| Race 1 | NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 2YO (1000 Metres) |
| FERNLIN was slow to begin and settled back. WILD WINGS and FERNLIN were crowded for a short distance passing the 800 metres when SILVERSMITH shifted in. | |
| Race 2 | MASSON IMPLEMENT CO / C&F INDUSTRIES 2200 (2200 Metres) |
| POTTER was slow to begin and settled back. EVASIVE TRACY raced three wide without cover over the early stages, prior to being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 1400 metres. | |
| Race 3 | THE ACAPULCO MOTOR INN TAUPO 3YO (1400 Metres) |
| COOL HAND DUKE began awkwardly, making contact with GRACIELLA . ALAGHERA and KERMIT were slow to begin. Shortly after the start NEAT BELT had to be steadied when inside RED MELODY , which shifted in. Passing the 1300 metres COOL HAND DUKE was tightened and checked making contact with the running rail. (K Myers) RED MELODY admitted a resultant charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that she allowed her mount to shift in when not clear of SANJARA , which was taken in and bumped with GRACIELLA , which in consequence shifted in tightening COOL HAND DUKE , which was checked. After consideration the Judicial Committee suspended Miss Myers licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Monday, 14 October until the close of racing on Thursday, 24 October (6 days). SIR JASPER raced wide without cover throughout. Passing the 250 metres LINCOLN PARK , after being momentarily held up, was angled inward to improve and bumped with NEAT BELT . | |

| Race 4 | PROFESSIONALS PATRICK & SCOTT / WCM LEGAL 1400 (1400 Metres) |
| <p>TAIPA TIGER was crowded on jumping away and shortly after clipped the heel of PARTY ICE and blundered, losing ground. HAVATASTE began awkwardly.</p> <p>PARTY ICE raced in restricted room over the final stages and was unable to improve.</p> <p>V Johnston (NEED A DIAMOND) was advised to exercise care after she allowed her mount to shift inwards after the winning post, resulting in HAVATASTE and PARTY ICE being crowded.</p> | |
| Race 5 | HIDDENBED NZ LTD 1400 (1400 Metres) |
| <p>TONY SOPRANO shifted out abruptly on jumping making heavy contact with MASTER THOMAS, which in turn bumped with FILLE DU ROI.</p> <p>FILLE DU ROI raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of FLASH MAN, rider J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a rain-affected track.</p> | |
| Race 6 | WORLD TRAVELLERS MASTERTON / AARON BIDLAKE RACING F&M SPRING (1000 Metres) |
| <p>PAIERAU PUKE was a late scratching at 2.18pm on veterinary advice. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required before PAIERAU PUKE next races.</p> <p>HOT SPOT began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>INDOLLJENCE began awkwardly.</p> <p>Passing the 700 metres WAITINO BISCUIT (S Doyle) commenced to over-race, shifting out contacting the hind quarters of CHANEL NUMBER FIVE, this resulted in S Doyle having to steady his mount which in consequence lost several lengths. S Doyle was of the opinion that WAITINO BISCUIT may be unsuited to the application of blinkers at this stage of its preparation.</p> <p>GOLDEN JUBILEE had to be steadied near the 600 metres when racing keenly and thereafter was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 150 metres RIVERINA'S CHOICE (D Turner) when laying in, shifted in, hampering FASHION LASS for some distance. Apprentice D Turner was advised that when in similar circumstances he is expected to stop riding out and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>Near the 100 metres SPILLANE and GOLDEN JUBILEE came together and bumped.</p> <p>HOT SPOT raced greenly throughout the final straight.</p> | |
| Race 7 | MARQUIS OF NORMANBY HOTEL SPRING (1000 Metres) |
| <p>NINE IRON dislodged rider D Turner in its preliminary and travelled at a slow tempo for some distance before being recaptured. NINE IRON underwent a veterinary examination at the barriers and was passed fit to run.</p> <p>PLATINUM LINCOLN was slow to begin.</p> <p>HEZANAKBAR was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers when runners either side shifted ground and as a result got back.</p> <p>BRIZA was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ETERNITY was held up rounding the turn and only obtained clear running near the 100 metres.</p> <p>PLATINUM LINCOLN was held up near the 250 metres before being taken wider to improve.</p> <p>RACEY RED had difficulty finding clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p>EDENSONG had to be restrained off heels near the 300 metres when in restricted room.</p> | |
| Race 8 | JAMES TRUCKS AND MACHINERY / GRAY CONTRACTING 1600 (1600 Metres) |
| <p>SHEZASTUNNA lay out rounding the home turn, inconveniencing SHADOW PLAYER which was racing to its outside.</p> <p>BASE CAMP was held up for a short distance rounding the home turn and near the 350 metres shifted out hampering the weakening VITAARI GIRL</p> <p>GOLDYSOX raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>VITAARI GIRL raced four wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>W Satherley (LIVERPOOL KISS) was reminded of his obligations with respect to the use of the whip on a horse not in contention.</p> | |
