## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>KNOTTINGLY FARM / MILLS REEF WINERY HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>BEAU ZED</b> bounded as the start was made and settled back as a result.</p> <p><b>HOT LIPS</b> raced wide through the early stages.</p> <p><b>KING OF ROCK</b> raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1400 metres when the tempo of the race eased.</p> <p><b>THE PAINTER</b> was held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>VALLEY OF PENTIRE</b> improved wide rounding the home turn.</p> <p><b>KING OF ROCK</b> raced in restricted room over the final few strides.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>BEEBEE STAR</b> which finished well back, rider <b>B Lammas</b> was of the opinion that the gelding is not suited to racing without blinkers which were removed for today's race.</p> <p><b>J Shackleton</b> could offer no excuse for the disappointing run of <b>DA BEAST</b>.</p> <p>Following the running of this event the track was upgraded to a Good 3.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>WAI PINE HOLDINGS / TIM HARRIS LTD MAIDEN</b>
<p>The start of this race was delayed 2 mins at the request of the TAB.</p> <p><b>LUCASAURAUS</b> shifted in abruptly on jumping away making firm contact with <b>DON'TSTOPGIRL</b>. <b>WATCH YOUR MAN</b> was hampered as a result and got back.</p> <p><b>THE NANCHO EXPRESS</b> raced keenly when being restrained passing the 1000 metre mark.</p> <p><b>INSCRUTABLE</b> raced wide through the back straight.</p>	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>WAIKATO STUD 3YO MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>IRISH STRINGS</b> began awkwardly and shifted out tightening <b>BAJOUR</b> which lost ground.</p> <p><b>MR FRANKEY</b> was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MISS SELBY</b> improved wide around the home bend.</p> <p><b>IRISH STRINGS</b> over-raced in the lead throughout.</p> <p><b>TRIPLE BILLING</b> was hampered inside the final 100 metres when <b>NATIONAL PRIDE</b> was dictated inwards into the line of <b>TRIPLE BILLING</b> by <b>IRISH STRINGS</b> which was racing greenly.</p> <p><b>NATIONAL PRIDE</b> had to be eased short of the line off the heels of <b>IRISH STRINGS</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>BNZ PARTNERS / PGG WRIGHTSON MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>RED SUNSET</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GALLETA</b> raced wide without cover through the early stages.</p> <p><b>MASTER THOMAS</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>BLAME DE ANGELS</b> was held up when attempting a marginal run near the 250 metres and when being angled out, lay outwards and bumped <b>GALLETA</b> for a short distance. <b>BLAME DE ANGELS</b> then had to change ground in order to improve near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>ADRIENNE</b> was inclined to lay in down the home straight and bumped for a short distance with <b>GALLETA</b> prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>L Whelan</b> reported <b>KIWI ROSE</b> received a knock near the 600 metres, appeared to lose confidence and tailed off in the home straight. <b>L Whelan</b> was further of the opinion the filly may have been feeling the Good 3 footing today.</p> <p><b>T Russell</b> advised that <b>JANDAKOT</b> raced indifferently throughout and as a result allowed the gelding to drift out in the final straight as he considered there may have been something amiss.</p> <p>Subsequent veterinary inspections of both <b>KIWI ROSE</b> and <b>JANDAKOT</b> failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities to either runner.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>MCVERRY CRAWFORD / THE SPEIGHTS ALE HOUSE HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>ROCKWEILER</b> got its head up as the start was made and began awkwardly.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>MY PENTIRE</b> was inconvenienced when <b>JUSTA CHARLIE</b> shifted in. <b>M Cropp</b> was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>SPIKE MILLIGAN</b> was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>PALMERS PRIDE</b> improved wide around the final bend.</p> <p><b>OUR ENTROURAGE</b> was held up for some distance early in the home straight and as a result <b>MY PENTIRE</b> was held up on the heels of <b>OUR ENTROURAGE</b>.</p> <p><b>MY PENTIRE</b> when seeking clear running, shifted out passing the 250 and made firm contact with <b>JUSTA CHARLIE</b>.</p> <p><b>R Myers</b> reported that <b>PALMERS PRIDE</b> was not suited the Good 3 footing, preferring an easing in the ground.</p> <p>Trainer <b>G Vile</b> attributed the improved performance today of <b>THE BACHELOR</b> to a course of swimming over recent times.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>RACHEL HUNTER / JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>KNOWING</b> underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier after dislodging rider <b>R Myers</b> and galloping a short distance before being captured.</p> <p><b>LES SYLPHIDES</b> began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p><b>UNTOLD</b> began awkwardly and made contact with <b>KNOWING</b>.</p> <p><b>KNOWING</b> raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>SAN PEDRO</b> was held up in the early part of the home straight. Over the concluding stages, <b>SAN PEDRO</b> raced in restricted room.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>SCULLYS PRODUCTS BULLS COUNTRY CUP</b>
<p>Due to an administrative error, <b>IAMISHWARA</b> was incorrectly reported as wearing blinkers. On and off-course patrons were advised accordingly.</p> <p><b>ALDEBARAN STAR</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>IAMISHWARA</b> was held up in the home straight until gaining clear running near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>SCARLET O'HARA</b> was eased out of the race early in the home straight after breaking down and was examined and treated for a collapsed suspensory apparatus.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>MCCARTHY TRANSPORT HANDICAP</b>
<p><b>POROTENE PARK</b> jumped in at the start and bumped with <b>GOLD WEDDING</b> resulting in <b>POROTENE PARK</b> settling towards the back.</p> <p><b>EXCEEDING A DREAM</b> was held up and unable to improve for the majority of the home straight.</p> <p><b>REDLINE</b> hung outwards over the final 200 metres having to be continually straightened by the rider and could not be ridden out fully to the finish.</p>	

**SLAH** lost the near foreleg plate passing the 400 metres.

**H Tinsley** could offer no excuses for the disappointing run of **GOLD MOET**.

**A Forbes**, the rider of the winner **SLAH** was reminded that he must ride his mounts fully to the line when circumstances permit after he relaxed his ride over the final stages.
