## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>RACE 1</b>	<b>HERITAGE HOUSE/A+ DRIVEWAYS MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>SPORTS ILLUSTRATED</b> bounded on jumping and was then crowded between <b>NO ACCLAMATION</b> and <b>DANASONIC</b> which shifted out after beginning awkwardly.</p> <p><b>WAITINO BISCUIT</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SPORTS ILLUSTRATED</b> lay in under pressure near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p><b>CRACK A TUI</b> lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.</p> <p><b>DANASONIC</b> had to be angled wider passing the 200 metres to improve.</p> <p><b>PINS 'N' ARROW</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination which revealed <b>PINS 'N' ARROW</b> to be a bleeder.</p> <p><b>NO ACCLAMATION</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish. <b>NO ACCLAMATION</b> appeared to shorten stride near the finish. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any abnormality. Trainer A Sharrock advised that he will not be persevering with the filly as a racing proposition.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BOOF FLEMING MEMORIAL F&amp;M MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>SILKYSAND</b> began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p><b>MRS WONG</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SILKYSAND</b> commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1200 metres and had to be restrained off heels for some</p>	

distance.

**TWOZNOTENOUGH** had to be steadied off heels near the 1200 metres when over racing.

**ZAFRENZY** (S Doyle) was crowded when tiring near the 250 metres when **TWOZNOTENOUGH** shifted in to improve. S Doyle was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

When questioned into the run of **VIRGINIA** which ran last rider Parkes could offer no tangible excuse.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>BROUGHAM HEIGHTS MAIDEN</b>

**HEAPZAGOLD** was declared a late scratching at 4.35pm after becoming fractious in the barrier, sustaining injuries and becoming cast. Trainer R Patterson was advised that **HEAPZAGOLD** must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to next racing.

**WILLHE** was slow to begin.

**DURHAM ROSE** was placed in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers when runners either side shifted ground.

Approaching the 800 metre bend **MION JAY** had to be restrained when awkwardly placed outside the heels of **OUTOFTIME**.

**MION JAY** when being steadied then made the corner awkwardly dictating **DURHAM ROSE** over extra ground.

**LA CITE** hung out when taken into clear running passing the 250 metres

M Cameron reported that **I'M FAIR DIMKUM** which failed to finish the race off to any extent may be better suited to some cut in the ground and in his opinion, may prefer a longer distance.

**DURHAM ROSE** lost the near side hind shoe plate during the running.

**PHONE GIRL** and **STANLEY** were slow to begin.

**PHONE GIRL** over raced in the early stages.

**IT'S A MONTY** hung out rounding the turn near the 1400 metres and ran wide dictating **STANLEY** over extra ground.

**TEQUILA SUNRISE** raced keenly in the middle stages and had to be steadied off heels for some distance passing the 1200 metres.

**IT'S A MONTY** raced wide in the middle stages.

**VIAMAN** over raced for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HTL INSURANCE MAIDEN</b>

**PEERAGE** began awkwardly.

**IRISH SPRING** was bumped at the start and settled back when there was movement from runners either side.

**PEERAGE** raced greenly throughout and shifted out rounding the first turn hampering **HEZANAKILAD** and **SHEZASTUNNA** which was forced over extra ground and continued to race wide throughout.

**ALEZAN** (R Hutchings) when negotiating the 800 metre bend shifted out abruptly and in doing so checked **SCARRED**. Also hampered was **HEZANAKILAD** and **I'M BELLA**. When questioned rider R Hutchings reported that **ALEZAN** touched the running rail and over reacted.

Over the final few strides **ALEZAN** shifted in under pressure and bumped with **JOYOHJOY**.

**STANICA STAR** over raced in the early stages.

D Turner reported that **RED DRAGON** was unsuited to the firm track.

**DUCHESSE OF CAMBRIDGE** began awkwardly and lost ground.

**LUCKY SPUR** raced wide early.

**VIKING CHIEF** raced three wide throughout without cover.

**LUCKY SPUR** was held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

**D Turner** (JUST LIKE NO OTHER) was issued with a warning with regard to his use of the whip in the home straight.
