Co-trainer Mr B Hawtin reported that MISS PELEAR had subsequently undergone an endoscopic examination with no abnormalities detected. Mr Hawtin further advised that they would be continuing with the mare's preparation with a tongue tie having been added to its notified gear.
Trainer Mr J Pender notified that OHOPE PRINCE , which had been late scratched behind the barriers due to lameness, had subsequently been found to be suffering from a bad foot abscess which had only burst out after several days with the gelding now recovering well and he was intending to continue with its preparation.

Race 1	ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS '2200'
CULTO LA VIDA (A Collett) was slow to begin before racing ungenerously in the early stages.	
CANDY GIRL (M Dee) was obliged to race three wide without cover until approaching the 1400 metres when it was allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader.	
CAJERO (M Cameron) raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres and was inclined to lay out for the remainder of the race.	
Passing the 700 metres CHAZELLE (M Coleman) shifted out to avoid the heels of the weakening CANDY GIRL and became unbalanced when making contact with KEENY KOOL KAT (M Sweeney) which was hampered and forced outwards onto CAJERO .	

LADY LINDAUER (J Oliver) was held up rounding the final turn when CANDY GIRL continued to give ground.	
Race 2	MARKS EWEN & ASSOCIATES 3YO
<p>DESCHABEEL (M Walker) was slow to begin.</p> <p>HANDS ORF (L Satherley) was badly hampered leaving the barrier when GABBI IS (M Coleman) shifted out and ENDEAN ROSE (S Collett) shifted in when beginning awkwardly. When being corrected ENDEAN ROSE then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of SIMBAAH (A Collett).</p> <p>ENDEAN ROSE raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>COLOUR PLUS (M Sweeney) raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 900 metres getting its head up. COLOUR PLUS continued to race greenly for a distance, going off stride when racing in restricted room to the inside of NOTHINLYKHIM (D Nolan) near the 800 metres, and again reacted poorly when racing to the inside of OPT (D Johnson) near the 600 metres.</p> <p>HAND ORF was held up behind GABBI IS near the 600 metres.</p> <p>FUNHOUSE (B Grylls) had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>Following this race the track was upgraded to Dead(4).</p>	
Race 3	SI LODEC NZ LTD '1200'
<p>MISS BROOKE (K Leung) was slow to begin.</p> <p>IONA ABBEY (M Hills) and THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN (M Dee) came together on jumping away when both horses shifted ground.</p> <p>BACHATA (M Walker) and IONA ABBEY had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.</p> <p>THE KNIGHT'S QUEEN got its head up when being restrained off heels near the 700 metres.</p> <p>MISS BROOKE lay out rounding the final turn making contact with FELICITY HALL (M Cameron) near the 300 metres.</p> <p>JENUWIN (D Johnson) ducked outwards abruptly near the 250 metres hampering CHARLIE MAC (S Collett) which was well beaten at that stage.</p>	
Race 4	TOWNLEY TRENCHING & ELECTRICAL '1560'
<p>BELLEZA IRLANDESA (M Dee) was slow to begin.</p> <p>STONELEIGH (M McNab) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>IDAHO'S CHOICE (M Cameron) got its head up when being steadied near the 800 metres.</p> <p>GEE WHIZ (M Hills) had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KNEES UP BARRY (J Oliver) near the 500 metres.</p> <p>KNEES UP BARRY had to be steadied approaching the 250 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of GEE WHIZ.</p> <p>ERNIE (M Coleman) shifted out when placed under pressure approaching the 200 metres making contact with STONELEIGH.</p>	
Race 5	BAYLEYS NATIONAL 7S – 11&12 JAN ROTORUA '1560'
<p>ALL IN BLUFF (M Walker) was slow to begin.</p> <p>MANAIA ROSE (K Leung) had to be firmly restrained for some distance passing the 1100 metres to avoid the heels of CLOEMMBAI (L Satherley).</p> <p>LASTING TOUCH (B R Jones) and KING PICCOLO (A Jones) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>A Jones (KING PICCOLO) was unable to use her whip for a short distance near the 200 metres when it became entangled with rider M Walker (ALL IN BLUFF) which was racing tight to her outside.</p> <p>DIAMOND EDGE (M Cameron) had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, and was held up near the 100 metres.</p> <p>SUPER THUNDER (B Grylls) also had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, and was held up over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 6	RAINBOW SPRINGS ROTORUA '1950'
<p>RED DAKOTA (M Walker) was slow to begin.</p> <p>LA VITESSE (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly and was further hampered when BOUVIER (B Grylls) shifted out.</p> <p>SAVARHYS (M McNab) over-raced in the early stages when three wide without cover.</p> <p>SOPHIE CLAIRE (A Collett) got its head up making the first bend passing the winning post on the first occasion awkwardly.</p>	
Race 7	INTERISLANDER '1400'
<p>FAST 'N' GORGEOUS knuckled leaving the barriers with rider C Grylls advising that the filly had lost the left front plate at that point of the race.</p> <p>MRS SIN (A Forbes) raced three wide without cover and was inclined to over-race.</p> <p>FAST 'N' GORGEOUS raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SERENANOVA (B R Jones) shifted out under pressure hampering THORNBURY (M Wenn) near the 100 metres before being corrected by its rider. B R Jones was advised to exercise more care.</p>	
Race 8	MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT '1400'
<p>FOXY BELLE (2.44 pm) and RAYNERS LANE (3.20 pm) were both declared late scratchings on veterinary advice after being</p>	

injured in the float en route to the races.

BEYOND ALL DOUBT (M Dee) was very slow to begin (3L).

MISS MOSSMAN (D Johnson) shifted out jumping away making contact with **LUCKY ORPHAN** (M Hills).

RAPID GAIN (M Cameron) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

PIT A PAT (S Collett) raced ungenerously going into the first turn near the 1200 metres.

IN TUNE (A Collett) got its head up when being restrained near the 1100 metres and raced ungenerously. **IN TUNE** again raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 900 metres.

RAPID GAIN had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight with rider M Cameron advising that the gelding had been reluctant to improve into a tight run.

LUCKY ORPHAN returned to the enclosure with blood in the left nostril which a veterinary inspection found to be from a laceration.
