RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THE EDGE 106.4 WANGANUI 1200
<p>The start of race 1 was delayed approximately three minutes after GOLDEN JUBILEE refused to enter the barrier and subsequently resulted in the mare being declared a late scratching. Trainer S Crutchley was advised GOLDEN JUBILEE must trial satisfactorily prior to its next start.</p> <p>KATES DELIGHT began awkwardly unbalancing the rider and losing ground.</p> <p>Near the 200 metres LORRAINE ducked inwards abruptly and bumped COLONEL LINCOLN</p> <p>TYCOON BAY tailed off throughout and lost contact with the field. Trainer H Gillies was advised that a warning is placed against the gelding with regard to its competitiveness.</p> <p>Following the event Stewards addressed starter B Clement with regard to the amount of time spent attempting to load GOLDEN JUBILEE away which the Stewards considered to be excessive on this occasion. The Manager of the Starting Crew was addressed by the Stewards with regard to the conduct of his staff when loading away a problematic horse.</p>	
Race 2	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1600
<p>A Taylor (LUCK AT LAST) was reminded of her obligation to be clear of other runners when shifting ground after she allowed her mount to shift in approaching the first turn when not clear of THIEVING SISTERS which had to steady.</p> <p>ZEITA'S CHANCE made the first corner awkwardly</p>	

<p>MR LINCOLN raced keenly going into the first bend and had to be steadied off heels on entering the back straight.</p> <p>THE BIG OPAL raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MACK and CONNOR JOHN bumped near the 300 metres when CONNOR JOHN was angled out in search of clear running.</p> <p>STAR EMERALD was held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>Over the final stages THE BIG OPAL was tightened and checked when THIEVING SISTERS (T Russell) shifted out abruptly under pressure. The incident was believed to be beyond the control of Rider T Russell. Also hampered to a lesser extent was PERONI.</p>	
Race 3	PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC NUTRITION 2040
<p>DUROYAL shifted out at the start bumping with MADAM ZENNO.</p> <p>MISSTEEFLYING was slow to begin.</p> <p>MISS PROFESSIONAL raced greenly in the early stages and near the 1700 metres shifted out and bumped with PAUL.</p> <p>DUROYAL raced wide near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>EARL SPENCER was inclined to hang outwards in the home straight and had to be continuously straightened.</p> <p>MISSTEEFLYING was held up until passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 4	TCL COMMUNICATIONS 1200
<p>GUS raced keenly early and when being restrained near the first bend shifted out tightening LEICA QUEEN.</p> <p>M Cropp the rider of LEICA QUEEN was reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out fully to the line when circumstances permit after relaxing his ride over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 5	ST JOHNS CLUB 1340
<p>ANTONINE was a late scratching at 2.44 pm after injuring itself in its yard.</p> <p>The track condition was down-graded to Dead 5.</p> <p>HIGH FASHION was inclined to lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of GO DANNY which struggled to keep pace throughout, Rider H Tinsley said while the gelding had performed on rain affected tracks in the past, struggled on this occasion.</p> <p>Following the running of Race 5 the surface was further down-graded to Dead 6.</p>	
Race 6	WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 25TH ANNIVERSARY 1340
<p>ON THE HILL shifted out on jumping crowding BARNIE O'MARNIE which got back.</p> <p>PREPARED shifted out on jumping bumping with ITSA TRU STORY which in turn shifted out crowding WILD ABOUT ME and RIVERMAN JACK which was buffeted and became unbalanced.</p> <p>THE RAHTWO REBEL was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RIVERMAN JACK gave ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the final stages. When questioned rider M Cropp reported that in his opinion the gelding may have swallowed a clod.</p> <p>ON THE HILL hung out rounding the turn and throughout the final straight having to be continually straightened.</p> <p>B Lammas (WILD ABOUT ME) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after he allowed his mount to shift out crowding ON THE HILL.</p> <p>Rider N Harris (CALEY ROSE) was questioned into his lack of vigour in the home straight. N Harris advised that near the 200 metre mark he felt the mare falter in front so did not ride it out to any extent over the final stages. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection of CALEY ROSE which failed to reveal any abnormality. Trainer L Latta was of the opinion the mare may have tied up during the running and agreed to report the progress of CALEY ROSE over coming days should anything come to light.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of OVERTHERIVER which finished well back Rider J Parkes said the colt was never suited to the track conditions.</p> <p>NO ENEMY returned to the enclosure minus the near front plate.</p>	
Race 7	CAMBRIDGE THOROUGHBRED CIVICS WANGANUI CUP 2040
<p>JUST ISHI and SOU'EAST were slow away.</p> <p>SACHA raced keenly in the home straight on the first occasion so was taken forward to lead in the back straight.</p> <p>CROCODILE CANYON raced four wide throughout and began to give ground passing the 600 metres and when doing so came back on to O'FILLE which clipped that runner's heel and blundered. O'FILLE then had to take evasive action and shifted out abruptly forcing VOLKSWOOD wide on the track.</p> <p>CHAPINTA was held up for some distance prior to entering the home straight behind the tiring CROCODILE CANYON.</p> <p>BACK IN BLACK was held up rounding the home turn and had to be angled wider near the 250 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of PERO rider S Doyle had no real excuse but considered the going may not have suited PERO on this occasion despite having performed on rain affected tracks in the past.</p>	
Race 8	DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS 2040
<p>BEEBEE STAR was slow to begin.</p> <p>LADY SHANNON was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and then lost ground.</p> <p>ELLIE'O raced ungenerously in the early stages and near the 1700 metres got its head up when being restrained.</p>	

Approaching the 1600 metres **JACKABEAN** shifted out marginally dictating **LUCKY SPUR** out on to the hind quarters of **BEAU AGEN** resulting in **LUCKY SPUR** having to steady.
TRICKJAH raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.

Race 9

WANGANUI CHRONICLE 1600

WE ARE ROYAL and **BRACKENWOOD** were slow away.

IF I CAN I CAN and **JULINKSY PRINCE** came together and brushed passing the 100 metres.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the second placed **IF I CAN I CAN** viewed coverage of the final stages with a view to lodging a protest against the winner **JULINSKY PRINCE** alleging interference passing the 100 metres but elected not to proceed with an objection.

CRIXUS returned to the bird cage minus a plate.

K Myers Trainer of **EDENBRAE** was fined \$50 for presenting the mare without blinkers which was its declared gear.
