RACE COMMENTS:

RACE 1	DRUNKEN DREAMS SYNDICATE MAIDEN
B Lammas replaced A Taylor (SIR GONZALES).	
HEZANAKILAD and CONNOR JOHN came together and bumped after both began awkwardly.	
IT'S A MONTY began awkwardly and settled back.	
SIR GONZALES raced wide into the first bend.	
SATANYA had to shift ground outwards near the 200 metres to improve.	
When questioned into the run of TINGED WITH GOLD which finished some distance last, rider R Hutchings was of the opinion that the filly was unsuited to today's firm track conditions.	
Race 2	DAVE & EDDIE 2YO
DAIFUKU blundered shortly after jumping away.	
KEWZERO jumped inwards leaving the barrier becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GRANITE clipping that runner's heel, losing ground.	
KEWZERO made the first corner awkwardly and shifted out dictating SAKURA over extra ground.	
DAIFUKU raced greenly and shifted in abruptly near the 300 metres hampering GRANITE and WHEELER FORTUNE which was then held up.	
DAIFUKU continued to race erratically in the home straight having to be straightened near the 200 metres and again near	

the finish.	
Race 3	RIMU ELECTRICAL MAIDEN
<p>OUR GIRL KATE began awkwardly and bumped with INSANE BOLTA. Shortly after the start CHEYENNE commenced to buck so was pulled up by rider B Lammis and took no further part. Connections were advised that the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards before next racing.</p> <p>WHATWASTHAT raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres TIHI KEEPA which was over racing shifted in marginally making contact with the hind quarters of OUR GIRL KATE which then shifted out forcing TIHI KEEPA which became unbalanced on to the heels of DELAGO'S SECRET and lost ground.</p> <p>OUR GIRL KATE was held up near the 250 metres so was angled wider to obtain clear running.</p> <p>WHATWASTHAT shifted in and bumped with DELAGO'S SECRET near the 100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of TIHI KEEPA rider S Doyle said his mount was reluctant to stretch out fully on the firm surface.</p> <p>Rider D Walker reported that THATS RACING raced greenly throughout.</p>	
Race 4	FARMLANDS 1400
<p>TEXAS YELLOW ROSE was slow to begin.</p> <p>TEXAS YELLOW ROSE and FALZANO over raced near the 900 metres and had to be restrained off the heels of COOL SPUR for a short distance.</p> <p>POROTENE LOLLIPOP was unable to improve into a narrow run which closed near the 300 metres after FALZANO shifted in under pressure. POROTENE LOLLIPOP was then obliged to angle inwards to improve and when clear finished the race off only fairly.</p>	
Race 5	GUSTO RESTAURANT MAIDEN
<p>STAGE DOOR began awkwardly and bumped with KIRKININI which settled back.</p> <p>TRANSLUCENCE raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>When crossing the junction near the 1200 metres STAGE DOOR which was over racing had to shift out abruptly to avoid the heels of FERGALICIOUS.</p> <p>LADY ANNALEE over raced for a short distance near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>S Doyle the rider of LADY ANNALEE lost his whip approaching the 100 metres.</p>

<p>SAINT MARTINS blundered and lost its footing on jumping away.</p> <p>LOVES THE SHOW raced keenly in the early stages and made the first bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>SECRET WHISPER raced in restricted room near the finish when LOVES THE SHOW lay inwards.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of SECRET WHISPER rider K Myers was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to the firm track conditions.</p>	
Race 7	CROWDED HOUSE 2000
<p>PILLAR TO POST charged the gate immediately prior to the start and as a result was slow away.</p> <p>HYPROFILE and DUCHESSE OF CAMBRIDGE bumped at the start.</p> <p>HYPROFILE shifted in near the final 100 metres and momentarily hampered LA PETITE which was improving to its inside.</p> <p>ALATION raced in restricted room early in the home straight.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of GOING PLACES rider K Kalychurun had no excuse.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of PLATINUM MARSEILLE rider J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to today's firm track conditions.</p>
