RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MITAVITE JUVENILE
<p>PRO FUMO (R Hutchings) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ADEQUATE (O Bosson) shifted in abruptly leaving the barriers crowding HARDASSAH (M McNab) and BLACK CALVADOS (A Forbes) with HARDASSAH losing ground and BLACK CALVADOS becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>ADEQUATE lay in approaching the first bend becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BLACK CALVADOS having to steady and shift out abruptly and was then obliged to race wide without cover.</p> <p>PRO FUMO hung out making the first corner and continued to hang around the bend running wide before being eased down over the final stages. Rider R Hutchings advised that the gelding was feeling the firm nature of the footing with trainer G Rogerson confirming that PRO FUMO was likely to be spelled.</p> <p>MISS BUFFO (S Spratt) had a tendency to lay out for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres HARDASSAH made contact with WOODSMAN (P Turner) for several strides when the pace steadied.</p> <p>After questioning several riders the track was upgraded from a Dead 4 to a Good 3.</p>	

Race 2	MONOVALE SAND 1400
<p>MRS SIM (D Hain) reared over becoming cast in the barriers. MISS SIM was then late scratched at 1.29pm on veterinary advice.</p> <p>FIRST CLASS (O Bosson) who was in the adjacent barrier was also removed to undergo a veterinary examination then being passed fit to start by the veterinarian.</p> <p>Trainer J Bell was advised that MRS SIM would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>LONELY BOY (P Taylor) shifted out leaving the barriers crowding ZOUK (M Coleman) and UNKNOWN PLEASURES (M McNab) which clipped a heel and blundered losing ground.</p> <p>LOOKATMEPINS (M Cameron) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Near the 1300 metres LONELY BOY and ZOUK had to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of FIRST CLASS which shifted in and BUCKLEBURY (L Innes) which shifted out when over-racing. RONAN which was improving forward had to steady when crowded to the inside of BUCKLEBURY and contributing was outward movement by BLOSSOM QUEEN.</p> <p>HARMONIZE (R Hutchings) hung out passing the 1000 metres making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p>Approaching the 800 metres RONAN (T Thornton) had to be steadied off the heels of BLOSSOM QUEEN (R Myers).</p> <p>WHOOPIE (J Nason) commenced to over race when being restrained in the early stages when racing wide, was then allowed to improve forward to lead passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>LOOKATMEPINS commenced to hang out passing the 800 metres and ran wide around the bend and continued to hang out around the top bend. When questioned M Cameron said that the horse had become unsettled and fractious in the barriers and then raced greenly throughout and was not ridden out fully in the final straight.</p>	
Race 3	BEVERLEY PRICE MEMORIAL 1200
<p>AMBITIOUS HERO (O Bosson) and RAROONEY (K Joyce) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>JUSTABOUT READY (M Dee) and THORNBURY (R Hutchings) were slow to begin.</p> <p>AMBITIOUS HERO commenced to race fiercely when being restrained and shifted out hampering HIT THE LIGN (M McNab) near the 900 metres.</p> <p>AMBITIOUS HERO was then obliged to race wide without cover.</p> <p>HIT THE LIGN made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and raced ungenerously getting its head up.</p> <p>RAROONEY over raced badly in the middle stages and hung outwards.</p> <p>PRINCE OF PASSION (D Nolan), when shifting in to obtain a tight run near the 300meters, made contact with MORENA (R Jones).</p> <p>AMBITIOUS HERO had to steady when in restricted room passing the 150 meters. O Bosson reported that the horse had proved difficult to ride racing greenly in its raceday debut.</p>	
Race 4	LANGSFORD – N & G LTD 1200
<p>MONTEREY BAY (R Hutchings) and ABSOLUTE GEM (L Callaway) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>KNIGHT WAGER (D Nolan) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MONTEREY BAY commenced to hang outwards making the bend passing the 850 metres losing ground and was persevered with over the final 200 metres. Trainer J Graham informed the Stewards that the gelding was feeling the effects of the firmer nature of the track and also that he would be spelling the horse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>AFFOGATO (T Thornton) was held up until shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running, then laying-out and making slight contact with OUR MOLLY MALONE (M Du Plessis).</p> <p>SPARE THE MOMENT (R Jones) shifted out under pressure inconveniencing CHEEKY BOY (S Spratt) passing the 50 metres.</p>	
Race 5	WILLIAM INGLIS & SON 1200
<p>KALEVALA (M Cameron), THE PAPERBOY (M Cheung), SUGAR PLUM FAIRY (P Turner) and LADY CHAPEL (D Johnson) all began awkwardly.</p> <p>Shortly after leaving the barriers THE PAPERBOY shifted away from SPRINGLOADED (T Thornton) crowding KALEVALA which had to be steadied.</p> <p>Approaching the 800 metres ZERO TUA HUNDRED (R Hutchings) shifted out onto AIMEES GOLD (K Myers) which made contact with the hind quarters of RUREADY (V Gatu) which was shifting in causing crowding to AIMEES GOLD which had to be steadied as a result. Apprentice rider V Gatu was issued with a warning.</p> <p>SPITTING IMAGE (M Dee) raced ungenerously when making the bend approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres SPRINGLOADED lay out making contact with ZERO TUA HUNDRED with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>As a result LADY CHAPEL which was following had to be steadied.</p> <p>SPLITTING IMAGE lay out passing the 450 metres forcing SPRINGLOADED, ZERO TUA HUNDRED and AIMEES GOLD</p>	

over extra ground.

Race 6 | **COOLMORE AUSTRALIA 1600**

BLACK HENNESSY (R Myers) was slow away.

BLACK ATTACK (D Johnson) began awkwardly.

EXABELLE (K Myers) shifted out to obtain clear running entering the final straight inconveniencing **CALL THE SHOTS** (M Du Plessis) near the 400 metres.

PIAZETTA (M Dee) shifted ground under pressure in the final straight.

KILLARNEY KID (L Innes) had a tendency to lay out in the final straight.

CALL THE SHOTS (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover.

Race 7 | **CROMBIE LOCKWOOD BLOODSTOCK 1600**

LONGBEACH (K Myers) began awkwardly shifting out hampering **LOVE** (M Du Plessis).

EDEN STAR (A Taylor) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **SINGING DUNE** (A Forbes)

LIQUID ASSET (O Bosson) began awkwardly losing ground.

LOVE and **MEZZALUNA** (D Johnson) both raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

EKRAARSTATIC (C Grylls) raced wide without cover.

Passing the 800 metres **COLONEL CARRERA** (R Hutchings) had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly and shifted back on **SINGING DUNE** which had to be steadied.

EDEN STAR became tailed off approaching the 700 metres being eased down by its rider. A Taylor advised that the filly felt very short in its action. A veterinary inspection found the filly to be lame in the left hind with trainer J Hunt advising that the filly would now be spelled.

Passing the 600 metres **LIQUID ASSET** appeared to go off stride when placed under pressure and was then eased down by its rider at the 400 metres with rider O Bosson advising the gelding had become very indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Stable representative was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to the gelding racing again.

Passing the 300 metres **LONGBEACH** shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **COLONEL CARRERA** on two occasions.

When questioned regarding the performance of **REJOICE** (L Innes) which was not persevered with over the final 100 metres, jockey L Innes advised Stewards the gelding was feeling the effects of the firming nature of the track.

Race 8 | **MISS RAGGEDY ANN 1600**

LOTUS LAUD (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

CYCLONE TRACEY (R Hutchings) began awkwardly.

VONCINI (L Innes) was slow to begin.

JUD STRUNK (K Leung) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages and shifted in abruptly passing the 1300 metres going off-stride.

I GOTTA HUNCH (A Jones) over-raced passing the 900 metres being awkwardly placed on heels then shifted out inconveniencing **CUP CAKE** (S Collett) who then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

R Hutching **CYCLONE TRACEY** was eased down over the final 200 metres with rider R Hutchings advising the filly was uncomfortable in her action when placed under pressure in the final straight. A subsequent veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Passing the 1300 metres **LOTUS LAUD** raced ungenerously when being steadied. D Johnston reported that the gelding maybe feeling the effects of the improved track conditions. Trainer P Coutts advised Stewards he was disappointed with the geldings performance and he would be trialing **LOTUS LAUD** prior to racing again.
