## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>TRINITY HILL SPRINT</b>
<p>S Doyle was unable to make the contracted weight for <b>CENTAROSE</b> and was replaced by L Whelan. S Doyle was fined \$100. <b>SUPACALIFRAGLISTIC</b> (M Cheung) began awkwardly.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>SHOWSTOPPER</b> rider J Parkes said the mare was under pressure some distance out and although running on over the final stages was nevertheless disappointing.</p> <p>Track conditions were upgraded to a Good 3 following the running of Race 1.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>STELLA ARTOIS FILLIES &amp; MARES MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>GALLETA</b> (B Lammass) shifted in and away from <b>MISS RAQUEL</b> (M Dravitzki) at the start, dictating <b>UNIQUE</b> (J Parkes) into the line of <b>HYMN</b> (D Walker) which was tightened and got back.</p> <p><b>MISS RAQUEL</b> over-raced throughout when in the lead.</p> <p><b>LIVE LIFE</b> (H Tinsley) shifted in under pressure and bumped <b>MISS RAQUEL</b> near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>SLICE OF CLASS</b> (R Myers) raced greenly in the home straight and passing the 200 metres shifted in prior to being straightened, a short distance further <b>SLICE OF CLASS</b> again shifted in under hard riding causing <b>INDOLLJENCE</b> (S Doyle) to be checked.</p> <p>Prior to the authorisation of dividends, connections of the fourth placed <b>INDOLLJENCE</b> viewed coverage of the home straight with a view to protesting against the second placed <b>SLICE OF CLASS</b> but elected not to proceed with an objection.</p>	

Rider R Myers admitted a subsequent breach of [Rule 638 (1)(d)] and after deliberations had her license to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on Sunday 5 <sup>th</sup> January up to and including racing on Friday 10 <sup>th</sup> January (4 Days)	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>BEST TRAVEL MAIDEN 3YO</b>
<p><b>LAMBORGHINI</b> (J Parkes) began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p><b>LACED UP</b> (S Doyle) bumped with <b>BLISS</b> (R Myers) at the start and then commenced to race very greenly throughout.</p> <p><b>FLYING CAPTAIN</b> (H Tinsley) shifted out under pressure over the final stages but was clear of other runners.</p> <p><b>LACED UP</b> became fractious in the barrier prior to the start. A post-race veterinary inspection of <b>LACED UP</b> revealed a laceration to the near side hind pastern.</p> <p>After questioning starter G Phillips and rider S Doyle, both advised stewards that they were unaware of any injury to <b>LACED UP</b> prior to the start, however G Phillips was advised that in future he is expected to have a particularly fractious horse removed and undergo a veterinary inspection prior to the start.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ROGER RUSSELL &amp; CHARLIE KEENAN MEMORIAL</b>
<p><b>JOE COOL</b> (R Myers) was slow away.</p> <p><b>PURE OCTAINE</b> (M Cheung) made the first turn awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MAKEBA</b> (S Doyle) lay in shortly after entering the home straight, momentarily hampering <b>PURE OCTAINE</b>.</p> <p>Over the final stages <b>NOTHING TRIVIAL</b> (M McNab) shifted in under pressure and bumped <b>SLIPPERY MISTAKE</b> (K Smith).</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>RUSSELL ROADS CITY OF HASTINGS CUP</b>
<p><b>SAVOUR THE MOMENT</b> (M McNab) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GALAXY STAR</b> (R Hannam) over-raced rounding the bend at the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>SAVOUR THE MOMENT</b> shifted in and brushed the running rail near the 250 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MORE FM MILE</b>
<p><b>THE INNKEEPER</b> (K Smith) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>WANNABE</b> (M McNab), <b>JILTED</b> (R Myers), <b>JAKOB GAMBINO</b> (J Parkes) and <b>BOB VALDEZ</b> (V Gatu) all raced in restricted room going into the first turn with <b>BOB VALDEZ</b> having to steady.</p> <p><b>WANNABE</b> raced keenly in the back straight.</p> <p>D Turner (<b>GWYNETHANNE</b>) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground when he angled his mount outwards near the 400 metres forcing <b>CAJUN</b> (L Whelan) wider on the track.</p> <p><b>STELLA BELLA</b> (R Hannam) raced in restricted room over the final few strides.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of <b>THE INNKEEPER</b> which tailed off throughout failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>DESERT GOLD CLUB STAYERS</b>
<p><b>SAN PEDRO</b> (D Walker) was cleared to start after making contact with the gatepost as it left the enclosure.</p> <p><b>PEARLS</b> (R Myers) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>PEARLS</b> rider R Myers stated the mare showed no early speed and failed to respond when placed under pressure and was disappointing. Co-trainer G Cullen advised he would monitor the mare over coming days and report any abnormalities to the stewards. G Cullen added that consideration would be given to spelling <b>PEARLS</b>.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of <b>VELDT</b>, which ran last, rider M Dravitzki said the gelding raced in a dour manner and was unable to quicken when the tempo of the race increased.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>
