Race 1	LINDAUER LAWN RACEDAY			
SCARRED was slow to begin.				
THE DUFFSTER was crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground resulting in THE DUFFSTER				
clipping a heel and blundering				
THE DUFFSTER layed out throughout.				
DUQUESA was held up rounding the turn and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.				
SCARRED raced in restricted room until passing the 100 metres.				
When questioned into the run of THE GRADUATE, M Cameron stated the gelding had raced greenly throughout and would				
benefit from the outing.				
Race 2	WELCOME ANDREW FAGE CATERING			

RUNWAY was fractious in the barriers and was slow to begin.

COMPOSING began awkwardly and over raced in the early stages.

SIR GONZALES raced three wide in the early stages until improving forward near the 1000 metres to obtain a position adjacent to the rail.

CELTIC WOMAN was held up near the 300 metres having to shift in to obtain clear running.

SATANYA (M Cameron) shifted ground inward passing the 200 metres crowding **STANLEY** which had to steady. Rider M Cameron was issued with a warning.

STAGECRAFT had to steady off the heels of SIR GONZALES when that runner shifted out passing the 200 metres.

ROULETT made contact with the running rail passing the 150 metres when laying in under vigorous riding.

Race 3 FARNSWORTH ROOFING MAIDEN 1400

GINA began awkwardly and struck the barrier losing ground.

IT'S A MONTY was slow to begin

IT'S A MONTY had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 500 metres.

POROTENE LOLLIPOP had to shift ground outwards near the 300 metres to obtain clear running and then raced in

restricted room for a short distance to the inside of **QUESTION MARK** which was laying in. **QUESTION MARK** continued to lay in for the remainder of the run.

When questioned regarding the performance of **ARZAK**, M Cameron advised the gelding was feeling the effects of the firm track conditions.

Race 4 ABOUT IMAGE MAIDEN 1100

TWOZNOTENOUGH was fractious in the barrier and shifted in on jumping, crowding **INSANEBOLTA**.

HE'S GOLD raced keenly in the lead in the early stages.

WHEN IN ROME raced three wide without cover throughout.

WHEN IN ROME lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 5 ANTON MORA & SON PAINTERS 1200

TRUE SPIRIT knuckled on jumping away.

KAWI began awkwardly shifting in crowding OUTOFTIME on to OVER ITT with OUTOFTIME losing ground.

POROTENE CHANCE was slow to begin and was further hampered when runners either side shifted ground.

VIAMAN began awkwardly shifting out crowding FRESH N FRUITY on to FERGALICIOUS

UNICORN'S PRESENT raced three wide without cover throughout.

ASANIA got its head up when making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

FERGALICIOUS and KAWI made contact passing the 300 metres.

KAWI had difficulty obtaining clear running until the near 200 metres.

Race 6 RJ EAGAR FURNISHINGS LTD 1200

YARDSTICK began awkwardly making heavy contact with the barrier, losing ground.

FOR PETESAKE knuckled shortly after the start.

LIBERATING and **SHARMACK** over raced in the early and middle stages.

RAMPANTEXCUSE raced three wide without cover throughout.

SHARMACK raced greenly in the run home having to be continually straightened and could not be fully ridden out.

FOR PETESAKE was momentarily held up near the 200 metres.

RAMPANTEXCUSE dislodged rider L Whelan after the finish, who was uninjured.

A & K Sharrock co-trainers of SHARMACK were fined the sum of \$50 for presenting SHARMACK in the parade ring without notifiable gear (blinkers).

Race 7 POWERWORX 1600

JOKRAAR began awkwardly losing ground.

POOKA'S SISTER was slow to begin

HER TO ETERNITY began awkwardly shifting out crowding STANICA STAR on to KUZANOV with STANICA STAR losing ground.

KATIE MCKEEN raced three wide without cover inside the final 1000 metres.

KUZANOV lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

POOKA'S SISTER faltered passing the 200 metres after sustaining a fracture to its near fore fetlock. **POOKA'S SISTER** was humanely euthanised.

LASSWADE was unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

Race 8CROWDED HOUSE BAR & CAFÉ 2000

TORRADO shifted in abruptly on jumping, bumping with **MILAN MISS** which in turn bumped with **HYPROFILE** which shifted in making contact with **MAUDE**. **MAUDE** when being corrected shifted in tightening **BALLROOM** which lost ground. **MILAN MISS** had to stead passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

PALRAF began to give ground passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination of **PALRAF** failed to reveal any abnormality, nonetheless the representative of Trainer J Litt was

advised that a veterinary certificate would be required prior to **PALRAF** next racing.
