RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RANGIORA NEW WORLD RATING 65 (1400m)
	Passing the 1200 metres UMSHINI WAMI had to steady when placed in restricted room when DA BEST COUP (J Bullard) shifted inwards. Rider J Bullard was reminded of his obligations. Near the 1100 metres GALLANT BABE was steadied when over racing for a short distance. DELIRIUM , COUP SECRECY and LIGHTNING LUCY all raced keenly passing the 1000 metres for a short distance. GERVASIO raced three wide without cover throughout. BELLA VI was held up momentarily passing the 600 metres. COUP SECRECY was placed in restricted room near the 500 metres when weakening on its' run. COUP ROTORUA raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of GERVASIO . When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner COUP SECRECY , apprentice rider A Frye advised that the gelding over raced early and only battled when placed under full pressure, and in her opinion would benefit from the run. Co-trainer D Champion reported that COUP SECRECY was galloped on during the running.

Race 2	PLOUGH HOTEL RATING 75 (1400m)
<p>SUMMER'S BOY began awkwardly. KETCHME was slow to begin. Passing the 1000 metres SUMMER'S BOY raced keenly and changed stride in behind and blundered. The saddle on FRAGRANT shifted forward passing the 1000 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage. KOSTALOT was hard ridden from the 800 metres. VANILLA improved wide from the 600 metres. ASHBURN LANE and KETCHME were held up for some distance passing the 500 metres. Near the 150 metres VANILLA had to steady for some distance when runners either side shifted ground marginally. FRAGRANT lost the near hind plate during the running. When questioned regarding the performance of KOSTALOT, rider J Morris advised that the gelding was under heavy pressure throughout and she could offer no tangible excuse for the performance. Trainer N Coulbeck undertook to advise the Stewards of any developments in subsequent days which may have led to the performance. A post race veterinary inspection of KOSTALOT did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 3	KINGFISH LODGE FAR NORTH BOUTIQUE WATERFRONT ACCOMMODATION MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>HI YO KO was slow to begin. KINGS PAL was awkwardly placed on heels when restrained shortly after the start and then over raced in the early stages. PENTAROSE raced keenly passing the 1100 metres when being restrained. OUR MEMOIR got its head up and raced fiercely as a consequence. Both FOR SHAW and PUTT FOR CASH were hampered as a result. FOR SHAW raced ungenerously for a short distance thereafter. ELLURE raced wide through the early stages. PENTAROSE was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres. Passing the 400 metres KAAPFLEUR (R Bishop) shifted out making heavy contact with ELLURE which in turn was forced into the line of DOUBLE BLUE which was unbalanced. Rider R Bishop admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) with the JCA suspending his licence to ride in races for 2 days effective 10 to 16 December inclusive. KAAPFLEUR continued to lay out over the concluding stages. R Bishop (KAAPFLEUR) was warned under Rule 638(3)(c) for striking his mount forward of the shoulder.</p>	
Race 4	CANSTAFF HANDICAP (1250m)
<p>NEVER DIE began awkwardly and tended to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages. Passing the 300 metres OUR PREMONITION commenced to lay outwards under a vigorous ride and forced GEORGIES GIRL over extra ground. Apprentice S Wynne was warned under Rule 638(1)(d). Over the concluding stages OUR PREMONITION had to be straightened on a number of occasions. When questioned regarding the performance of NEVER DIE, rider R Hannam could offer no tangible excuse.</p>	
Race 5	GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>The start of this race was officially delayed 3 minutes on TAB request. ISHIMINE was slow to begin. NEEDASTAR raced fiercely in the early stages. Passing the 1000 metres CAPTAIN TODD raced ungenerously for a short distance. Near the 600 metres EMERALD QUEEN was steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of NEEDASTAR. Approaching the 400 metres CAPTAIN TODD lay outwards.</p>	
Race 6	TUSCANA MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN (1800m)
<p>WHY WAIT blundered on jumping. SERAPHIM FALLS began awkwardly. ARE YOU MINE raced fiercely in the early stages. CAPET ROYALE raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up on several occasions. Passing the 1000 metres MR WIZ which was travelling keenly shifted off heels and in doing so forced SERAPHIM FALLS over extra ground. Also hampered as a result was MY RULES. SERAPHIM FALLS raced wide from the 900 metres. Passing the 800 metres both MR WIZ and ARE YOU MINE were held up for some distance when on heels. MCMAJ lay inwards for the majority of the race. ARE YOU MINE lay out rounding the final bend. Passing the 300 metres SOUTHERN PRIDE lay inwards and had to be straightened, placing MR WIZ in restricted room momentarily.</p>	
Race 7	JOHN WHITE BLOODSTOCK RATING 75 (1800m)
<p>Passing the 450 metres STINGRAY and UNRELENTING LADY were both held up until near the 200 metres before shifting ground outwards to obtain clear running.</p>	

Race 8

DUNSTAN FEEDS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER RATING 65 (1800m)

SEEKING REDEMPTION was restrained to the rear on jumping.

DIRE STRAITS was steadied off heels for some distance passing the 1600 metres.

CHAMPAGNE KATIE raced wide for the majority of the race.

MISTER SPIDERMAN raced keenly in the middle stages.

COMMANDING OAK raced wide from the 600 metres.

MISTER SPIDERMAN had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the home turn when racing in restricted room.

Passing the 250 metres **CHAMPAGNE KATIE** lay out under pressure.
