RACE COMMENTS:

RACE 1 HERITAGE HOUSE/A+ DRIVEWAYS MAIDEN

SPORTS ILLUSTRATED bounded on jumping and was then crowded between **NO ACCLAMATION** and **DANASONIC** which shifted out after beginning awkwardly.

WAITINO BISCUIT began awkwardly.

SPORTS ILLUSTRATED lay in under pressure near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

CRACK A TUI lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.

DANASONIC had to be angled wider passing the 200 metres to improve.

PINS 'N' ARROW returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination which revealed **PINS 'N' ARROW** to be a bleeder.

NO ACCLAMATION raced keenly in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish. **NO ACCLAMATION** appeared to shorten stride near the finish. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any abnormality. Trainer A Sharrock advised that he will not be persevering with the filly as a racing proposition.

Race 2 BOOF FLEMING MEMORIAL F&M MAIDEN

SILKYSAND began awkwardly and lost ground.

MRS WONG was slow to begin.

SILKYSAND commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1200 metres and had to be restrained off heels for some

distance.

TWOZNOTENOUGH had to be steadied off heels near the 1200 metres when over racing.

ZAFRENZY (S Doyle) was crowded when tiring near the 250 metres when **TWOZNOTENOUGH** shifted in to improve. S Doyle was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

When questioned into the run of VIRGINIA which ran last rider Parkes could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 3 BROUGHAM HEIGHTS MAIDEN

HEAPZAGOLD was declared a late scratching at 4.35pm after becoming fractious in the barrier, sustaining injuries and becoming cast. Trainer R Patterson was advised that **HEAPZAGOLD** must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to next racing.

WILLHE was slow to begin.

DURHAM ROSE was placed in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers when runners either side shifted ground. Approaching the 800 metre bend **MION JAY** had to be restrained when awkwardly placed outside the heels of **OUTOFTIME**. **MION JAY** when being steadied then made the corner awkwardly dictating **DURHAM ROSE** over extra ground.

LA CITE hung out when taken into clear running passing the 250 metres

M Cameron reported that **I'M FAIR DIMKUM** which failed to finish the race off to any extent may be better suited to some cut in the ground and in his opinion, may prefer a longer distance.

DURHAM ROSE lost the near side hind shoe plate during the running.

Race 4 WAYNE BEGGS / MAXINE ROGERS TSB REALTY 3YO MAIDEN

PHONE GIRL and STANLEY were slow to begin.

PHONE GIRL over raced in the early stages.

IT'S A MONTY hung out rounding the turn near the 1400 metres and ran wide dictating STANLEY over extra ground.

TEQUILA SUNRISE raced keenly in the middle stages and had to be steadied off heels for some distance passing the 1200 metres.

IT'S A MONTY raced wide in the middle stages.

VIAMAN over raced for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.

Race 5 HTL INSURANCE MAIDEN

PEERAGE began awkwardly.

IRISH SPRING was bumped at the start and settled back when there was movement from runners either side.

PEERAGE raced greenly throughout and shifted out rounding the first turn hampering **HEZANAKILAD** and **SHEZASTUNNA** which was forced over extra ground and continued to race wide throughout.

ALEZAN (R Hutchings) when negotiating the 800 metre bend shifted out abruptly and in doing so checked **SCARRED**. Also hampered was **HEZANAKILAD** and **I'M BELLA**. When questioned rider R Hutchings reported that **ALEZAN** touched the running rail and over reacted.

Over the final few strides ALEZAN shifted in under pressure and bumped with JOYOHJOY.

Race 6 REVITAL FERTILISERS RATING 85

STANICA STAR over raced in the early stages.

D Turner reported that **RED DRAGON** was unsuited to the firm track.

Race 7 RETURN TO EARTH RATING 65

DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE began awkwardly and lost ground.

LUCKY SPUR raced wide early.

VIKING CHIEF raced three wide throughout without cover.

LUCKY SPUR was held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

D Turner (JUST LIKE NO OTHER) was issued with a warning with regard to his use of the whip in the home straight.
