RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TAUPO COMMITTEE & STEWARDS 1800
<p>MANGAROA HUSTLER (M Dee) and POSH (M Hills) were slow to begin.</p> <p>BERLUSCONI (T Thornton) raced keenly in the early stages over-racing when being restrained rounding the first bend.</p> <p>CHANTILLY ROSE (A Collett) commenced to over-race badly in the early stages making the first bend awkwardly and running wide. A Collett advised that CHANTILLY ROSE had hung outwards throughout the race.</p> <p>BEAUTIFUL MAN (H Tinsley) raced ungenerously for a distance when being steadied near the 1400 metres after the pace eased.</p> <p>RED STORM (K Myers) and EVENADUCHESS (K Chiong) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>BERLUSCONI hung out rounding the final turn.</p> <p>KING SAVINSKY (M Cameron) raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	TAUPO TIMES 1000
<p>HARRY CLAASSEN (R Smyth) which was slow to begin was further hampered when FULLY FASHIONED (R Myers) shifted out leaving the barriers.</p> <p>SIMBAAH (A Collett) made the first bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>SIMBAAH had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of RHYTHMS OF NATURE (M Coleman) rounding the</p>	

final turn near the 300 metres. SIMBAAH was then reluctant to improve into a tight run to the inside of RHYTHMS OF NATURE eventually being steadied across the heels of that runner near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.	
Race 3	STARLIGHT CINEMA CENTRE 1400
<p>BLACK HENNESSY (R Myers) was slow to begin.</p> <p>COLD SNAP (M Cameron) and SOVEREIGN ROSE (K Myers) both jumped away awkwardly with both runners coming together and COLD SNAP being further hampered when GENDARME (L Magorrian) shifted out leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ELUSIVE GOLD (L Innes) and ROSE OF VIRGINIA (M Coleman) both had to be steadied when crowded to the inside of SAM MESI (S Spratt) which shifted in near the 1300 metres. S Spratt was issued with a warning.</p> <p>OHOPE PRINCE (T Thornton) over-raced in the middle stages shifting out across heels near the 900 metres and racing wide without cover from that point.</p> <p>When being restrained near the 600 metres ELUSIVE GOLD went back on to BLACK HENNESSY (R Myers) which was hampered.</p> <p>OHOPE PRINCE and SAM MESI both had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>DUBAI WOLF (A Forbes) was crowded when weakening near the 150 metres by BLACK HENNESSY which was taken in by COLD SNAP. M Cameron was advised to exercise more care.</p> <p>DUBAI WOLF which raced disappointingly underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Rider A Forbes was of the opinion that the gelding was better suited to more rain-affected footing.</p>	
Race 4	EBBETT TAUPO 1200
<p>MACBEC (M Dee) lay out shortly after jumping away inconveniencing INCREDITABLE HULK (M Du Plessis) which lost ground.</p> <p>LAC LA RONGE (M Hills) began awkwardly.</p> <p>GARLAND (L Innes) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>INCREDITABLE HULK raced three wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres INCREDITABLE HULK lay inwards making contact with FIROSTEFANI (K Myers) which shifted in and bumped HARMONIZE (M Cameron) which became badly unbalanced making solid contact with the running rail. Also hampered as a result were runners following being LAC LA RONGE, MACBEC and KILDERRY (B R Jones). Rider M Cameron advised that HARMONIZE had felt reluctant to hit out following this incident. A post-race veterinary examination found the filly to have a superficial abrasion to the left hock.</p> <p>INCREDITABLE HULK raced greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 5	THE NZI 1800
<p>Trainer Mr S Clotworthy was fined \$50 after presenting STELLA without notified gear (side winkers). PHEROZARDO (B R Jones) began awkwardly.</p> <p>SLOSHED (K Myers) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with RYAN JOHN (R Myers) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>STELLA (A Collett) made the bend awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p>LADY OF TROY (R Norvall) raced wide from the 800 metres when attempting to improve forward.</p> <p>RYAN JOHN was held up early in the final straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running hampered the weakening LADY OF TROY (R Norvall) approaching the 100 metres. R Myers was issued with a warning.</p> <p>DESI GIRL (M Dee) was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight, and shifted in passing the 100 metres crowding STORM IN (K Leung) which was checked. Rider M Dee was issued with a warning and advised that he must make a greater attempt to maintain a straight line of running.</p>	
Race 6	TAUPO VETERINARY CENTRE 1200
<p>M Cameron was unable to make the weight for BHIWANI being replaced by M Coleman. M Cameron was fined \$100.</p> <p>VILLARS (H Tinsley) and NEWS OF THE WORLD (K Myers) made solid contact on jumping away with both runners becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>TOP STAR (A Forbes) shifted out abruptly after jumping away hampering THE NANCHO EXPRESS (M Dee), BLOSSOM QUEEN (R Myers), BHIWANI (M Coleman) and DECANTER (M Du Plessis).</p> <p>THE NANCHO EXPRESS over-raced in the early to middle stages, and when being restrained shifted out hampering BHIWANI on two occasions passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>When being steadied to avoid the heels of SO DANSO (A Collett) going into the bend near the 800 metres NEWS OF THE WORLD went back on to MR RUFFIAN (D Nolan) which had to steady, and in turn went back on to TOP STAR and DECANTER which were both hampered. A Collett was advised to exercise more care.</p> <p>VILLARS and BHIWANI raced wide without cover.</p> <p>VILLARS shifted out away from DECANTER near the 200 metres inconveniencing BHIWANI.</p>	
Race 7	AMBITIOUS DRAGON 1200
<p>PALMERS PRIDE (R Myers) began awkwardly shifting out hampering ALCHEMY'S FLIGHT (M Cameron) and COSTUME (M Du Plessis). Also contributing was inward movement from ASON (M McNab).</p> <p>CAPISTRANO MAGIC (D Johnson) shifted out abruptly after jumping away hampering MISS CONSTRUE (K Myers) and</p>	

GOING PLACES (A Taylor).

LA TOURNEAU (L Innes) was slow away.

ASON raced three wide without cover on the pace.

ALCHEMY'S FLIGHT was inclined to over-race through the middle stages.

ALCHEMY'S FLIGHT was held up until shifting outwards across heels passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 8

PATIENCE C IZARD 1400

Trainer Mr J Bridgman was fined \$50 after failing to notify gear for the first starter **LONGBEACH** by the required time.

FUSSY HUSSY (K Myers) was slow away.

LONGBEACH (M Cameron) began awkwardly.

COVERED 'N BAY (P Turner) jumped in the air at the start losing ground.

MIDNIGHT MOLLY (H Tinsley) shifted out abruptly after jumping away making contact with **SWEETAZCUZ** (D Johnson).

CALL THE SHOTS (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages.

PICTURE PERFECT (M Hills) and **ASADAUSKAITE** (M Coleman) both raced wide without cover throughout.

SWEETAZCUZ over-raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

COVERED 'N BAY had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels going into the 800 metre bend.

CUPCAKE (S Collett) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

Race 9

TAUPO TAB 1400

BOY (M Du Plessis) which was slow away was further hampered when crowded between **BONINSKY** (K Leung) which shifted out and **GREY POWER** (K Chiong) which was taken in by **RAY'S GIRL** (C Grylls).

QUINTERO (S Spratt) raced keenly in the early stages.

THE MENACE (S Collett) raced three wide without cover.

S Spratt was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of **QUINTERO** which dropped out to finish a distant last.

A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr P McKay advised that he would be having the gelding thoroughly checked on return to its stable with regard to making a decision on its racing future, and would advise Stipendiary Stewards of any relevant findings.
