grylls) shifted in abruptly jumping away, hampering PHARSALUS (T Thornton) which lost ground.</p> <p>MATAATUA (L Innes) began awkwardly.</p> <p>TWIST OF FATE (BR Jones) began awkwardly and shifted in, hampering RIOT ACT (M Hills) which lost ground.</p> <p>GARDEN OF GOLD (J Whiteside) over-raced in the early stages and then was obliged to race wide without cover.</p> <p>TWIST OF FATE and MATAATUA both raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 800 metres.</p> <p>NORDIC KNIGHT (S Spratt) over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>PHARSALUS and DANCE (M Du Plessis) both over-raced in the middle stages when being restrained.</p> <p>MATAATUA was held up early in the final straight, shifting out passing the 400 metres, making contact with CHARLIE FARLEY (A Collett) which became awkwardly placed on the heels of GARDEN OF GOLD. CHARLIE FARLEY was then held up for a distance. MATAATUA then raced in restricted room for a distance when trying to obtain clear running.</p> <p>CHARLIE FARLEY was again held up over the concluding stages when racing in restricted room between NORDIC KNIGHT and DANCE.</p> <p>ELYSIUM (S Collett) was held up early in the final straight, shifting out off heels passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>LITTLE ROCKET (A Taylor) was held up passing the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 12	Battersby Funeral Services 1200
<p>The start of this race was delayed 1 minute at the request of TAB Control.</p> <p>SHOW MACCOOL (C Grylls) began awkwardly, losing ground and then was further hampered.</p> <p>BLISS STREET (C Dell) began awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p>SENTEBALE (M Hills) raced wide without cover throughout when vying for the lead.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres SENTEBALE raced in restricted room when weakening, becoming unbalanced, having to steady.</p> <p>BLISS STREET had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and then passing the 300 metres was held up behind PUNT HILL (S Spratt). BLISS STREET then shifted to the inside of PUNT HILL to obtain clear running and again raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres between BRONZE LASS (S Collett) which shifted out and away from MAHBEER (M Du Plessis) and PUNT HILL which shifted in slightly.</p>
